Red River Flood Damages Ag Land

As the Red River flood waters continue to recede, farmers in the northern part of Louisiana are assessing the economic impact of the most recent disaster to strike this state.

“Are we supposed to be contacting FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency)?” That was

one of several questions Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. addressed when he visited the flood stricken area on June 12. Strain answered many questions including this one by telling the farmers he visited in Elm Grove, La. to contact their local Farm Service Agency (FSA) of-

fices first.

Agriculture and Forestry officials are currently working on an emergency declaration through the USDA to assist the farmers in their recovery process. Strain recommended that farmer’s get in the practice of keeping records, taking photographs and documenting all losses. “It’s not uncommon for the federal government to audit you if you receive some sort of assistance, so it is imperative you keep good records,” said Strain.

Bossier Parish farmer Drew Lefler expressed major concerns about his crop. “We’ve seen a tremendous amount of damage. We were prepared for some flooding, but nothing like what we got,” said Lefler.

Lefler added that the flooded corn field had four and a half feet of water.

“We won’t harvest a single bit of corn from that field. The good part is that most of our land is on the other side of the levee.”

Michael Simpson said his cattle were stranded and he was having difficulty feeding them. He worried he will lose them.

“Our biggest issue is how badly the forecast was missed. By the

time they revised the forecast, it was too late to move them out,” said Simpson. For cattle farmers, they worry about what diseases their cattle can get from flood waters and the impact stress will have on their cows. Other farmers expressed concerns about how long the water will stay, wiping out crops, hay and trees.

About 50 farmers visited with Strain in Powhatan. Again, he reiterated the importance of helping one another, ensuring animals stay alive and keeping good records of losses, feed costs and livestock. “Remember to stay safe during these tense times. The high water, utility outages and snakes all present problems,” added Strain.

Strain said he will work with the federal government to secure low interest loans with ample time to repay those loans and livestock indemnity programs.

It could be several weeks before the full economic impact of the damage is determined.

LaSalle Parish man attempts to evade authorities

A LaSalle Parish man was nabbed in Anchorage, Alaska while attempting to cross the border into Canada and now faces additional timber theft charges here in Louisiana. James Marcus Ainsworth, 39, of 254 Joiner Road, already faced eight felony timber theft counts. Friday, May 22 Ainsworth was charged with one more timber theft count in LaSalle Parish.

In the most recent incident, Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) investigators said Ainsworth cut 24 acres of timber in May and June 2014 for a landowner in Nebo, in La Salle Par-

ish. After the timber was cut, forestry agents said the landowner did not hear from Ainsworth and went to his home and confronted him about payment.

"During this meeting Ainsworth showed the landowner scale tickets and checks totaling \$30,000 telling the landowner this was the amount of timber that had been cut off the property. Ainsworth also told the landowner he should receive \$12,000 for his portion. Ainsworth was never able to provide the landowner with scale tickets specific to the landowner's property," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain.

Forestry investigators went to mills and wood dealers and recovered records showing Ainsworth cut 45 loads of timber valued at \$41,234.13 but the landowner only received \$3,400.

Investigators reported in early April, Ainsworth, his wife and daughter drove to the Chicago area, put all of their belongings in storage and then flew to Anchorage, Alaska with the intent to cross the border into Canada and avoid prosecution. Ainsworth's information was put in the National Crime Information Center, NCIC, and Ainsworth was arrested in Anchorage. Deputies

from the LaSalle Parish Sheriff's Office drove to Anchorage and brought Ainsworth back to Jena.

Ainsworth is currently in the LaSalle Parish Detention Center on \$1 million bond. In all, Ainsworth has seven timber theft charges in LaSalle Parish and two in Catahoula Parish.

Prior to the most recent arrest, Ainsworth is accused of stealing approximately \$100,000 worth of timber from landowners.



Southern Pimiento Cheese

8 oz. sharp Cheddar cheese, shredded	1/2 cup mayonnaise
8 oz. white Cheddar cheese, shredded	1 tsp. sea salt
1 cup roasted red bell peppers, finely chopped	1/2 tsp. dried celery flakes
	1/4 tsp. ground pepper

Shred both blocks of cheese and place in a medium mixing bowl. Add diced red peppers, mayonnaise and spices. Gently mix all ingredients together.

Cover and chill for at least an hour before serving.

Note: You can use jarred roasted red peppers instead of roasting your own. Use peppers in brine only, not oil, and be sure to drain completely and remove as much moisture as possible.

Egg and Cheese Breakfast Bites

3 large eggs, lightly beaten	1/4 cup chopped cooked ham, bacon or sausage
1/3 cup lactose-free milk	
Pinch of black pepper	1/2 cup shredded, reduced-fat Cheddar (2%) or Pepper-Jack cheese
6 slices whole-wheat bread, crusts removed	

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Spray 6 muffin tins with cooking spray. Mix eggs, milk and pepper in a small bowl. Press 1 slice of bread into each muffin cup, making a cup shape with bread. Pour egg mixture evenly into bread cups; top with ham, bacon or sausage. Bake 15 minutes or until eggs are cooked and not runny. Remove from oven and turn oven off. Top evenly with cheese and let stand in oven 5 minutes or until cheese melts. Remove from oven and let cool at least 5 minutes.

2 (8-oz.) packages cream cheese	1 cup sour cream

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Stir together graham cracker crumbs and 2 tablespoons sugar. Mix in butter. Press mixture evenly in bottom of 9-inch springform pan. Bake 10 minutes, then removed from oven and let cool. Reduce oven temperature to 300 degrees. Beat cream cheese in large bowl. Gradually add 1 cup sugar, beating until fluffy. Add vanilla. Beat in eggs, one at a time. Pour over crumb mixture. Bake one hour until center is firm. Let cool at room temperature and top with sour cream. Cover and let chill at least 3 hours.

Cornwell Sour Cream Pound Cake

3 sticks butter	1/4 tsp. baking soda
3 cups sugar	1 cup sour cream
6 large eggs	1 tsp. vanilla
3 cups cake flour	

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Cream butter. Gradually add sugar and beat until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Sift flour with baking soda; add alternately, with sour cream, beginning and ending with flour. Add vanilla and beat on low for 2 minutes. Pour into greased and floured tube pan. Bake 1 hour and 20 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pan on a wire rack 10 minutes. Remove cake from pan and cool completely on wire rack.

Did you know?

The Louisiana Agricultural Commodities Commission is responsible for the licensing and bonding of all commercial warehouses, grain dealers and cotton merchants doing business in Louisiana. Regulation of the Louisiana grain and cotton industry is necessary in order to help ensure the protection of those Louisiana producers that sell to Louisiana licensed grain dealers and/or cot-

ton merchants or store their agricultural commodities in Louisiana licensed warehouses. The Louisiana Agricultural Commodities Commission requires audited financial statements (which are carefully reviewed by experienced state auditors for their financial stability), proof of provisional stock insurance, and proof of security for all state licensed warehouses, grain dealers and cotton merchants.

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Farmers, gardeners must register cotton plants with the LDAF

All cotton planted in Louisiana, including cotton grown in ornamental gardens and other non-traditional locations must register with the state Boll Weevil Eradication office to be monitored for possible boll weevil presence, Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

State boll weevil eradication law requires anyone who intends to plant cotton for non-commercial purposes must receive prior permission from the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and

Forestry.

“While our state is officially boll weevil-free, we continue to monitor all cotton grown in the state to protect Louisiana’s cotton industry,” Strain said. “Boll weevil traps are set along the edges of cotton fields, but gardeners outside traditional cotton growing areas may plant cotton,



for example, to spin their own thread for fabric. Gardeners may also grow cotton for its ornamental appeal. In any case, we have to place a boll weevil trap nearby to be sure we preserve our boll weevil-free status.” Historically, the

boll weevil has been cotton’s most destructive pest. All cotton-growing states have eradication programs.

In 2014, 164,132 acres of cotton were harvested in Louisiana and the total value of cotton production was \$197.9 million.
