When Noma Fowler-Sandlin's husband became disabled, her hobby of making jams and jellies helped them get through that tough financial time. “I started making

jam when I was 14. As an adult, I was only working part-time when my husband got sick. So I started selling my jams and jellies at our local farmers market in Shreveport

which really helped supplement our income and keep us afloat.”

Since then, Fowler-Sandlin has become market manager for the Shreveport Farmers Market which has been in existence for over 25 years. Her son Graeme has taken over the jelly business, Pan's Pantry, and now sells in the market.

“I loved the market atmosphere. At the time, we had about 35 vendors and about 2,500 people visited on opening day. It was a very small market, but about three years ago, we built up to about 160 vendors and 12,000 people came through on opening day,” added Fowler-Sandlin.

In south Louisiana, Baton Rouge's Red Stick Farmers Market opened about 20 years ago located downtown on North Boulevard. “Our non-profit has a mission to build a healthy and strong food system and give opportunities to the small-scale family farm,” said Copper Alvarez, executive director of the Big River Economic and Agricultural Development

Alliance or BREADA.

In 2002, Red Stick Farmers Market expanded and moved to 5th and Main streets, located next to BREADA's public marketplace Main Street Market.

“At the time it was then Governor Mike Foster's dream to have a public market downtown and give state workers and visitors a place to eat lunch and enjoy local foods,” said Alvarez. When the farmers market moved to 5th Street as a compliment to Main Street Market, the number of visitors increased.

“We now are unique that our shoppers have a place to enjoy breakfast or lunch, and we are connected to the parking garage which gives us a rainy day location so rain or shine, we're open.”

On average, Alvarez says about 150,000 people attend the market each year. “We have a different audience during the week because it's mostly state employees and on any given Saturday, we could have a crowd of about 10,000.”

Both Alvarez and Fowler-Sandlin say people who are really

open to local foods visit the markets from all over. “At the market on a Saturday, everyone is taking it slower. In our urban environment, you don't have time to visit, but this gives people a chance to connect with one another,” said Alvarez.

Fowler-Sandlin added, “People like keeping their money in their community. Our vendors come from a 100 mile radius around our city. They know the vendors and farmers earn the money and spend it in the community, as well. It's all about getting to know the farmer too.”

The quality of the produce tends to be fresher because sometimes the farmers are picking the produce right before they get to market on a Saturday morning. That means a lot to the consumer who is both health and environmentally conscious.

“Some of our farmers come from larger farms. It's amazing to me that they still come to the market, but the farmers tell me that they *See Farmers Market, continued on page 20*

Arrest Made in Vermilion Parish cattle theft

Baton Rouge, La. (July 15, 2015) – A Vermilion Parish man is accused of stealing seven heifers and selling them at a stockyard.

Investigators with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission say a cattleman in Vermilion Parish reported to the Vermilion Parish Sheriff's Office and LDAF Brand Commission that seven heifers were missing from his pasture.

The cattle were described as black, black baldy or red. All had the cattleman's brand on the right hip.

LDAF investigators say after researching brand inspection records, animal health traceability records, and stockyard records, it was discovered that seven heifers fitting the description given by the cattleman and carrying his brand were sold at a Louisiana stockyard on June 15, 2015.

"This is why we urge cattle producers to have their property tagged or branded. In the event there is a theft and if the cattle stolen are a common breed, they are more identifiable and traceable if there is a unique brand or other identifier such as a tag," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Five of the heifers have been located in Louisiana and positively identified as those belonging to the cattleman. The other two

heifers were shipped to other states. The seven heifers were sold at the stockyard for a total of \$13,742.50.

Eighteen year old Jodi M. Richard of 404 Kibbe St., Erath, La. was arrested and booked into the Vermilion Parish Jail on July 14. Richard is charged with one count of theft. Bond is set at \$25,000.

If convicted, Richard faces up to 10 years in prison, up to \$10,000 in fines or both.




2015 First Quarter Market Summary

Stumpage prices paid for pine sawtimber during the first quarter of 2015 averaged \$246.00 per thousand board feet Doyle. This average represents a

6.36 percent decrease from the previous quarter and 3.18 percent decrease compared to a year ago. Prices paid for mixed hardwood sawtimber during the

first quarter of 2015 averaged \$344.28 per thousand board feet Doyle which is a 22.5 percent decrease from the previous quarter and 9.3 percent higher than

a year ago. Pulpwood stumpage prices averaged \$26.30 per standard cord for pine and \$27.45 per standard cord for hardwood.



This report is intended to serve only as a guide for timber stumpage prices and to monitor market trends. It should not be used to determine the fair market value of a specific timber sale. 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Researchers turn to nanoparticles to reduce pesticide use in ag

The soybean looper is a destructive pest on soybeans capable of defoliating fields if left unchecked. It can be difficult to control because of its resistance to many insecticides. LSU AgCenter scientists are looking at a novel way to increase the efficacy of pesticides to better control insects such as the soybean looper using nanotechnology.

Biological engineer Cristina Sabliov and entomologist Jeff Davis are testing the use of nanoparticles – particles 1,000 times smaller in width than a human hair – in insecticides to see if the particles help the chemical better adhere to the leaf tissue and provide better defense against pests. They want to see if the use of nanoparticles loaded with pesticides means farmers can use less chemicals on their crops while making the chemicals more effective.

The researchers are using nanoparticles made of zein, a biodegradable corn-derived protein. They entrapped the insecticide in technical-grade methoxyfenozide within the parti-

cles and applied it to leaves of soybean plants.

“The particles were designed to assist in electrostatic binding to the foliage or the roots of the soybean plant and to provide controlled release properties of the entrapped component,” Sabliov said.

The nanodelivery system was tested over two years against the soybean looper. Before they could test it with entrapped pesticide, however, they had to make sure the nanoparticles alone would not harm the soybean looper.

Davis said they fed the loopers a diet with and without nanoparticles and saw no mortality, demonstrating the particles without the insecticide would not hurt the pests.

Next, they looked to see if the nanoparticles would prolong the effectiveness of the insecticide when entrapped in the nanoparticle.

“We sprayed the plants and would feed the leaves to the soybean loopers at three days out, seven days out, up to 42 days,” Davis said.

The insecticide alone is usually

effective up to 14 days. But when used with nanoparticles, they saw good control of the soybean looper for 21 days.

The researchers said these results could mean that nanoparticles may help farmers spray less often and spray less of the chemical. But questions still remain on the safety of the nanoparticles, Davis said.

Kurt Ristroph, a student working in Sabliov’s lab, said they washed the plants sprayed with insecticides entrapped within the nanoparticles to simulate rain and checked to see how long the chemical would stay on the plant.

“The results are good. The particles seem to adhere well to leaves and wash out slowly over time” Ristroph said.

The scientists want to see the environmental effects of the nanoparticles before moving forward.

“To extend the applications of nanotechnology to agriculture with the specific purpose of improving pesticide functionality, we have to have a full understanding of the nanopesticide behavior within the plant and soil,” Sabliov said.

love meeting the people who buy and eat the foods they grow,” said Alvarez.

Both markets have cooking demonstrations, arts and crafts and special events to appeal to different groups. Every fourth Saturday of the month, the Red Stick Farmers Market has what’s called Sprouts Saturday. That’s where kids use tokens to purchase gelato, chocolate, produce and/or flowers. They get to sample certain foods and decide what they want to purchase. They get to talk to the farmer about where the produce comes from and using tokens, they learn how to do a money transaction because to participate in the program and receive \$2 in tokens from the market, the “sprout” is required to actually conduct the transaction with the vendor.

In Shreveport, they too have special events that bring music acts to the market and other entertainment such as people who use hula hoops and belly dancers. Like the Baton Rouge market, both have a brunch where food is cooked onsite.

“We consider the small market café as a small business incubator. People who want to start a restaurant can get a feel for how the business will operate. We have several people who’ve gone through the market and have opened up restaurants or catering companies,” said Fowler-Sandlin.

“I think so many of us have someone in our background who had a garden or a farm. We all want to

get back to that, but we don’t have the time,” said Alvarez. “We are seeing more and more people appreciating locally-grown food. This is why the farmers markets are growing in popularity.”

Alvarez added that one day she hopes the farmers market can be a food hub and distribute produce to schools and hospitals.

The Shreveport Farmers Market is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend at the Festival Plaza in downtown Shreveport located at 101 Crockett St. An afternoon market is open on Tuesdays starting the week of Memorial Day for seven weeks.
