Little Green Thumbs

The garden club members at Winbourne Elementary in Baton Rouge are bubbling with energy as they talk about what they've

learned this year. "I like to watch them grow," said seven year old Malaysia Battley. The second grader is one of 12 first through

fourth graders who is a member of the garden club.

"We went out to our garden and saw different vegetables like cabbage and made the observation that some plants are alive and some are not. Some plants just can't grow in the winter," added eight year old Aaliyah Knighten.

The garden club was initiated this school year at the Baton Rouge elementary school under the City Year AmeriCorps program where tutors and mentors work in elementary and middle schools and provide math, reading, writing, attendance and behavioral health. AmeriCorp member Maya Curtis is heading up the garden club at Winbourne.

"They just enjoy everything. We introduce them to fruits and vegetables and we talk about what they eat and where it really comes from." She added, "In the long run, we hope this helps them get interested in making healthy choices."

Troy Chapman, Impact Manager for City Year at Winbourne, added, "I think this encourages them to work togeth-



er. I've looked into food deserts and this is a way to look at things differently. Hopefully, it will improve their community and they will share what they learn. Plus, it exposes them to other things and helps their growth."

At the beginning of the school year, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, Southern University Agriculture center and the Early Risers Kiwanis Club provided the resources needed to grow a garden. Right now, and while the weather is frigid, the garden club is focusing on learning how the ecosystem works and they've even made drawings of what their dream gardens would be like.

"As it gets warmer, we will bring in a representative from the Farmers Market to talk to the kids and explain the importance of supporting the local farmer. We're

also excited about getting outside and picking the cabbage and other vegetables and integrate that into the lessons. I know they're ready to get their little hands dirty!" said Curtis.

Some of the students say they wished they had gardens of their own at home. "I like the garden because it has lots of vegetables," added seven year old Jahleel Williams.

The club also offers an opportunity for the students to develop friendships with students in other grades.

Curtis says she hopes to develop a cookbook using family recipes provided by the garden club students. She also envisions a space that provides a learning experience and a peace garden. She says they want to add benches and a welcome sign for people who visit the garden.

Strain urges Congress to pass consistent food labeling standard

Genetically engineered (GE) or genetically modified products have gained much opposition in recent years. Unfortunately, we are in a vicious battle where legislation is being proposed that is not based on sound science. In states around the country, there are laws that would mandate the labeling of GE products. Not only would state labeling laws stigmatize an important proven technology, they would also drastically increase the price of food. A recent Cornell study showed the increase could be as high as \$500 a year for the average family of four.

The reality is biotechnology has the ability to help farmers grow more crops on less land, using fewer pesticides and water and emitting less greenhouse gas. Even Bill Gates has touted the potential of GE products to help feed a growing world population. Study after study has found biotechnology to be safe for both humans and the environment. In fact, a recent survey by the Pew Research Center found that nearly 90 percent of America's scientists believe GE products to be completely safe. Furthermore, I have not seen a single peer-reviewed research health-

related study that indicates otherwise.

As Louisiana's agriculture and forestry commissioner, I understand that it is critically important to make sure our government doesn't pass laws that put our farmers at a competitive disadvantage. Almost 90 percent of corn and 94 percent of soy grown in the United States are genetically modified, according to the US Department of Agriculture. The farmers I represent depend on this technology to grow more crops using fewer resources at a cheaper cost ultimately passing on the savings to

you the consumer.

Last week, at the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture meeting, a resolution was passed calling for federal legislation on this issue. We need a national, consistent labeling standard that is easy to understand and based on sound science, public health and nutrition. My fellow commissioners and secretaries of agriculture voted unanimously in favor of the resolution. This should send a clear signal to Congress that the agricultural community stands united on this issue. American farmers and consumers

deserve food policy that is solely driven by science and facts. I urge Congress to enact legislation that meets that fundamental goal.





Important ARC and PLC deadlines fast approaching

(Alexandria, La.), February 13, 2015 - U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Louisiana Farm Service Agency (FSA) State Executive Director, Craig A. McCain, reminds producers and landowners that the deadline to participate in the ARC and PLC Programs is fast approaching.

Taking appropriate action by the following dates is crucial to program participation as the elections will be longstanding and will affect future benefits through the life of the 2014 Farm Bill.

The last day for landowners to make decisions concerning base reallocation and/or to update yields is February 27, 2015.

In addition, the last date for a current producer to make decisions concerning the election of ARC or PLC is March 31, 2015. Farms with a covered commodity base, on which no election decision is made prior to the deadline, will be defaulted to PLC for all covered commodity bases on the farm for the life of

the Farm Bill.

Customers are encouraged to make an appointment and make the necessary decisions concerning updating yields and/or re-allocating bases as soon as possible. Decisions concerning program elections can be revised through the election deadline, however, no revisions are allowed after the deadline.

Producers and landowners are strongly encouraged to contact your local county office now to make an appointment, unless you have already done so. For more information, visit www.fsa.usda.gov/arc-plc.

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
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LDAF annual shade tree seedling sale is in March

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) will hold its annual shade tree seedling sale on various dates throughout the state, Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.



contain two seedlings including water oak, sawtooth oak, willow oak, shumard oak and bald cypress. Pine packets are \$6 each and hardwood packets are \$2 each. Packet species content

may vary in some cases, depending on availability. All seedlings are bare-root and come with planting and care instructions. They will be available on a first-come basis and cannot be reserved in advance.

“Our orchard-grown hardwood and pine seedlings are descended from superior stock,” Strain said. “Since the seedlings can be purchased in small packets, they are manageable for just about any home gardener.”

“Some years we sell out of certain species before the week is out, especially some of the hardwoods, so we encourage folks to come early during the sale,” Strain said.

Two types of seedling packets will be offered.

Pine seedling packets contain 20 advanced generation loblolly with the exception of the Opelousas location, which will be advanced generation slash pine. Hardwood seedling packets

USDA accepting applications for FY15 Rural Energy for America Program (REAP)

USDA Rural Development State Director Clarence W. Hawkins announced recently that the USDA is soliciting grant and loan applications for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Rural Energy for America Program (REAP).

Rural small businesses and rural or urban farmers are eligible to apply for funding for energy projects that serve their farm or business operations. Eligible projects include those using wind energy, solar energy, biomass heat, power, or fuels; anaerobic digestion, geothermal energy, and a wide variety of energy efficiency technologies and upgrades.

REAP grants fund up to 25% of the costs of a renewable energy or energy efficiency project, up to a maximum award of \$500,000. REAP guaranteed loans can be made for up to 75% of project costs, up to a maximum of \$25 million. Both

FY14 and FY15 funds are simultaneously being released, adding up to over \$100 million and making this the largest single REAP solicitation ever. A special set-aside of \$20 million is allocated for small grant requests of \$20,000 or less.

REAP grant applications will be considered in two rounds, with deadlines of April 30 and June 30, 2015. Applicants requesting \$20,000 or less and wishing to compete for the special small grant set-aside must submit by April 30. REAP loan guarantee applications will be accepted and considered on a continuous basis. Applications are submitted to Louisiana's USDA Rural Development state office; grant-only applications may alternately be submitted through Grants.gov.

Past recipients are enjoying reduced energy consumption and increased efficiencies

with modern upgrades to equipment and buildings. One example includes Hebert's Supermarket located in Henderson, Louisiana. Owner, Mark Hebert received grant funding to upgrade their refrigeration and freezer equipment with modern energy-efficient rack systems. The upgrade proved better than expected results in reducing energy costs for the business.

The new final rule for REAP under the 2014 Farm Bill, published by USDA in December, outlines a number of changes to the program. Among other changes, application requirements have been streamlined for smaller requests, the second meter requirement for farmstead projects has been relaxed, scoring criteria have been modified, and eligibility for retail fuel pumps and feasibility study-only projects has been removed.



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
