## Spirit of Louisiana

*Bayou Rum might be the new bottle on the shelf but this craft distillery is quickly gaining notoriety for its top notch product.*

It doesn't take long to recognize Trey Litel has a passion for Louisiana and all it has to offer. Shortly after graduating from LSU in 1985, the Lake Charles native landed a marketing job with rum giant Bacardi, the largest privately held, family-owned spirits company in the world. That job took him to California, South Carolina and Florida.

Following a stint with RC Cola and the computer industry, Litel decided he missed the beverage business.

"I came home to visit family and we always talked about why there wasn't a world class rum from Louisiana. To me, it was a no-brainer with all of the sugarcane we grow. We've been making sugar in Louisiana since the 1700s," said Litel.

So Litel, his brother, Tim, and business partner Skip Cortese started looking at the craft distilling industry and what it would take to build a distillery.

Litel said they needed raw material so they began talks with mills but ran into roadblocks. They also needed land because they knew they wanted their business to be a destination, so they bought 22 acres of land in Lacassine located in Jefferson Davis Parish.

However, they still needed a local source of sugar and molasses. That's where M.A. Patout & Sons Sugar Mill out of New Iberia came into the picture.

"We were introduced to the Patout's by sugar industry veteran Roddy Hewlett and we found a great partner," said Litel. Bayou Rum was officially founded in May 2011. By July 2013, their product was available. In November 2013, the distillery was open to the public.

"I don't have a farming background but I know rum. We believe Louisiana's raw materials are far superior than what other rum makers use. Louisiana cane is just hardier."

Litel said their method of making rum is also unique. "There are differences in the sugarcane intensity of sweetness and the type of yeast we use which is born off of sugarcane. How we distill our rum in copper pot stills and mature the product also contributes to the great taste," added Litel. They are even using Louisiana satsumas for their Satsuma Rum Liqueur.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## More charges filed against LaSalle Parish man for timber theft

Baton Rouge, La. (December 23, 2014) - An investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has resulted in two more felony timber theft charges for a Jena man. In all, this makes a total of eight felony timber theft counts against James Marcus Ainsworth since September.

Ainsworth, 39, of 254 Joiner Road was arrested last Friday morning by forestry agents and booked into the LaSalle Parish jail on two counts of felony timber theft totaling just over \$14,600.

Investigators say complaints were filed by two LaSalle Parish landowners. The first complaint was made by an Olla couple who was promised \$5,000-\$6,000 for a thinning operation on 28 acres. However, LDAF investigators say additional timber was cut while the landowner was away. The second complaint was made by a Trout man who was initially told he would receive \$6000-\$10,000 for timber on his 11 3/4 acres, but he only received \$1,240. The timber on both tracts was cut during the months of July and October 2013.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "Our investigators found that Ainsworth cut the timber with the landowner's permission and that he was paid promptly for the timber. No scale tickets, settlement sheets or loader's log were ever received by either landowner as required under state law. They simply received a check for a fraction of what they were promised."

Ainsworth was originally arrested in September by forestry agents and booked into the LaSalle Parish jail on one count of felony timber theft of more

than \$10,400. Ainsworth was arrested again by forestry investigators on October 2 in LaSalle Parish for an additional count of felony timber theft of more than \$28,000. Ainsworth was then arrested on October 31 for two additional counts of timber theft in Catahoula Parish totaling nearly \$29,000 and again on November 24 for two counts of timber theft in LaSalle Parish totaling nearly \$12,500.

sourced in Louisiana products." Litel says that was very important to them because of the farm to table movement. "Everyone wants to know where their food and beverage products come from."

Besides Louisiana, Bayou Rum is available in Alabama, Florida, Mississippi and Texas. Canada will receive its first shipment in January. The company will launch in Georgia and Maryland in March 2015 and plans to ship to New York later in the year.

"We're getting inquiries from all over. We sell to mom and pop liquor stores, local restaurants and bars. We are also in Wal-Mart, Sam's, Costco and the New Orleans Superdome."

Litel said with 62 rum brands sold in Louisiana, Bayou Rum is the fifth best seller in a one-year period. "To date, we have won 52 tasting awards including international competitions." Litel says those honors include "Best in Class" at the Miami Rum Festival, American Crafts Spirits Association and

from the American Distilling Institute.

"Sugarcane generates \$2.7 billion toward our economy and rum is a value added agricultural product. We built a state of the art facility and invested \$12 million before we ever shipped a case of our rum," said Litel. "American rum has never been done this way. There's no reason we can't make a world-class rum from Louisiana sugarcane in Lacassine. We can't fail. We want to make it better every step of the way," he added.

Starting in January, the distillery will offer bottling opportunities on a volunteer basis. Litel says participants will be served lunch and at the end of the shift, the volunteer will get a bottle of rum of their choice, a t-shirt and a Bayou Bottling Crew signed certificate.

Gardeners are no exception to wishing for the better – better gardens, better planning, better record keeping, etc. Here are five resolutions – with a few modifications – that our friends at the National Garden Bureau recommended a few years back. They would certainly be appropriate for Louisiana gardeners to consider in 2015.

– To start, don't blame yourself for gardening failures. Oftentimes, Mother Nature is not our friend when it comes to gardening. Or life gets in the way. We do not want you to despair. Simply try again and learn from experience. Your garden, and your gardening friends, are both extremely forgiving.

– "I will not be afraid to ask questions" is a great gardening resolution. How else can you learn? Take advantage of the experience of your neighbor, your aunt, the garden center employee, Louisiana Master Gardeners or the local extension agent. They will appreciate your interest and be flattered that you want to learn from them. You cannot learn by sitting back.

– "I will try new plants" is a popular resolution. This is kind of a no-brainer, right? Have you ever met a gardener who didn't want the newest of the new – for bragging rights, if nothing else? But what about really new ... like a new growing style or completely new crop of vegetables. Cruise around on Pinterest, and you're sure to find something irresistible that's out of your usual comfort zone. Try an LSU AgCenter Louisiana Super Plant that

– "Sharing my passion for gardening and landscaping" is another suggested resolution.
