Strain unveils mobile pet shelter

Many lessons were learned following Hurricane Katrina which battered the New Orleans area and changed the lives of so many people.

"I vividly remember how people were not paying close attention to this storm that was looming in the Gulf of Mexico. It was a weekend, school had just started and people were busy living their lives," said Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

But what happened on August 29, 2005 marked future changes in the way people prepare for storms and how they plan for evacuations. Many people who did not evacuate during Hurricane Katrina stayed behind because they had no transportation and in many cases did not know what to do with their pets.

"We're a bunch of veterinarians and every day we

work with people and their pets. We know how strong that human animal bond is. I know my clients would put themselves in harm's way to take care of their pets. Everyone knows that.

Katrina made the rest of the world aware of that," said Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART) Director Renee Poirrier, D.V.M.

In August, a new mobile pet shelter to assist in transporting and sheltering household pets during declared emergencies was unveiled at Lamar Dixon in Gonzales. The

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is designated by the Louisiana Homeland Security and

Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act to perform this duty.

"The purpose of immediate onsite sheltering with

Pigweed Plagues Louisiana Farms

Baton Rouge, La. (September 11, 2015) – A weed originally discovered in Georgia continues to spread across the south and has been known to be present in Louisiana for some time.

“Initially, glyphosate, the active ingredient in the popular herbicide Roundup®, would kill the weed. Unfortunately, the weed has become resistant,” said Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Palmer Amaranth (a type of pigweed) started plaguing Louisiana farms in 2010. Since this pigweed has become resistant to certain herbicides commonly used to control the weed, it is becoming a real problem for corn, cotton and soybean farmers. It can also be troublesome for other crops.

“One of the best methods of control is to prevent the introduction of the seeds on a farm so the plant does not get a foothold. This can be done by cleaning equipment

before moving it between fields and ensuring custom harvesters are thoroughly cleaning their equipment before entering a new farm,” said Strain. “In addition, the weed control research done by the LSU and Southern ag centers is essential to protecting our state’s crops and the agricultural industry.”

Pollen transfer from herbicide-resistant pigweeds to other pigweeds can occur over very long distances. Pigweed found in Mississippi and Tennessee has

recently proven to be resistant to a different group of herbicides, further limiting control options for this weed.

In addition to cleaning equipment, it is best to alternate use of herbicides that still show effective control. But preventing the introduction and spread of resistant pigweed to the farm through diligent cleaning of equipment is still the best way to avoid introduction of the invasive plant.



Savory Spinach & Rice Casserole

Vegetable cooking spray	2 cups cooked ham, chopped
3 cups cooked rice	2 (12-oz.) pkgs. frozen spinach soufflé, thawed
2 cups Gruyere cheese, shredded	2 Roma tomatoes, thinly sliced

Preheat oven to 400 degrees and coat a 13x9x2-inch baking dish with cooking spray. In a large bowl, combine rice, cheese, ham, and spinach soufflé. Pour rice mixture into baking dish; top with tomato slices. Cover with foil and bake for 15 minutes; remove foil and bake an additional 15 minutes.

Wild and brown rice, kale salad

4 cups kale	Salt and pepper to taste
1/2 tsp. salt	1 cup cooked wild rice, cooled
1/2 lemon, juice and zest	2 cups cooked brown rice, cooled
2 tbsp. + 1 tsp. EVOO, divided	6 oz. blueberries
1/4 cup pumpkin seeds	8 dried apricots, chopped
1/4 cup orange juice	1/2 cup pomegranate seeds
1 clove garlic, minced	1/4 cup feta cheese, crumbled

Place the washed, stemmed and cut kale into a large bowl. Sprinkle with salt, lemon juice and zest, add 1 teaspoon olive oil. Massage the kale leaves between your hands until you see the kale turn a dark, shiny green. Toast the pumpkin seeds by placing them in a dry skillet over medium heat. Stir the seeds with a wooden spoon until then begin to puff up and turn slightly golden. Remove the seeds from the heat and set aside to cool. Make the dressing by whisking together the orange juice, olive oil, garlic and salt and pepper. Combine the massaged kale, wild and brown rice, blueberries, apricots, pomegranate seeds and pumpkin seeds in a large bowl. Mix in the dressing.

1 cup uncooked brown rice	1 cup carrots, shredded

Combine reserved mandarin orange juice with enough water to equal 2 cups liquid. Bring juice mixture, 1 teaspoon oil and salt to boil in medium saucepan over medium-high heat. Stir in rice; cover and reduce heat to simmer. Cook according to package instructions. Stir mandarin oranges and sweet chili sauce into cooked rice. Meanwhile, heat remaining oil in large skillet over medium heat. Add shrimp and sauté just until cooked through, about 4-5 minutes. Arrange lettuce leaves on large platter. Spoon rice mixture into center of each lettuce leaf. Top with carrots and shrimp.

LDAF inspector finds credit card theft device on Baton Rouge gas pump

On Aug. 31, A Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry fuel inspector, who was conducting a routine inspection at a Baton Rouge gas station, found a credit card skimming device.

These devices are attached to credit card machines in various ways by criminals to steal credit card data from unsuspecting customers.

The device was removed and turned over to law enforcement. While early generations of credit card skimmers were typically glued over card readers, recently, the devices have been found inside locked cabinets of gas pumps where the electronics are located. Our inspectors began checking for credit card skimmers several months ago along with their routine gas pump inspections in an effort to further protect consumers at the gas pump.

the mobile pet shelter is to provide safe transport of pets and have the ability to relocate and quickly co-locate them with their owners. The evacuation, transportation and sheltering of household pets during disasters has become necessary as a lifesaving measure. What we have experienced in the past are victims who have refused assistance unless their pets were accommodated," added Strain.

"We've worked in the state to remove all obstacles to get people to evacuate. One of those obstacles is to get people to take pets with them," said Poirrier.

The first time the state evacuated pets with their owners was during Hurricane Gustav in 2008.

Currently, Louisiana has methods

of transporting pets and has areas to shelter the pets near their owners. "We have human and pet shelters, but one of the issues we have is that it's the co-location that we need. The most exciting thing about the pet shelter is we can roll that up next to any human shelter and so we have a co-location shelter," said Poirrier.

A \$40,000 donation was made by the Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART), Dr. Walter J. Ernst, Jr. Veterinary Memorial Foundation and Louisiana Veterinary Medical Association (LVMA) to help fund this project.

LDAF's household pet plan includes 48-53 foot transport trucks with assembled pet cages

and staff to assist parishes with the evacuation, transportation and sheltering of evacuees' pets. The LDAF's current pet sheltering plan can accommodate thousands of pets at mega pet shelters. The new mobile pet shelter unit will also be used in search and rescue missions and will be available, upon request, to other states during a disaster.

The mobile pet shelter is a tractor trailer that has a 55 pet capacity. It is equipped with metal cages, generator, battery power and a wash down system. It has an air ventilation system to provide proper air circulation and temperature for the pets.

The total cost of the project was \$80,000. The LDAF provided the additional funding.
