Dry weather devastates crops, doubles disaster declarations

Clouds of dust trail Sonny Kirby's combine as he harvests what beans he can—it's a sign of just how dry it's been on his farm near the Louisiana-Arkansas border north of Shreveport.

With it so dry right now, it's hard to believe just a few months ago the same dry 100 acres were completely covered in backwater from the Red River. The unusual conditions have seen disaster

declarations for both flooding and drought this year.

"I've never seen any spring like we had," Ryan Kirby said. "We had the Red River crested at the highest level it's been since 1945."

The bitter irony for Ryan Kirby is that after replanting from the flood, he had to irrigate those same beans.

"I lost a little more than 100 acres from the Red River flood backwater," Ryan Kirby said. "Some of that field was planted in May. Part of it was replanted in July. We're actually harvesting right now the part of the field that was planted in May and I'm still irrigating the part of the field that was planted in July."

There's a line in the field where he's harvesting that tells the story. On one side, green soybeans from the replanting in July. On the other side, the areas which survived the flood but then got hit by drought and now is nothing but dried, cracked dirt and withered soybeans. Ryan Kirby said that in these areas he's already harvested, he's only seeing about five to 10 bushels per acre, a far cry from the record year of 2014 that averaged 57 bushels per acre across the state.

"I've got to give it to these beans,

they tried to make a crop," Sonny said. "I mean, they grew off well and they had lots of pods. They grew to about the size of a BB. They just ran out of moisture and they died."

Neighbor Stephen Logan has had similar experiences with his crop on his farm near Gillam. He had no idea as he watched the fireworks on the Fourth of July that he'd seen the last rain of the summer.

"July the 3rd, we had a nice rain," Logan said. "After that, we hadn't had significant rainfall since."

While his experience with the flooding was not as bad as the Kirbys, he still didn't have a lot of hope for this year's crop.

"Well, we didn't have real high expectations after the spring we had," Logan said. "We knew we had lost a lot of fertilizer. We knew we had a lot of root damage from standing water and other issues that come with all of that wet weather. We've probably gotten a little better crop than we thought we might have and we've had good harvest conditions."

Both Logan and the Kirbys are now in a situation where they are hoping for the dry weather to continue so they can get everything

harvested.

"That would have been the icing on the cake if we had a wet Fall," Ryan Kirby said of his 1,200 acres of beans and 650 acres of cotton. "That would have been the icing on the cake to make this year just absolutely a catastrophe."

It might not be a catastrophe, but it is a disaster that could cost as high as \$50 million for Louisiana agriculture this year, according to Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Dr. Mike Strain.

"We are expecting about \$30 million to \$50 million in losses," Strain said. "We won't know until after the harvest when we compare the yields of this year to previous yields."

The disaster declaration does open the door for the Kirbys, Logan and their farming neighbors to get low-interest loans from the Farm Service Agency. This might be the only assistance available, even though five to 10 bushels per acre doesn't even cover the diesel to harvest the beans, it might be enough to stay above the crop insurance threshold. With beans below \$9 per bushel, the only thing more scarce than rain might be income for many farmers this year.

Jonesboro Man Arrested in Connection with Arson

Baton Rouge, La. (October 16, 2015) – A joint investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) and the Louisiana State Fire Marshal’s Office has resulted in the arrest of a Jonesboro man on six counts of simple arson.

Investigators said 22-year-old Justin L. Murphy of 1150 Firewood Road in Jonesboro was arrested Friday afternoon and charged with setting six woods fires in Jackson Parish near Jonesboro while he was a volunteer firefighter at the Jonesboro Fire Department during

2010 and 2011.

The arrest was made following an interview Thursday in which Murphy was questioned as a “person of interest” about the Liberty Hill fire in Bienville Parish Tuesday that burned approximately 800 acres. The fire destroyed one home and threatened several others including a train that contained numerous tanks filled with hazardous chemicals.

During the interview, investigators said Murphy admitted making small grass bundles and using a cigarette to light the

blaze. As a volunteer member of the Jonesboro Fire Department, Murphy was paid \$10 for every call out on a grass fire and \$25 for each call out to a woods fire.

“Our agents are currently investigating numerous wildfires that have been allegedly set by individuals in the Bienville and Jackson Parish areas. Wildfires can get out of control very easily and this week, a family is homeless as a result. We have formed a task force with the State Fire Marshal’s Office to investigate and find those responsible for the damage

and loss of property, said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. Bond was set at \$90,000.

Strain and State Fire Marshal Butch Browning are asking individuals to report any information they may have regarding these fires. The Louisiana Forestry Association is offering up to a \$2,000 reward for information that leads to an arrest and conviction. 



EAB update

Two new parishes are now quarantined following evidence of the insect identified as Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) which was originally found in Webster parish earlier this year. EAB is an invasive pest that primarily attacks trees of the genus *Fraxinus* (Ash).

The quarantine now restricts the movement of ash nursery stock and unprocessed ash timber from moving outside of Bossier, Claiborne and Webster parishes.

In April, an EAB trapping and survey program was initiated by several state and federal agencies including the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. In addition to the trapping and survey program, the LSU AgCenter and U.S. Forestry Service began a biocontrol release program earlier this year to aid in the control of EAB. The parasitoid wasp program is a USDA funded program that provides states with wasps to aid in the control of EAB. Dr. Rodrigo Diaz, LSU AgCenter entomologist, and United States Forestry Service employees Wood Johnson, James Meeker, Brian Strom, Billy Bruce, and Chris Steiner have made several releases this year at two separate locations. The total number of wasps released was 25,000.

Tetrastichus planipennis is a tiny non-stinging wasp that parasitizes EAB larvae by drilling through the ash bark and laying eggs on its host.

Spathius agrili is another tiny non-stinging wasp that parasitizes EAB larvae and like *Tetrastichus planipennis* drill through the bark and lay its eggs directly on the host.

Oobius agrili is another tiny non-stinging wasp that parasitizes EAB eggs. The wasp finds an EAB egg and lays its egg inside of the EAB's egg.

The best landscape plants are grown locally

HAMMOND, La. – Fall is here, and it is a great time to add new ornamental plants to your landscape.

Did you know that Louisiana is one of the top nursery crop-producing states in the country? It's also well represented in listings of the top states in sales of retail garden center products.

The nursery and landscape industry is the third largest Louisiana agricultural industry in terms of annual contributions to the state's economy. Nursery growers, landscape professionals and garden centers in Louisiana employ over 56,000 individuals. The industry is active in all 64 parishes.

October, November and December are great times to do landscaping. This month, the Louisiana Nursery and Landscape Association, along with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, is encouraging us to purchase Louisiana-grown nursery plants.

"Buy fresh, buy local" is widely associated with fruits, vegetables and other farm produce, but it applies to landscape plants, too. The LSU AgCenter also supports selecting landscape plants that are Louisiana grown.

What advantage is there to buying a landscape plant grown in Louisiana compared to a plant grown out of state? First, Louisiana plants will have less stress because of shorter shipping times. You'll also have a fresher product at retail and a healthier plant when you bring it home. In addition, a landscape plant grown in Louisiana will be acclimated to our unique growing conditions.

Many retail garden centers now have their own growing operations. The plants you

buy today may well have been in their greenhouse next door or only a few miles away as recently as a day or two ago.

Louisiana producers also are more likely to grow Louisiana-recommended plants, like Louisiana Super Plants, than plants that are more adapted to Texas or northern Mississippi or Alabama. Mass merchandisers often buy plants for stores over a multi-state area with a few growers supplying many states. Locally owned independent retail garden centers tend to buy from Louisiana greenhouse growers and nursery crop producers.

We know that buying local, whether wholesale or retail, benefits the local economy. An investment in buying local means your money stays in your community or parish.

Fall is a great time for planting. Trees and shrubs can be added to the landscape this time of year with more success than if you planted in spring. And porch and patio containers with combinations of "spiller, filler and thriller" plants make great contributions to outdoor living, outdoor lifestyles, barbecues and entertaining during fall. Consider trying a small vegetable garden, too.

The Louisiana Nursery and Landscape Association wants every family to plant together. Their new promotional theme is "buy it, plant it, grow it and love it." The AgCenter also encourages you to get it growing this fall.

Did you know?

Louisiana is one of 27 states with a State Meat Inspection Program.

The Federal Meat Inspection and the Poultry Products Inspection Acts require that all meat and poultry food products sold for human consumption originate from an inspected source; either state or federal. The Acts allow the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to partner with and assist states in protecting consumers from meat and poultry food products that are adulterated or misbranded.

For almost 50 years the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has maintained a State Meat Inspection Program that regulates the harvest of

locally raised livestock and the processing of meat and poultry food products unique to Louisiana's varied cuisines. Mainly due to consolidation in the livestock industry and the resulting loss of a significant number of small meat processors, many livestock producers around the country experience difficulty in making value added meat and poultry products available locally. Inspections provided by the Program at livestock harvest and processing facilities around the state affords livestock producers in Louisiana that opportunity for marketing at the local level.

Livestock producers are not the only ones that benefit from the availability of the program. Small businesses inspected by

the program supply Louisiana consumers with a variety of locally processed meat and poultry products while providing employment opportunities for area residents. The availability of the program to the businesses and residents of Louisiana also has a significant impact on the state economy.

In 2014:

- 21 million pounds of processed meat and poultry products were produced in Louisiana, and,
- 47,000 head of livestock and poultry were harvested in the businesses regulated by the LDAF State Meat Inspection Program.
