THE SMALLEST CATTLE IN THE WORLD

For 72-year-old Jerome Hammons, farming is the only life he knows in Many, La. "I've worked cattle and horses all my life," said Hammons.

Along the way, he has managed to pick up some hobbies. "Fifteen years ago, I went to Texas to buy some miniature horses. In the corner of the yard, I saw something I'd never seen before."

Hammons was told he was purchasing a miniature Zebu which is related to western breeds of cattle. They are native of India, Africa and Southeast Asia. "I've learned they are some of the oldest and smallest breed of cattle."

The first miniature Zebu bought was a little bull for Hammons' grandson. "We fell in love with him, but he needed a girlfriend."

Hammons also started showing his new breed of cattle from California to Florida. Hammons said more and more people are buying them as pets.

"They can range in price from \$500 on up. They're so easy to care for and they don't eat nearly as much as a big cow."

Hammons said when he started purchasing the miniature cows and bulls, there were about 1,000 registered breeders in the U.S.; now, he estimates there are more than 4,000.

Pete Rudesill found Hammons after Hammons put an ad in the Market Bulletin. "I've had horses and cattle all my life," said Rudesill. "I have miniature horses too, but I'd never heard of miniature cows until I saw the ad in the Market Bulletin. Boy, are they cute!" Rudesill planned to buy a cow and a bull as

pets for his grandkids.

Hammons said lots of people are buying miniature Zebu for 4-H projects. "It's a good way for children to start showing cows and bulls because they are small and a little easier to handle. They all have personalities of their own, but their size makes a difference," said Hammons. "I love 4-H and Future

Farmers of America. It's good, clean fun for kids while teaching them responsibility," added Hammons.

Hammons still competes and shows his miniature Zebu. He's won more than 25 championships with just one bull. Miniature Zebu eligible for competition must not be taller than 42 inches. Their weight

usually varies between 200 – 600 pounds, and their lifespan is 20-plus years. They vary in color, gray being the most common. According to the American Miniature Zebu Association, they are disease and insect resistant.

Arrests Made in Cattle Thefts

Baton Rouge (December 18, 2014) – Two men are under arrest following an investigation by the Louisiana Livestock Brand Commission for allegedly stealing three cows and selling them at the Kinder Livestock Auction in Kinder, La.

Allen Tyler Meylian, 20, from Kinder and Jacob Chance Constance, 23, from Lake Charles were booked into Allen Parish Jail today and each was

charged with one count of theft of livestock.

According to an investigator with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Brand Commission, the two suspects reportedly removed old back tags from three cows that were being held at Kinder Livestock Auction. Back tags are a temporary form of identification used on cattle in livestock markets.

The stolen cows were given

new tags indicating they were owned by one of the suspect's relatives. The three cows sold on Monday, December 15, 2014 and a check for \$4170.97 was written to the suspect's relative. Investigators say Jacob Constance accepted the check.

A Kinder Livestock Auction employee contacted the Brand Commission on Tuesday, December 16, 2014 to report the theft. Brand inspection records and animal health

traceability records confirmed the three cows sold in the name of the suspect's relative were the same three cows missing from the pen where they were being held by their owner.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "This case highlights the importance of livestock identification and our animal health traceability systems which clearly helped to verify that those were indeed the stolen cattle."

Cornbread

1½ cup cornmeal	2 tbsps. sugar (optional)
½ cup flour	¼ cup oil
1 tsp. salt	1½ cup milk
1 tbsps. baking power	

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Combine all ingredients and mix well. Pour into a 9 inch greased cast iron skillet and bake for approximately 30 minutes or until golden brown.

Black-Eyed Peas

2 tbsps. oil	1 lb. smoked sausage
2 cups small dice yellow onion	1 lb. dried black-eyed peas, rinsed
¾ cup diced green bell pepper	2 quarts chicken stock
½ cup diced celery	1 tsp. bay leaves
2 tbsps. minced garlic	1 tsp. oregano
1 ½ lbs. ham hocks	Salt, pepper and hot sauce to taste

In a medium to large Dutch oven, over medium-high heat and add oil and onions. Sauté until onions are clear and browning. Add peppers and celery; sauté until soft. In center of pot, add garlic and sauté for about 30 seconds. Add ham hocks and sausage and sauté another 4 to 5 minutes. Add chicken stock, bay leaves and oregano; bring to boil. Cover and reduce heat to a simmer, stirring occasionally, until ham hocks and peas are tender, about 3 hours. Remove ham hocks, set aside to cool. When cool, remove the meat and return to pot. Discard bones and skin. Season to taste. When ready to serve, return to simmer. Garnish each bowl with chopped green onions if desired.

Honey Spiced-Rubbed Pork Tenderloin

¼ cup Catalina Dressing, divided	1 tsp. dry mustard
1 large pork tenderloin	½ tsp. paprika
1 tsp. red pepper	¼ tsp. dried thyme leaves
1 tsp. garlic powder	1 tbsps. honey

Brush 2 tablespoons of dressing over pork. Mix dry ingredients: rub onto pork. Let stand 10 minutes to 24 hours to marinate. Preheat grill to medium heat. Place pork on grill; cover. Grill 20 minutes, turning occasionally. Mix remaining 2 tablespoons dressing and honey. Brush some of the honey mixture over pork. Continue grilling 5 to 10 minutes, turning and brushing with honey mixture until pork is cooked through (160 degrees). Cover with foil and let stand, for a few minutes before serving.

Your anonymous tip which leads to the arrest and conviction may get you a cash reward. The sooner a crime is reported the better chances of recovering the stolen items.

A BRAND IS A COW'S ONLY RETURN ADDRESS

The deadline to register your brand for the next five year period passed on September 1, 2014. However, applications for brand renewals have been extended to Dec. 31, 2014. If the owner fails to renew the brand, it will be forfeited on the last day of the year and may thereafter be issued to another applicant.

The Livestock Brand Commissioner mailed out renewal notices to all brand owners to remind them of this. The fee for the next five years is \$10.00. The fee must be mailed in to avoid delays in processing your renewal.

Louisiana farmer recognized as 2014's best at national rice conference

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — Fred Zaunbrecher, a rice farmer in Acadia Parish and a member of the Louisiana Rice Research Board, was honored on Dec. 8 as Farmer of the Year at the USA Rice Federation Outlook Conference.

Zaunbrecher, a fifth-generation farmer, was recognized for his farming career and leadership in the rice industry. He graduated from LSU with a master's degree in agronomy.

He farms rice, crawfish and soybeans on 4,600 acres with his brothers — Paul, Philip and Bill — and he said their commitment to the farm allowed him to participate in organizations including the USA Rice Federation.

He credited his parents and his wife, Candee, for his farming success. "It takes a very special person to live with a farmer," he said.

His father, Glenn Zaunbrecher, worked at the LSU AgCenter Rice Research Station in Crowley before farming.

Steve Linscombe, director of the Rice Research Station, said the Zaunbrechers are outstanding farmers. "The farming operation of this group of brothers is one of the most progressive in the region," Linscombe said.

Linscombe said Zaunbrecher is one of the most active rice industry leaders in Louisiana. "He understands that the success of his operation is dependent on the contributions and hard work of all the individuals within his group."

Also Dec. 8, Hayes rice farmer Paul Johnson and Dustin Harrell, LSU AgCenter agronomist and the next LSU AgCenter rice specialist, were among seven individuals chosen for the Rice Leadership Development Program.

Others chosen for the class are Nicole Creason of Jonesboro, Arkansas; Hudgens Jeter of Stuttgart, Arkansas; Greg Van Dyke of Pleasant Grove, California; Nat McKnight of Cleveland, Mississippi; and Collin Holzhauser of Harrisburg, Arkansas.

A Jennings high school student, Penny Lejeune, was recognized with a \$3,000 scholarship for her project in the National Rice Month competition.

Kent McKenzie, a former LSU AgCenter rice breeder at the Rice Research Station, was honored with the Rice Industry Award. He became the director of the California Cooperative Rice Research Foundation in 2000, and he has developed several short- and medium-grain varieties for California growers.

Johnny Saichuk, retiring LSU AgCenter rice specialist, gave an overview of the 2014 growing season in Louisiana. He said the south Louisiana second crop was one of the best ever. The good yields are a testimony to the resilience of rice that went through a cold spring, he said.

Saichuk said more farmers are taking advantage of forward contracting because it reduces their risks.

Linscombe reviewed the research efforts by the LSU AgCenter. He said breeding work on the Provisia rice technology project is making progress, with 12 rice lines being grown now at the winter nursery in Puerto Rico. It will allow farmers an alternative to Clearfield technology in the control of red rice. "We think Provisia is going to be a huge step forward."

Hybrid work at the station continues to advance, he said, with an emphasis on grain quality.

A University of Arkansas economist, Robert Coats, projected that Arkansas farmers will plant 1.3 million acres of rice in 2015, including 250,000 acres of medium-grain. The state grew 1.6 million acres in 2014.

Arkansas is the leading rice producer among the six major rice producing states, accounting for roughly half the rice grown in the U.S.

The incoming governor of Arkansas, Asa Hutchinson, opened the conference. He said American

foreign policy should not hurt American farmers, and the Russian grain embargo of the 1980s is a good example of the harm that can be done to farmers.

He said during the past 20 years, rice farmers have decreased their water and energy needs considerably while dramatically increasing their yields and decreasing soil loss.

Forage producers discuss nutrition at annual meeting

ALEXANDRIA, La. — Forage producers discussed the benefits of different forage systems and human nutrition at the Louisiana Forage and Grass Council's annual conference on Dec. 5.

LSU AgCenter forage specialist Ed Twidwell, who serves as secretary for the council, said each year they try to bring in a variety of speakers, which includes people from the industry and producers to give their experiences in growing forages.

"If I had to name an overall theme for this year's meeting, I think it would be growing forages for the late summer and early fall," Twidwell said. "We had some producers talk about the things they plant to help to get them through

that period."

That is typically the period of the year when it's pretty dry and there's not a lot of forage production, Twidwell said. Producers like to plant something in the summer that will carry them into winter.

A producer panel discussed various options for late summer and early fall forage production. Some of the options discussed were forage radishes, cowpeas, stockpiling Bermuda grass and Alyce clover.

Twidwell said the market for forage-fed beef seems to be increasing across the state with the growing number of farmers markets and the demand for locally grown products.

"But I would want growers to be aware that it takes high-quality forage and a lot of it to be successful in that market," he said.

On the program promoting the consumption of beef and other animal products was Peter Ballerstedt, forage product manager for the Barenburg Group in Tangent, Oregon.

Ballerstedt said many Americans believe fat from animal products is bad for their health, but can in fact be part of a healthy diet.

"A number of people would be able to restore their health by switching to a diet that is lower in carbohydrates and higher in animal products," he said, noting that most of the carbs Americans eat come from cereal grains and caloric sweeteners.

It doesn't matter what type of animal products, Ballerstedt said. "Whether it's beef, pork, chicken or fish, barring certain food allergies, they are all acceptable."
