## Lea retires from State Veterinarian post, Moreau appointed

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Bob Odom recently appointed Dr. Henry Moreau to the position of state veterinarian to fill the vacancy created by the upcoming retirement of Dr. Maxwell Lea of Zachary.

We're sorry to see Dr. Lea go, but after 17 years as the state veterinarian and another 20 in private practice, Mack decided it was time to retire, Odom said.

Odom said he was proud of the accomplishments of Lea and the animal health staff during Lea's tenure as the state's top veterinarian.

Louisiana became a certified brucellosis-free and tuberculosis-

free state in cattle under Dr. Lea's watch, Odom said. The impact to the state's cattle industry has been tremendous.

Odom also credited Lea with the implementation of an equine infectious anemia testing and micro-chipping plan, the elimination of pseudorabies and brucellosis in swine, the creation of the poultry diagnostic laboratory in Homer and the supervision of livestock and pet rescue and sheltering during the Katrina-Rita hurricane crises.

Lea received his veterinary training at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater.

Our new state veterinarian also

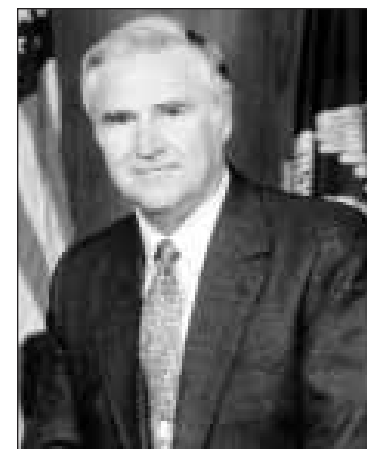
comes with impressive credentials, Odom said. Dr. Henry Moreau has already served 27 years as a regional veterinarian with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

Moreau said the new challenges of establishing an efficient animal identification program, a crack emergency response team to deal with the current threats of foreign animal diseases like avian influenza, and continuing the department's work in brucellosis and tuberculosis prevention are top priorities.

I know Dr. Moreau will have the state well-prepared when it comes to these issues, Odom said.

Moreau, a Simmesport native, received his undergraduate education from Louisiana State University and his veterinary training from Texas A&M University. He is a small and large animal specialist.

Moreau is married to the former Geryllyn Rabelais of Cottonport and together they have four children, Jake, 27; Justin, 22; Jenny, 17; and Jordan, 12. Among other civic and community positions he has held, Moreau served as president of the Avoyelles Parish Cattlemen's Association, the Atchafalaya Area Chamber of Commerce and the Avoyelles Parish LSU Alumni Association.
