Riceland Crawfish



Owner Dexter Guillory takes pride in producing high quality products for his customers

As crawfish season winds down, a visit to processing plant Riceland Crawfish in Eunice indicates there's nothing slow about the crawfish industry. "The process from cooking to packaging crawfish tails is timed and food safety is of utmost importance," said Food Safety Auditor Dwight Landreneau.

For Riceland Crawfish, it's not about being one of the biggest processing plants, it is about having a quality product that the consumer can trust. "I need to make sure the next generation can maintain and expand this business by making it the best it can be," said owner Dexter Guillory.

Guillory, a former crawfisherman, started the processing business in 1984. Most of his crawfish come from ponds but some come from the Atchafalaya Basin. Riceland Crawfish gets all of its crawfish from a list of certified crawfish harvesters.

Guillory says having certain quality control certifications is important to him. Their certifications include Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) and Safe Quality Food (SQF). Riceland Crawfish is the only processing plant that holds these two certifications in the United States.

Landreneau added, "Our safety procedures include knowing where the food comes from, how the raw product is handled and how the seasoning is handled. We document everything. It's all for the sustainability of the industry."

Riceland Crawfish processes between 10-15 million pounds of crawfish per year. They sell live crawfish to

150 stores in and around Louisiana. They sell whole boiled seasoned crawfish and crawfish tail meat to thousands of stores belonging to a major retailer. They also process alligator meat which they sell to more than 600 stores throughout the U.S.

"Our major retailers such as Wal-Mart demand quality products. They've let us know – you must be certified and sustainable," said Guillory.

"Our packaging promoting Louisiana is going across the country. If you put trash in it, it's a poor reflection on us," added Landreneau.

The crawfish get weighed, washed and graded where it is determined what is sold live and what is processed. The crawfish are then cooked and packaged. Seasonal workers (H2B) are required to sanitize the equipment between each batch of crawfish that is cooked.

All seasoning used and sold is also created in Louisiana. It's a family business that continues to grow as standards are maintained at a high level.

"We're now branching into the cold storage business mainly because we are expanding," said Guillory. Because of the volume, Riceland Crawfish recently built a cold storage facility down the road from the processing plant. "This allows us to work even more efficiently because we can move product out quickly to get Louisiana crawfish and alligator into commerce. This cold storage facility in Eunice also allows other businesses in our area to have access to a facility of this type," said Guillory.

Strain attends White House Infrastructure Summit

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said it was a tremendous honor to represent the nation's agricultural producers at a meeting Thursday, June 8 with White House officials including President Donald J. Trump and Vice President Mike Pence.

"We discussed infrastructure challenges and what it means to the rural community. While we are an economic super power, our infrastructure must keep up. Improving infrastructure improves commerce, the economy and it

moves America forward," said Strain.

Strain said infrastructure topics included: reducing permitting time to move projects along more quickly; increasing infrastructure spending while restoring accountability in how infrastructure funds are spent; and allowing state and local governments more flexibility to develop infrastructure free from federal impediment.

Strain also led the discussion on the need to invest in mechanisms to bring products to market such as waterways, railroads and highways. "Our inland waterways

and ports are an essential lifeline which move eighty-five percent of grains destined for the global marketplace. We must work cooperatively to improve our dilapidated waterways system which is failing our food producers. Congress must prioritize funding for these critical infrastructure projects."

Strain and White House officials also discussed the need for inter-connectivity in rural America so everyone has better access to technology.

Strain, who also serves as National Association of State

Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) President and South Carolina Commissioner of Agriculture Hugh Weathers, Chair of NASDA's Rural Development and Financial Security Committee, attended the White House Infrastructure Summit with numerous cabinet secretaries, governors, mayors, and other state, local, and tribal leaders.

The event, part of the White House Infrastructure Week, was an opportunity for state and federal leaders to lay the groundwork for cooperatively improving the nation's infrastructure.

Milk-Braised Pork Loin

1 boneless pork loin (3 1/2 to 4 lbs.)	Zest of 2 medium lemons
Kosher salt and black pepper	1 tbsp. orange zest
3 tbsps. unsalted butter, divided,	1 tbsp. minced garlic
1 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil	1/8 tsp. freshly-ground nutmeg
1/2 cup shallots, thinly sliced	2 cups whole milk
2 tbsps. chopped fresh sage	2 cups heavy cream
1/2 tsp. chopped fresh thyme	Several whole thyme and sage sprigs (added to pot and for garnish)

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Let pork loin come up to room temperature for about an hour. Season pork liberally on all sides with kosher salt and black pepper. Melt 1 tablespoon butter and olive oil over medium-high heat in a heavy-bottomed pot that is just large enough to fit pork. Add pork and sear on all sides, 10-12 minutes. Remove pork from pot and set aside on plate.

Place remaining 2 tablespoons butter in pot and melt over medium heat. Add shallots, cooking until just translucent. Add herbs, garlic, citrus zest and nutmeg and cook until fragrant, about 1-2 minutes. Add milk and cream, stirring to combine all ingredients. Return pork to pot, along with any accumulated juices and whole springs of thyme and sage, bring up to a slow simmer. Cover pot and place in preheated oven. Cook 2 hours, turning it half way through cooking. Uncover and cook an additional 30 minutes.

Transfer pork to a carving board and let rest at least 15 minutes. With a slotted spoon, remove the larger curds if any from the sauce and discard any herb stems. Place pot back on the stove over medium heat; bring to a simmer. Cook 12 to 15 minutes until reduced by half, stirring frequently so milk doesn't scorch. Cut pork into 1/2-inch-thick slices and arrange on deep serving platter. Ladle milk gravy over pork and garnish with any remaining fresh thyme, sage and zest.

Chocolate Almond Coffee Cooler

2 cups milk	Few drops almond extract
2 tbsps. unsweetened cocoa powder	1 cup ice cubes
2 tbsps. sugar	Refrigerated dairy whipped topping
1 tsp. instant coffee crystals	Chocolate wafer crumbs

In a blender container, combine milk, cocoa powder, sugar, coffee crystals and almond extract. Cover and blend until smooth. Add ice cubes. Cover and blend until ice is crushed. Pour into chilled glasses and top with whipped cream and chocolate wafer crumbs.

Roasted Red Pepper-Feta Dip

2 garlic bulbs	2 cups canned cannellini beans, drained
2 medium red bell peppers, roasted and peeled	1/2 tsp. ground red pepper
1 cup plain yogurt	1 cup (8 oz.) crumbled feta cheese

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Slice off the tops of the garlic bulbs with a sharp knife to expose the cloves. Place the garlic on a square of aluminum foil. Fold foil to seal. Wrap entirely in more foil and bake 45 minutes. Unwrap and let cool. Squeeze the soft garlic cloves from their skins.

Cut bell peppers in half, lengthwise; discard seeds and membranes. Place peppers, skin side up, on a foil-lined baking sheet; flatten with hand. Broil 15 minutes or until blackened. Place bell pepper in a zip-top, heavy-duty plastic bag and seal; let stand 10 minutes. Peel. Combine roasted bell peppers, Greek yogurt, beans and ground red pepper in food processor; process until smooth. Add feta and pulse just until combined. Serve with pita chips, crackers or sliced vegetables.

Easy Italian Vegetable Pasta Bake

3 cups mostaccioli pasta, cooked, drained	2 cups thinly sliced mushrooms
1 (27 1/2 oz) jar light pasta sauce	2 cups sliced halved yellow squash
1 (8 oz) pkg. shredded, reduced-fat mozzarella cheese, divided	2 cups sliced halved zucchini

Mix mostaccioli, sauce, 1 cup cheese and vegetables. Spoon into 13-x9-inch baking dish; sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake at 375 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes or until thoroughly heated.

Great Substitute: Substitute 1 cup each thinly sliced red and green peppers for 1 cup each of the squash and zucchini.

Truelove Cheesecake

1 1/4 cups graham cracker crumbs	1 cup sugar
2 tablespoons sugar	1/4 teaspoon vanilla
3 tablespoons butter, melted	4 large eggs
2 (8-ounce) packages cream cheese	2 cups sour cream divided
1 (3 oz) package cream cheese	Fresh raspberries (optional)

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Stir together graham cracker crumbs and 2 tablespoons sugar. Mix in butter. Press mixture evenly in bottom of 9-inch springform pan. Bake 10 minutes, then removed from oven and let cool. Reduce oven temperature to 300°. Beat cream cheese in large bowl. Gradually add 1 cup sugar, beating until fluffy. Stir in 1 cup sour cream. Add vanilla. Beat in eggs, one at a time, pour over crumb mixture. Bake one hour until center is firm. Let cool at room temperature and top with remaining 1 cup sour cream. Cover and let chill at least 3 hours. Garnish with raspberries, if desired.

LDAF accepting organic cost-share rebate applications

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said Louisiana agricultural producers and handlers who have either obtained or renewed USDA organic certification may qualify for reimbursement for their certification costs through a cost share rebate program.

The program will reimburse

up to 75 percent of certification costs, or up to \$750 per year per certification category. The rebates are available to cover certification expenses incurred between October 1, 2016 and September 30, 2017.

“Earning the USDA Organic certification for an agricultural product has a number of benefits like adding value and consumer

confidence; however, the certification can be a costly and lengthy process,” Strain said.

Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) Oct. 2, 2017.

The program is funded through USDA’s Farm Service Agency (FSA).

The 2017 cost-share application is available at www.LDAF.la.gov.

Reimbursements will be on a first-come, first-served basis, based on receipt of the completed application packet, until available funding is exhausted.
