## HOMEGROWN BY HEROES



*From seeds comes solace  
and a new identity for  
veterans*

Looking out for the wounded combat veteran is Jaye Townsend's calling these days. Townsend was in the U.S. Army infantry from 1998 to 2007 and is head of the Louisiana Armed Forces

Foundation. He, too, is a wounded combat veteran who lives in Baton Rouge and has been working to assist veterans to better transition back into society, especially in the field of agriculture.

"I read about the Homegrown By Heroes" program which started in Kentucky and contacted the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) to see if there was something we could do here," said Townsend.

Townsend established the Louisiana Armed Forces Foundation (LAFF) in 2011 in order to help combat veterans transition home to Louisiana. LAFF is partnering with the LDAF and various organizations, such as LSU and Southern Universities, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs and Wounded War Heroes and Farm Service Agency, to help establish pilot programs and a solid structure for veterans to work in the agricultural and seafood industries.

"Agriculture is an attractive industry because it focuses on developing and cultivating the land, it allows the farmer veterans to work the land with their hands which can also be therapeutic to them. Plus, it gives them a platform to sell what they produce and will hopefully give them a purpose," added Townsend.

Townsend said these veterans need to feel accepted when they come home. "A lot of guys come back and feel abandoned because people don't understand them or they feel unappreciated. It's good for the veterans to connect with a purpose. The Homegrown By Heroes brand allows for this connection to be made."

Kentucky initiated and announced the Homegrown by Heroes program in January 2013 after business development director Ben Shaffar was tasked to find out how to get more military veterans interested in agriculture. On Veteran's Day of that same year, Kentucky Ag entered into a partnership with the Farmer Veteran Coalition, a non-profit that assists farmer vets in agriculture at the national level.

"Kentucky Agriculture Commissioner James Comer spent some time with the Kentucky National Guard and was made aware of the high unemployment rate and pitfalls that occur for many of our military veterans. When he found out there were veterans working in agriculture, Comer asked me to look into what

we could do to push along this movement," said Shaffar.

Shaffar said he learned there were a number of agencies that were active in helping farmers increase their production and sales, but he also noticed there was not a marketing tool, such as the Kentucky Proud logo, to promote what their local farmer vets were doing. "I realized we needed to raise their profile from a marketing standpoint."

Right now, Kentucky has roughly 80 farmer veteran members who sell their products under the Homegrown By Heroes label mainly at farmers markets. Shaffar says they are also noticing a huge growth in demand from retailers and chefs who want to serve what these military veterans produce to their customers.

"Any military veteran or current service member who wants to join the program just needs to show an honorable discharge or something from their hierarchy that shows they are in good standing. They also have to show 50 percent ownership or management of the farm," said Shaffar.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Grant Awarded to LDAF to Support Food Safety

**Baton Rouge, La. (August 31, 2015)** – The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Agricultural Chemistry Programs Division was recently awarded a five year, \$3 million grant from the Food and Drug Administration in support of food safety efforts.

The Animal Feed Regulatory Program Standards (AFRPS) Cooperative Agreement will advance efforts to achieve a nationally integrated food safety

system.

The agreement will provide funding for the LDAF Feed Program, housed within the Agricultural Chemistry Programs Division on the LSU Campus in Baton Rouge. It will develop and maintain best practices, enhance feed safety and better direct regulatory activities at reducing foodborne illness attributed to feed safety hazards in facilities that manufacture, process, pack, or hold animal feed materials/

supplies. In addition, this cooperative agreement will provide funding for the LDAF Agricultural Chemistry Laboratory to pursue laboratory accreditation under the International Organization for Standards (ISO) 17025 criteria. The funding will assist in ensuring quality laboratory management and technical operations and support the analytical testing of feed products sampled by the LDAF Office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences

inspectors.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, “The job of the LDAF is to ensure a safe food supply through sampling and testing of foods available to the Louisiana consumer. Receiving this grant award allows us to continue our work to make sure food is safe for both people and animals.”

This cooperative agreement begins September 1, 2015 and ends August 31, 2020.



Shaffar says production varies by farmer veterans. "Some are using agriculture as a means of therapy, providing them solace and a new identity. It continues to give them that service mentality by providing Americans a fresh, healthy product."

Besides Kentucky and Louisiana, six states have signed on which include Arkansas, Illinois, Maine, Ohio, Pennsylvania and South Carolina. Several more states intend to enter into formal agreements soon.

The program is described as a consumer-driven brand so the goal is to have farmer veterans have as much success as possible at the market place. A lot is driven by packaging

and labeling. Also, farmers are aging and there aren't enough farmers to take their place. "We desperately need a new generation of American farmers and our veterans are stepping up to lead the next generation. We need to find ways to make sure our veterans are successful at the market place and the Homegrown By Heroes brand can aid in that pursuit. Moreover, the brand affords consumers a tangible way to give back to our veterans by buying their products, making it a win-win for everybody," said Shaffar.

Townsend said in a short period of time, about a dozen veterans have become involved with the program. In the

New Orleans area, a community garden will be planted in an area where duplexes are being built to provide affordable housing to the veterans coming home. A partnership with Istrouma Baptist Church is being finalized in Baton Rouge. Townsend says Istrouma plans to donate some land and provide counseling programs for the vets.
