Every great dairy begins with good cows. It also takes good people to take care of them. From the label to the cows, you'll notice something different about milk from the Flowing Hills Creamery in Belmont, La. For starters, Carlton Salley has three different breeds of cattle on his farm: Holstein, the ones most people associate with dairies; Jersey, the second most popular dairy breed; and then there are the Brown Swiss, which are known for having very rich milk. That creamy rich milk works well for Flowing Hills because the milk sold here is not homogenized. That means the cream still rises to the top and you have to do like your grandmother always did before pouring a glass of milk: shake the jug. Carlton Salley says it's healthier that way. "In homogenization, you break down enzymes that your body needs and by doing what we do, you don't break those enzymes down."

At Flowing Hills, the Salley's also pasteurize their milk a little differently to preserve what is naturally healthy in this milk and destroy potentially harmful bacteria found in raw milk.

Letting the Cream Rise to the Top

raised dairy cows since 1979, he got out of the business in 2008. Just last year, the Salley's decided the only way they could make it in the dairy business was to bottle and market their own milk. They planned to start small, but this pasteurizer changed that plan.

Brenda Salley said, "It was 600 gallons and we had to change the complete form of the plant and add on to it before we even got started. So, it's like God just dropped in and opened those doors and so we just have to pasteurize more. We get it out to the public and they want more and more of it every day."

Carlton added, "I never intended for it to grow like it has, but I've been well blessed."

Blessed is a great way to put it because there was a reason why the Salley's got out of the dairy business six years ago: it's tough to make ends meet. It's his experience at a local farmers market, which set his mind at ease.

"I knew that it was going to be okay when you start, after two to three weeks, you have local return people, you know, just come back with their ice chests. I knew then that it was going to be okay. And, so we have a great following of people that's regular."

Now, back to the Flowing Hills label. The cows on it are the grand dames of national champion show cattle owned by the Salley's. Everything at this dairy is handled by the family, including the creation of the name Flowing Hills.

"Leslie, my daughter-in-law, came up with the idea of Flowing Hills Creamery from a Bible scripture which told that the milk flowed from the hills. It's in Joel. It's on our label," said Brenda.

Flowing Hills Creamery milk is sold in stores from Shreveport to Monroe. However, the best way to try their milk, butter, and even their sweet tea, is to go to one of the five farmers' markets they visit every week in Shreveport and Alexandria.

"We do a low VAT pasteurization. We get to about 145-150 degrees for 30 minutes and then we immediately cool it back down. From the time we start our process, our pasteurization, we try to have it cooled down and ready to bottle within two hours," added Carlton Salley.

According to the LSU AgCenter, there are 125 dairy farmers left in Louisiana.

One way for dairy farm families to survive is to process and bottle their own milk.

The Salley's pasteurize their milk in a piece of equipment originally owned by Warren Smith, owner of Smith's Creamery. After an explosion destroyed the Smith Creamery in June of 2011, it sat unused until Carlton Salley bought it. The destruction of one creamery led to the rebirth of a dairy in Sabine Parish.

Even though Carlton Salley



Program aims to bring fresh, seasonal produce into La. schools

BATON ROUGE – Growing interest in making fresher, more healthful food available in Louisiana communities has led the LSU AgCenter to implement the Louisiana Harvest of the Month pilot program in three Louisiana schools – Dufrocq Elementary School in Baton Rouge, Andrew H. Wilson Charter School in New Orleans and North Bayou Rapides Elementary School in Alexandria.

Harvest of the Month is designed to deliver fresh-from-the-farm specialty-crop fruits and vegetables one day each month to each school, said Ann Savage, program director for Harvest of the Month.

The program is being developed this fall and will be implemented starting in January 2015 by the LSU AgCenter in partnership with The Louisiana Farm to School Network, Fresh Beginnings, Central Louisiana Economic Development Alliance (CLEDA), Slow Food Baton Rouge and other community partners.

The program is funded through a U.S. Department of Agriculture Specialty Crop Grant Fund coordinated by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

Currently, childhood obesity is at its highest rate, Savage said. In Louisiana, 40 percent of youth are overweight or obese.

“Innovative programs like Harvest of the Month aim to connect kids with food and where it comes from,” Savage said. “There is no question that the areas where children live, learn and play can have a real impact on their eating habits.”

The program will promote Louisiana’s horticultural diversity and long growing season by highlighting a different, in-season, local fruit or vegetable each month.

“We are excited to have the opportunity to pilot the Louisiana Harvest of the Month Program so that we can use this program to create a model for the purchase of local produce and serving it in schools,” Savage said. “By starting on a small scale we hope to develop protocols and recommendations for schools statewide and demonstrate it is possible and adaptable to schools around our Louisiana.”

“In 2012, the National School Lunch Program served 92 million lunches to Louisiana students,” she added. “If we could buy just a fraction of this food locally, it could be a huge boost for the local economy.”

Throughout the year this program will extend from the classroom to the cafeteria to the home and community, promoting healthier habits and futures for Louisiana students.

The pilot program will affect nearly 2,000 students and their families during its first year, Savage said. It will allow students to learn about the various nutritional benefits, history, fun facts and botanical and growing information of fruits and vegetables through educational materials for all involved.

“Given that children spend the majority of their day at school, school meals and snacks have a significant impact on youth’s diets,” said Carolyn Johnson, director of the Prevention Research Center at Tulane University. “The Louisiana Harvest of the Month statewide program for fruits and vegetables will allow the LSU AgCenter to promote

fruit and vegetable consumption and educate youth about the origin of food.”

“The program is a win for everyone – kids win because they are gaining access to nutritious, high-quality, local food while learning the origin of their food; farmers win because they are gaining access to a new institutional market; communities win by reducing carbon footprints of food transportation while stimulating the local economy with local purchases,” said Katie Mularz, Louisiana state lead for the National Farm to School Network.

A successful farm to school program has three components – local and regional procurement, education and gardening, Savage said.

“The Harvest of the Month program will work in its pilot stage to target the first two components in a way that provides a sustainable model for continued support when funding ends,” she said. “We hope in the future we can target the third component of gardening while also taking the model we have created and providing the program to more schools throughout the state.”
