## Tallulah Farm Girl to Compete on Prime Time Cooking Show

Growing up on a farm in Tallulah, La. was heaven on Earth for Tammi Arender. "I loved the farm. I was a tomboy and I just loved it when my dad would let me ride on that tractor with him," said Arender.

What she did not do a lot of was spend time in the kitchen. "It's so funny. I did not grow up cooking. Both Mom and Dad were great cooks and, of course, Dad was a hunter so I used to always say, if it ran across the yard, he shot it and put it in the skillet."

While Arender was not in the kitchen preparing the meal, she developed a great appreciation for really good food and well prepared dishes. "Growing up in Tallulah did not influence my cooking but rather my taste buds. My father's passion was cooking and good food. We had a garden and cooked at home. Truly, it wasn't until I left Tallulah that I realized the experience of eating out."

Arender says the closest restaurants to Tallulah were in Monroe, La. and Vicksburg, Ms. When Arender's job as a news anchor and reporter brought her to different cities, that is where she discovered

fine dining.

"I was in Baton Rouge and eating tremendous foods, but I was spending a lot of money for it. One day I said, let me see if I can make that? So what I would do is tweak it and

make it my own! Low and behold - shut the barn door! I found that I could do it." That was 8-9 years ago. She's been passionate about cooking ever since.

Arender said she raided her mother's cookbook collection. "I got some of those cookbooks from her and started reading them like a John Grisham novel. I was fascinated by the process of cooking which always results in a payoff. Not only is it good to my taste buds, but the reaction I get from others is an incredible payoff."

Currently working for RFD-TV and Rural Radio Sirius XM Ch80 where she anchors the rural evening news and market day report in Nashville, Tn., Arender says one day she came across a casting call for a new cooking competition. The only problem was, she was in Nashville and the audition was in Atlanta, Ga.

"I jumped through hoops, but I drove to Atlanta with what I needed to prepare my dishes for the audition. I was called back and told I was going to be on the show, *On The*

*Menu*, with the possibility that my dessert would be featured at Planet Hollywood restaurants."

After that, Arender found herself on a plane to Los Angeles, Ca. to compete and tape the show. Celebrity judges included representatives from Planet Hollywood, Ty Pennington and Chef Emeril Lagasse.

"I overheard Emeril ask Ty, which one is from Louisiana? It was neat to talk to him and have him mentor me.

I watch Emeril Lagasse and Rachael Ray on television. I've really learned from both. To meet him in person and have him give me advice was a surreal moment. He really wanted you to do your best so he really evaluated what you were doing."

While Arender cannot disclose which dessert she made or the results of the competition, she was able to share this: "I'm making something that as a Louisiana chef, Emeril was *See Cooking, cont. on page 20*

## Farming and Our Youth

I often talk about the average age of today's farmer. Let me put it to you this way – they're not getting any younger. The average age of the American farmer today is 58 years old.

Imagine my delight when I met young James Desselle, 14, from Avoyelles Parish at this summer's Louisiana Junior Cattlemen's Association La Moo U program. Actually, it was not my first time meeting James. He told me he heard me speak the year before at La Moo U. He also handed me a letter and here's an excerpt from that letter:

"You gave a speech that said youths need to acquire assets." Well, apparently James took my

advice because in the letter, he said he now had "access to a tractor, two four wheelers, tractor implements, a bar, fence and he, by himself, now owned three cows on three acres of land".

Wow. That's quite the accomplishment for such a young man. In his letter, he further explained that he secured a loan from the USDA to start building his assets. He then said he had advanced all he could on his own, but wanted a cattleman's advice to further advance his farm.

We have since put James in touch with the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association (LCA) to help guide him. A member of my staff spoke with James' father, Kevin, to get an

update and we are told that current LCA president Tom Ardoin visited with James recently to discuss topics ranging from calving to grass management. We're also told James thought it was a great honor to have Tom Ardoin visit and they plan to stay in touch.

I urge each of you to spend time teaching the young where our food comes from. Support them when they say, "I want to learn the farming business". It could be something as small as helping them plant a garden. Support them with that too. Farming teaches a multitude of things – responsibility, hard work and resiliency. I am encouraged when I hear about a young person who is interested in



### The Best Zucchini Casserole

2 pound zucchini, cubed	1 10¾ ounce can cream of chicken soup
¼ cup chopped green onion	1 cup sour cream
1 cup water	1 stick butter or margarine, melted
1 cup grated carrots	1 - 8 ounce package Pepperidge Farm herb dressing

## Fall 2014 HORTICULTURE HINTS – Checklist for September, October, November

LSU AgCenter- Dan Gill

1. Begin preparing beds for fall planting.
2. Take soil samples from landscape beds and submit to the LSU AgCenter Soil Testing Laboratory for analysis. Check with your parish LSU AgCenter Extension Service office for more information.
3. Fall is a great time to plant hardy trees, shrubs, ground covers and vines.
4. Plant spring-flowering bulbs in your gardens from late October through early December. Exceptions are tulips and hyacinths, which must be refrigerated and

planted in late December or early January.

5. Garden mums make a great addition for fall color. Check at your local retail garden center for availability.

6. Watch azalea plantings for early fall infestations of lace bugs. Control with acephate, horticultural oil sprays (bifenthrin, cyfluthrin or permethrin) and other recommended insecticides.

7. Build a compost pile out of leaves, grass clippings and remains from your vegetable garden.

8. September is a good time to divide and transplant Louisiana irises, if you need to.

Fertilize your irises in October.

9. Many of the summer-blooming perennials are finished or finishing up their floral displays for the year. Cut back the flower stalks and old faded flowers to keep the plants looking attractive.

10. October weather can be dry. Water plants as needed. Pay special attention to any newly planted areas. It generally is best to water direct-seeded beds of flowers or vegetables lightly every day to make sure the seeds do not dry out.

11. Prune everblooming roses by early September.

12. Fall is an excellent time to plant many herbs in the garden. A few herb plants provide a lot of harvest, so don't plant more than you can use. Herbs to plant now include parsley, sage, thyme, dill, cilantro, rosemary, oregano, borage, fennel, nasturtium, French tarragon, chives, mint and catnip.

13. Trees that provide good to excellent fall color in Louisiana include baldcypress, Nuttall oak, Shumard oak, cherry bark oak, flowering pear, Chinese pistachio, ginkgo, Japanese maple, sweet gum, sumac, red maple, Southern sugar maple and hickory.

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# Louisiana Agricultural Producer Trains Employees on Pesticide Safety

By Marty Pousson

With harvest time in full swing across Louisiana, agricultural producers are reminded about the federal mandate to train their field workers and pesticide handlers about pesticide safety. In early September, Black Gold Farms in Delhi, La. put those wheels in motion. That weekend, personnel with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) and the LSU AgCenter teamed up with Mario Saavedra (Regional Education Specialist with the Texas Department of Agriculture) and Francisco Lomas (language interpreter) to present a comprehensive pesticide safety program in the Spanish language to Black Gold Farms' 326 incoming Hispanic farm workers, effectively providing them with the knowledge needed to safely work around pesticides used on their farm.

The Worker Protection Standard (WPS) is a federal regulation – 40 CFR Part 170 – published in 1992 by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and enforced in Louisiana by the LDAF. The regulation is aimed at reducing the risk of occupational pesticide exposure among agricultural workers (people involved in the production of agricultural plants) and pesticide handlers (people who mix, load, transfer, apply pesticides, and perform related tasks). Nationwide, the regulation offers occupational protection to more than 2 million agricultural workers, early-entry workers, and pesticide handlers working at 600,000 farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses.

“The regulation requires that agricultural employers train workers and pesticide handlers about pesticide safety, provide protections to them from potential pesticide exposure, and provide mitigation efforts in case exposures may occur,” said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “Currently, WPS safety training must be provided to employees before they begin work and at least once every three years, unless employees are already certified pesticide applicators with the LDAF. In 2013 alone, a total of 1,270 pesticide handlers and 758 workers received training in the state,” said Strain.

To conduct WPS training in Louisiana, individuals must hold current pesticide applicator certification – either private or commercial – with the LDAF and have attended an approved initial or refresher WPS Train-the-Trainer educational workshop within the last three years. “The 637 current WPS Trainers in the state include LSU AgCenter parish agents, agricultural producers, agri-business managers, and correctional facility staff,” said Strain.

Office staff and field specialists within the LDAF Pesticide and Environmental Programs Division work closely with the LSU AgCenter Pesticide Education Safety Program



and the U.S. EPA in maintaining a successful pesticide applicator certification and training program that consistently meets national standards. “Our division’s main goal is to protect people, property, the food supply, and the environment from both pests and pesticide exposure.

We ensure that all certified, registered, and supervised pesticide applicators working within the state are competent to use pesticides properly and effectively through education, examinations, and supervised experience requirements,” said Kevin Wofford, division director. The divi-

sion also enforces state pesticide laws, rules and regulations, including requirements related to certification for the use of certain pesticides.

## What does the Current WPS Regulation Require?

While the WPS regulation covers all pesticides with an Agricultural Use Requirement section on the label, the label does not provide all information needed to comply with the regulation. At a minimum, the current WPS regulation requires the following actions from agricultural employers:

- Providing pesticide safety training for all workers and handlers
- Access to labeling information for pesticide handlers and early-entry workers
- Access to site-specific information for workers and handlers which includes providing information about pesticide applications on the establishment, emergency information, and posting a pesticide safety poster at a central location
- Keeping workers out of areas being treated with pesticides
- Keeping workers out of areas that are under

- a restricted-entry interval (REI) with a few narrow exceptions
- Protecting early-entry workers who are doing permitted tasks in pesticide-treated areas during an REI, including special instructions and duties related to correct use of personal protective equipment
- Notifying workers about pesticide-treated areas so they can avoid inadvertent exposure
- Monitoring handlers using highly-toxic pesticides
- Providing required personal protective

equipment to handlers and taking steps to prevent heat illness when personal protective equipment is being worn

- Providing decontamination supplies including a sufficient supply of water, soap, and towels for routine washing and emergency decontamination
- Providing emergency assistance to a medical care facility in case of a pesticide injury or poisoning, and providing information about the pesticide(s) to which the person may have been exposed.
