Merry Christmas and Happy New Year

It's hard to believe another year has come and gone. As always, it's been very busy at the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF). We are seeing major growth in the industry. The current value of agriculture in Louisiana is \$12 billion. That's more than double what the value of agriculture was when I took office in 2008.

The year 2014 was a productive one. We started dismantling the Lacassine syrup mill following its sale in November 2013. The site is now being leased by Ohio based company Porocel which has a manufacturing plant in Broussard, La. Porocel is investing millions of dollars in site improvements and will employ approximately 50 people.

On the emergency management front, the Animals in Disaster Advisory Group (ADAG) was formed by the LDAF and the Stephenson Disaster Management Institute (SDMI) to help keep animals out of harm's way during a disaster. The LDAF is required by law to protect the health and welfare of animals during an emergency. ADAG is made up of individuals representing local, state, and federal governments, academia, and private institutions with expertise in emergency animal preparedness, response and recovery.

This year, we implemented the FASTER fleet management system in the department. The new system has

enhanced oversight of fleet operations to include automated preventative maintenance recordation, scheduling and inventory control. The FASTER system tracks operational costs of each vehicle, aircraft, and piece of equipment in LDAF inventory. This system will soon be interfaced with the agency's GPS system. The LDAF will be the first agency in Louisiana to have an automated central repository for all vehicle information and it will assist management in obtaining oversight of vehicle use.

We also maintained strong regulatory programs to benefit the agricultural community and the entire state as to protect Louisiana's public health,

environment and economy through aggressive monitoring and management.

Our current budget is 29% less than fiscal year 2008 with a collective savings to Louisiana taxpayers of more than \$120 million. During that same time period, we have reduced our debt and liabilities by more than 61% from approximately \$120 million to \$38 million.

On a national level, the Agricultural Act of 2014 (the Farm Bill) finally became law. It was a two year battle but passage of the act will drive food, farm, conservation, trade, research, energy policies and much more for the next five years. It will also make a significant impact on our state and national economies as well as security.

As I reflect on the past year, I am very thankful for the dedicated employees of the LDAF, our hard working agricultural producers and foresters, and for the citizens of this great state. Make time to spend with family and friends. The memories made spending time with loved ones can never be replaced. As we celebrate with our own loved ones and count our many blessings, consider reaching out to those who may be alone this holiday season.

My wife Susan, son Michael, daughter Melissa and I wish each and every one of you the merriest Christmas, the most festive Hanukkah, and a happy New Year. Let there be peace on Earth, and may you find warmth and happiness with family and friends in the true spirit of the season.

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Mobile Pet Shelter for Disasters Becoming a Reality

Construction is expected to begin this month for a mobile pet shelter scheduled to be in use by the 2015 hurricane season.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "The evacuation, transportation and sheltering of household pets during disasters has become necessary as a lifesaving measure. What we have experienced in the past are victims who have refused assistance unless their pets were accommodated."

The LDAF is designated by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act to evacuate, transport and shelter household pets during declared emergencies. A \$40,000 donation was made by the Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART), Dr. Walter J. Ernst, Jr. Veterinary Memorial

Foundation and Louisiana Veterinary Medical Association (LVMA) to help fund a project to develop a mobile pet sheltering system.

"The Louisiana State Animal Response Team, Dr. Walter J. Ernst, Jr. Veterinary Memorial Foundation and Louisiana Veterinary Medical Association are pleased to participate in funding this important capability for the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry to assist people with pets in getting out of harm's way during disasters and emergencies. We appreciate the role of LSU and the Stephenson Disaster Management Institute (SDMI) in making this possible," said H. Bland O'Connor, Jr., Executive Director, Louisiana Veterinary Medical Association.

"The Animals in Disaster Advisory Group (ADAG) under the

LSU Stephenson Disaster Management Institute is made up of individuals representing local, state and federal governments, academia and private institutions with expertise in emergency animal preparedness, response and recovery matters. The ADAG focuses on utilizing a strategic approach to improving the care of animals during an emergency. The ultimate objective is to save lives and prevent the suffering of both humans and animals involved in a disaster. This generous donation will help us complete this important project by providing a much needed capability to shelter and care for animals impacted by a disaster," said Pat Santos, Chairman of the ADAG.

LDAF's household pet plan includes 48-53 foot transport trucks with assembled pet cages and staff to assist parishes with the evacuation,

transportation and sheltering of evacuees' pets. The LDAF's current pet sheltering plan can accommodate thousands of pets at mega pet shelters. The new mobile pet shelter unit will also be used in search and rescue missions and will be available, upon request, to other states during a disaster.

Strain added, "The benefit of a mobile pet shelter is immediate onsite sheltering and care of pets affected by a disaster, the ease of safe transport of pets, reduced expense of sheltering and care and the ability to relocate quickly to be co-located with pet owners."

The project includes a tractor trailer that will have a 60 pet capacity. It will be equipped with metal cages, feed, water bowls and a wash down system. It will have an air ventilation system to provide proper air

circulation and temperature for the pets.

The total cost of the project is approximately \$80,000. The LDAF will provide the additional funding.

Poinsettia time is here

HAMMOND – The Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday season means it's time for poinsettias.

"You can start selecting poinsettias most years around Thanksgiving week, and they are generally available in good numbers until Christmas," said LSU AgCenter horticulturist Allen Owings.

People can expect poinsettias to last well into 2015 if they give proper consideration to selection and care, he said.

Poinsettias are available in a tremendous variety of leaf – or bract – colors, including red, white, marble, pink and combinations of these colors. Red poinsettias continue to represent around 90 percent of the market, although other colors are increasing in popularity.

"The new poinsettias of various colors and those with different leaf shapes are referred to as novelty types," Owings said.

He said points to consider when purchasing poinsettias include the size and number of the colored bracts. They should be large and extend over the lower green leaves.

"The number and size of bracts usually dictate plant price," Owings said. "A premium-quality poinsettia usually has at least six bracts and should have more."

Purchasers also should inspect the lower green leaves on poinsettias. Leaves should have good appearance and extend over the rim of the pot. Drooping leaves may indicate problems.

"You also should check for insects, primarily white flies, underneath the lower leaves," the horticulturist said. "The most important observation that can be made before purchasing a poinsettia is inspection of the green flower parts – called cyathia – in the center of the bracts. These flower parts indicate display life."

Plants with large cyathia showing yellow pollen and sap will have the least amount of display life left. Plants with smaller cyathia, little to no pollen and no sap will have the longest display life. A poinsettia should last for four to six weeks in the home with proper care.

"To prolong the beauty and health of poinsettias once they are in the home, proper care is essential," Owings said. "Although poinsettias do not become acclimated to interior settings as well as most foliage plants, it is easy to be successful."

Select a location that receives some sunlight. Interior hallways are a poor location. It also is very important to avoid exposing the plant to sudden temperature changes, so don't place a poinsettia near a ventilation system or in a drafty spot near a doorway. But temperatures in most homes are acceptable, and the ideal is to provide 70- to 75-degree daytime temperatures and 62- to 65-degree nights.

As for watering, Owings said to allow the soil surface to dry out thoroughly before watering with warm water. Just the soil surface should be dry to the touch before watering again.

Avoid water or mist on the colored bracts, and do not let the poinsettia stand in water for more than 30 minutes to an hour, he said.

"Along with poinsettias, amaryllis, Norfolk Island pines, orchids, Christmas cactuses and several other plants can be used to brighten your home during the holiday season," Owings said.

You can plant a vegetable garden any time

BATON ROUGE – Just about any time of year is a good time to plant vegetable seeds in Louisiana.

"If you're just itching to plant something now, try beet and spinach seeds," said LSU AgCenter vegetable specialist Kiki Fontenot. "And you can sow seeds of kale and mustard greens."

Dinosaur kale is a "fun" plant with its crinkled leaves, she said. This is a cold-hardy plant, and the leaves make good oven-fried kale chips – "a healthy option that tastes great."

Wait until mid-January to sow lettuce seeds, Fontenot said. Good lettuce varieties are Sierra, Nevada, Lolo Rosso, Tango, Panisse and Skyphos, a buttercrunch type.

A common mistake is planting lettuce seed too deeply. Many lettuce varieties require sunlight for germination, so the best way to plant them is to scatter the seed on the row and lightly rake it into the soil. Keep the soil moist until the seeds have germinated and are well established.

"You can plant transplants of cabbage, broccoli and cauliflower," she said. And December is a good time to plant bulbing onions.

Cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower and greens planted now should be covered if freeze or frost is predicted because they haven't had time to harden off. Otherwise, they're hardy in Louisiana.

If you're looking for vegetables like

broccoli or cauliflower, insects shouldn't be much of a problem. If you want to harvest the leaves, however, you need to control the pests.

Cabbage, on the other hand, can have insect problems if they get into the head before it firms up, Fontenot said. Because they're hidden in the center of the plant, the insects cause damage that won't be apparent until the head is harvested and cut. Then you'll find tunnels where the insects have been feeding.

If you see holes in the leaves of these plants, look for loopers, worms and caterpillars, Fontenot said. Because they feed at night, these insects may be difficult to spot.

Because we generally don't eat leaves from broccoli and cauliflower, these plants can tolerate more worm, looper and caterpillar damage. Cabbage, on the other hand, needs to be watched carefully.

If you do have problems, you can treat with Sevin dust, Bt or spinosad. Be sure to follow label directions on any pesticide you use in your garden.

And with cold weather upon us, gardeners should remember to cover strawberries when a freeze or frost threatens.

"The plants are hardy, but the blossoms will be damaged and won't produce berries," Fontenot said. "You'll have to wait for the next bloom."

Cold snap good for Louisiana citrus

HOUMA – Citrus fruit are becoming sweeter and juicier with cooler temperatures, according to LSU AgCenter agent Barton Joffrion in Terrebonne Parish.

Growers in the southern part of the state have been picking for about a month now, and on those nights the temperatures drop to near freezing helps the fruit, and also helps the trees prepare for the colder months of January and February, Joffrion said.

Houma citrus grower John Rogers has been picking since early October and says the crop is good and getting better.

"We've been picking satsumas for about 30 days," Rogers said. "The cool weather we've been having lately has really helped the fruit come along."

Satsumas ripen and are in stores before navel oranges, Rogers said. Navels must be tested for their sucrose level and must score a 10 before they are allowed to be sold.

"We normally have them sweet and ready to go right after the first frost," Rogers said.

Blossoms were a little later this past spring, Joffrion said. That has pushed the fruit back a few weeks and is causing the citrus to be smaller.

Rogers said not to let the small size fool you, though. The smaller satsumas are full of juice, so you will get more for your

money.

Beginning in October, growers normally begin to harvest lemons, satsumas and kumquats, and from late November through early December, oranges, grapefruit and other citrus should reach the full color stage, according to LSU AgCenter agent Rene Schmit in St. Charles Parish.

Color tends to be an issue with a lot of consumers, but Alan Vaughn, LSU AgCenter agent in Plaquemine Parish, says color is not as important as most consumers think.

"Passing the Louisiana Department of Agriculture test for sweetness is the key,"

Vaughn said. "Most satsumas can pass the test before the greenish color turn orange."

Vaughn said cold weather can even turn the orange color back to a green, so temperature and day length play a major role in ripeness.

Joffrion said growers are excited about the recent cold snaps because they know they prepare their trees for what's to come, in addition to improving the sugar content of the fruit.

Rogers and other growers are in the middle of the satsuma selling season, which will be ending in late December or early January.

"The navels will be coming in by late December, and they should last until late February or early March," Rogers said.
