Liuzza's Farm in Tangipahoa Parish is known for growing some of the sweetest strawberries around and other produce, but in recent years, the farm has become a destination spot for area schools.

"When we first started, kids would visit to pick strawberries, go on a wagon tour, eat lunch and go home," said owner Elizabeth Liuzza.

Liuzza said she envisioned an opportunity to do more with kids on the farm. "When you have kids, you want to give them everything – activities, a petting zoo, you name it," added Liuzza.

"You may pass by a field with farm animals, but putting your hands on them and feeding them makes a difference," said Aaron Guillot whose six-year-old son, Carter, was visiting the farm along with the rest of his first grade class at Madisonville Elementary.

Entering "Liuzza Land", the children begin their tour. As they pass the cow, they pick up a small milk carton showing them that milk comes from a cow. They also visit with the alpacas where they grab a piece of wool and they scoop up an egg as they walk through the chicken coop.

Over at the farmer's vegetable garden, the students get to plant a bean. First grade teacher Heather Cockfield added, "Just the idea that they get to plant seeds in the dirt and take it home and watch it grow is a great experience. Lots of these children live in subdivisions and don't get to see how vegetables look planted in the ground."

They even get to "shop" in the farmers market where they learn the importance of supporting the local farmer.

A trip through the corn maze is where they get to read facts about America's largest crop. "They really learn

things and associate it with fun," added Guillot.

Cockfield said she's taken her first graders on this tour for the past five years. "Part of our social studies program is learning about community and how we work together as a community. It gives them hands on experience and a visual of how food gets to the grocery store."

As Liuzza ventured into agritourism, she realized it was also a marketing tool for the family run business. "By expanding what we offered, it was also a way to bring awareness to the farm and promote buying local.

You see, kids will go into the grocery with their parents, recognize the name and tell their parents about their trip to Liuzza's."

On a wagon tour around the property, one of the Adventure Land tour guides explains that farming is a "real job" because they raise animals and produce fruits and vegetables.

The children can visit a blacksmith shop, chapel and school while visiting Liuzza Land. Besides feeding the goats, there are other fun activities such as a hill with a slide and a pumpkin patch.

Liuzza Land opens the last week of September through the second week of November. It opens again for two weeks during December and is decorated for Christmas. It re-opens in the spring from March through the first week of May.

Liuzza Land is also the home to Berry Barn which is used for events such as weddings, parties and showers.

## Arrests made in Pointe Coupee Parish for theft, killing of calf

Two men are accused of animal cruelty for shooting and killing a calf while four are accused of stealing the animal for its meat.

On September 22, 2015, a cattleman found a dead calf on the spillway levee near Morganza. Pointe Coupee Parish deputies observed the calf had been shot and one hindquarter and a loin had been removed.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Livestock Brand Commission was contacted to assist in investigating the case.

After interviewing possible witnesses, it was discovered that four suspects left Morganza together with the intention of riding

down the levee to kill a cow.

Investigators said the suspects drove to an area where there were cattle on the levee and one of the suspects, Austin Leonard, fired a gun at the fleeing cattle but did not kill any of those cattle.

According to investigators, during the night, two of the suspects, Austin Leonard and James Cole Devillier, drove back to the levee where Austin Leonard shot and killed a calf with a 12 gauge shot gun.

Investigators said Leonard and Devillier enlisted the help of Kale Ashten David and Dustin James Vidrine to load the calf. Once the four returned to get the calf, they

realized it was too big to load so they removed one hindquarter and one loin.

The leg bone was discarded in a trash can down the road from David's residence.

Investigators say the suspects admitted their involvement during interviews.

"The LDAF Livestock Brand Commission closely works with law enforcement to quickly solve crimes, bring these criminals to justice and hopefully deter others from committing such heinous acts. If we find out you've stolen property and abused that property, we will hold you accountable," said Agriculture and Forestry

A 12 gauge shot gun and some of the meat were recovered. A discarded leg bone was discovered in the garbage can where Leonard said he discarded it.

All four suspects were arrested and booked into the Pointe Coupee Parish Jail Sept. 25 and charged with theft of livestock for participating in taking the meat. Leonard and Devillier were charged with aggravated cruelty to animals for allegedly killing of the calf. Leonard was also charged with illegal possession of a firearm by a convicted felon because he is a felon on probation for a prior felony incident.

## Don't move used cotton harvest equipment without inspection, paperwork

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said with cotton harvest comes an influx of used cotton harvest equipment moving into and through the state of Louisiana.

“Since the boll weevil has been eradicated here in Louisiana, the investment made by the state and the cotton producers must be protected by preventing the reintroduction of boll weevils,” Strain said. “Reintroductions usually occur when used cotton harvest equipment from a boll weevil infested area travels through the state or stops within the state to conduct harvest operations without being properly inspected and certified as being free of boll weevils.”

Used cotton harvest equipment includes cotton pickers, cotton module builders, cotton module trucks, boll buggies, tractors, trailers, and any other equipment potentially harboring cotton debris or boll weevils.

“Equipment entering Louisiana from areas, such as Texas, Arizona, and New Mexico, that have restrictions

due to pink bollworm will require that a Fumigation Certificate or USDA PPQ Inspection Form 540 accompany that equipment,” Strain said.

“Equipment from all other states should have a phytosanitary certificate or other official document such as a statement on letterhead from a state-of-origin regulatory official certifying that the equipment is free from boll weevil or that the equipment originated in a boll weevil free area.”

“Once the equipment stops anywhere within the state of Louisiana, our department must be notified so we may conduct an inspection of the equipment and all pertinent documentation.”
