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## Steele's Christmas tree farm providing Christmas trees for 38 years

Kevin Steele, Sr. has always loved Christmas. "Christmas is the celebration of life. I give all the glory to God."

Steele recalls a story from his childhood when he decorated his very own tree. "It wasn't pretty, but my late mother made me feel like it was the most beautiful tree she'd ever seen. She was wonderful like that," said Steele.

Today, he grows some of the most beautiful Christmas trees. This year, the Washington Parish Christmas tree farmer has the distinction of providing the tree that will be showcased at the Governor's Mansion. This honor is the result of a Southern Christmas Tree Association competition for which Steele has won the past four years.

"It's wonderful. In the past, we've been invited to the Governor's mansion to see our tree on display."

A nurse by profession, Steele moved to Sheridan, La. from the New Orleans area in 1976. At the time, he was working for South Central Bell as a lineman. Moving to the country allowed him to pursue his passion of growing Christmas trees. "There was this longtime weathercaster named Nash Roberts who grew Christmas trees in Folsom. I remember him talking about it and it really peaked my interest," said Steele.

Steele opened his Christmas tree farm in 1979. Today, he grows six thousand trees on six acres. You'll find Leland Cypress, Carolina Sapphire, and Blue Ice. Frazier Fir and White Pine are imported from North Carolina.

"We really urge people to support their local tree farmers. You're helping the economy and you get a fresher tree when it's been grown and cut close to home."

Steele also reminds folks that once you enjoy your Christmas tree, your old, discarded tree can also benefit

the environment. "People really get into the coastal restoration project in which Christmas trees are used. Some people will even sink their trees in a pond and make a fish habitat. So keep that in mind when you're debating whether to buy a fresh tree or one from a store in a box."

It takes five years for a tree to mature. Like any farm, it takes hard work and some luck for the trees to grow. "It's a beautiful thing when you can plant that seedling and watch something grow; but, you have to get the proper amount of rain at the right times. That's sometimes hard in Louisiana. You just hope, by the grace of God, they grow."

For Steele, it's also a family business all the way around. His grown children and grandchildren help on the farm. As for his customers, they too, are like family. "We now have third generation customers who visit the tree farm. We allow families to pick and cut their own trees or my staff cuts the trees for the customer."

As a nurse, Steele says he often see's people at their worst. But on his farm, it's nothing but happy, smiling faces. He says most families love the tradition of Christmas tree shopping.

Since 2012, Steele has added a new attraction on his property each year. These days, you'll find a pumpkin patch, a petting zoo, trains, a hayride, giant jump pillow and even pig races. There's also a gift shop and a concession stand.

The pumpkin patch is open Monday through Friday during the month of October for school field trips by appointment only. The pumpkin patch and activities are open to the public from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Saturday's and from 1:00-6:00 p.m. on Sunday's.

## PSA grower training, optional GAPs Food Safety Plan writing workshop set for Nov., Dec.

Fruit and vegetable growers and others interested in learning about produce safety, the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) Produce Safety Rule, Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs) and co-management of natural resources and food safety should attend this food safety training. The two-day training will be offered on Nov. 14-15 in Lafayette and Dec. 7-8 in Oak Grove.

The PSA Grower Training Course is one way to satisfy the FSMA Produce Safety Rule requirement outlined in section 112.22(c) that requires At least one supervisor or responsible party for your farm must have successfully completed food safety training at least equivalent to that received under standardized curriculum recognized as adequate by the Food and Drug Administration.

### DAY 1: PSA Grower Training Course

The trainers will spend approximately seven hours of instruction time covering content contained in these seven modules:

- Introduction to Produce Safety
- Worker Health, Hygiene, and Training
- Soil Amendments
- Wildlife, Domesticated Animals, and Land Use
- Agricultural Water (Part I: Production Water; Part II:

Postharvest Water)

- Postharvest Handling and Sanitation
- How to Develop a Farm Food Safety Plan

### Day 2: Optional GAPs Food Safety Plan Writing

Fresh produce growers, packers, and processors and extension agents are encouraged to take this opportunity to learn more about GAPs and GHPs. Although this is not a requirement of FSMA, it is for those being asked by their buyers to have a food safety plan and undergo a 3rd-party audit. Financial assistance in the form of a cost reimbursement program will be established and will support 75% (up to \$1000) of the auditing fees associated with GAPs certification for a minimum of 25 producers. Producers attending this workshop will be eligible for the cost reimbursement program on a first come first served basis.

# Louisiana pecan crop coming up short

Expectations for an excellent Louisiana 2017 pecan crop have been dashed by unfavorable weather, according to the LSU AgCenter pecan specialist.

"It's not nearly as good as what we thought it was going to be," said Charlie Graham, who is based at the LSU AgCenter Red River Research Station.

The projection of 15 million pounds has probably been reduced by 3-4 million pounds as a result of several factors.

Some losses occurred from heavy rains washing away the initial crop, Graham said.

The biggest problems were caused by cloudy, rainy weather in August, which resulted in shucks dying and splitting open, a condition called shuck decline.

Some varieties suffered heavy losses due to water split. "Affected nuts have usually initiated shell hardening, so they have lost some elasticity, but haven't hardened enough to withstand the increased pressure," Graham

said. "The sudden influx of water following a rainfall event increases the internal water pressure until it ruptures."

The nuts were OK if they were further along in maturity when the rains came or if they were later in development, he said.

Graham said he lost half of some varieties, such as Caddo, Oconee and Schley.

The disease neofusicoccum was a problem in Pointe Coupee Parish, causing trees to defoliate, and the effects on the 2018 crop are uncertain. "I've talked to several growers who had that problem," Graham said. "It is becoming a common problem in pecan orchards not utilizing a fungicide spray program."

Pecan prices are good this year. "Prices have been very, very strong, and we can expect them to stay strong," he said.

The leading pecan state, Georgia, was expected to have a 90-100 million-pound crop, but that was reduced by 30 percent

because of damage from hurricanes.

The Georgia crop could be reduced even more because pecans that survived this year's hurricane season could have been bruised from the winds.

"I don't see anything that's going to make the price drop, except lower kernel quality," Graham said.

Graham said he's not heard of any major problems from walnut caterpillars in north Louisiana.

LSU AgCenter agent Keith Hawkins in Beauregard Parish said he's gotten numerous complaints from backyard growers with walnut caterpillars causing defoliation problems. And he said his own tree was damaged by the insect.

"It wasn't just me. There also were trees affected in Calcasieu and Vernon parishes. I've gotten lots of complaints over several weeks," Hawkins said.

He said he's also heard of problems with

the insect in Rapides Parish.

Commercial growers can afford the expensive equipment to spray for the pest, but the best option for a homeowner with a few trees is a granular product, Arena. It can be used to treat trees against future infestations, but the chemical doesn't get rid of an existing problem, Hawkins said.

Graham said Arena 50 WDG insecticide is only labeled for use on non-bearing nut trees.

"Young pecan trees are more easily damaged by walnut caterpillar than large trees. So for protecting pecan trees less than 6 years old, it would be a good choice," Graham said.

Honeybees should be considered before the chemical is used.

"It kills bees for up to 5 days after application, so it shouldn't be used if you have flowering plants in bloom near your treated pecan trees or foraging bees in the area," Graham said.

## LSU AgCenter launches new website about giant salvinia

The LSU AgCenter has a new resource to help educate the public about the invasive weed giant salvinia.

The website, [www.lsuagcenter.com/giantsalvinia](http://www.lsuagcenter.com/giantsalvinia), looks at the problem of salvinia and control methods. Images and maps show how the aquatic plant has spread across Louisiana waterways.

Giant salvinia is a free-floating fern native to southeastern Brazil. LSU AgCenter entomologist Rodrigo Diaz said it creates dense mats of weeds on lakes, ponds and reservoirs throughout the southeastern United States. The thick mats prevent sunlight from reaching the water column and suppress native vegetation while affecting fish, waterfowl and other species in the area.

"The purpose of the website is to have

a central hub for information about giant salvinia," Diaz said. "We have compiled practical information about the biological control program of giant salvinia in Louisiana."

Diaz is conducting research on the salvinia weevil, an insect which feeds on the plant and has been shown to control it.

This website includes information on how to recognize giant salvinia, its effects on aquatic habitats and how to use salvinia weevils to manage this problem.

"Managing giant salvinia with biological control requires monitoring the population of weevils and salvinia conditions. We hope this website will be useful not only for plant managers but also people who enjoy wetlands," Diaz said.
