The LSU AgCenter will host a poinsettia open house and sale from 8 a.m. to noon on Dec. 4 at the LSU AgCenter Botanic Gardens at Burden, located at 4560 Essen Lane near the junction of I-10 in Baton Rouge.

Visitors may purchase fresh poinsettias from a wide selection of varieties on display for \$10 per plant.

Visitors also have the opportunity to take a survey and rate several poinsettia varieties and are invited to stop in the lobby of the Ione Burden Conference Center to take a peek at a poinsettia Christmas tree.

Those attending the open house will be asked to vote on their favorite new varieties. "This public preference

survey will guide recommendations made to poinsettia growers across the state," said Jeff Kuehny, resident director of the Botanic Gardens at Burden.

After poinsettias are purchased and brought home, consumers find it is often difficult to keep them looking as good as they did in the store. Here are a few helpful hints to preserve the beauty of poinsettias for the entire holiday season.

Do not over water your poinsettias because they are susceptible to root rot. Keep the plants out of direct air flow from a vent or heater because they don't like changes in temperature.

Poinsettias naturally grow best in full sun, so if possible, choose a sunny area to place them.

With proper care poinsettias should bring you and your loved ones Christmas cheer throughout the holiday season.

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Allen Parish couple convicted for forestry equipment theft

Baton Rouge, La. (November 17, 2015) – An Allen Parish couple is now serving up to eight years behind bars in connection with the theft of forestry equipment.

Investigators said Joey Ganson, 35, and Jamie Coker-Brown, 35, were arrested in February 2015 in connection with the September 2014 theft of hundreds of gallons

of diesel fuel, radios and other equipment from a logging operation in the Westbay Wildlife Management Area near Oakdale, La. The duo was formally convicted earlier this month.

The Allen Parish Sheriff's Office worked with Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) investigators on

the three month joint investigation.

Investigators said Coker-Brown admitted she and Ganson committed the thefts.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "Once we've made arrests, it is important that we hold these criminals accountable, bring them to justice and make sure they pay the price for the crime

which they have committed."

LDAF investigators and the APSO were able to locate and recover much of the stolen equipment.

Ganson pled guilty to simple burglary and received a sentence of eight years. Coker-Brown received a seven year sentence and a \$1,000 fine.

Breakfast Biscuit Quiches

2/3 cup shredded swiss cheese	1/4 tsp. salt
1/3 cup finely chopped ham	1/8 tsp. pepper
1/4 cup finely chopped green onions	1 pkg. (12 oz.; 10 Biscuits)
3 Eggs	Refrigerated Buttermilk Biscuits
2 tbsp. milk	

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Combine cheese, ham and green onions in small bowl; mix well. Beat eggs, milk, salt and pepper in medium bowl until blended. Separate biscuits; press or roll each into a 5-inch round on lightly floured surface. Place 1 biscuit in each of 10 greased muffin cups, leaving the 2 cups in center of pan empty. Press biscuits firmly against bottom and sides of cups and form rim at top. Spoon 2 tbsp. cheese mixture into each cup. Pour in egg mixture, dividing evenly. Bake in center of 350 degrees oven until filling is set and biscuits are deep golden brown, 20 to 25 minutes. Remove from pan; serve warm.

Pumpkin Souffle

Sugar for dish	6 EGG yolks
6 EGG whites, room temperature	1/2 cup canned pumpkin
3/4 tsp. cream of tartar	1/2 tsp. pumpkin pie spice
1/2 cup sugar	

Heat oven to 375 degrees. Coat 4 lightly greased 8-ounce soufflé dishes evenly and completely with sugar. Place in 13 x 9 x 2-inch baking pan. Beat egg whites and cream of tartar in mixer bowl with whisk attachment on high speed until foamy. Beating constantly, Add 1/2 cup sugar, 2 Tbsp. at a time, beating after each addition until sugar is dissolved before adding the next. (Rub a bit of mixture between thumb and forefinger; it should feel completely smooth.) Continue beating until whites are glossy and stand in soft peaks. Beat egg yolks in separate bowl on high speed until thick and lemon-colored. Fold in pumpkin and pie spice. Gently but thoroughly fold yolk mixture into whites until no streaks of white remain. Pour into soufflé dishes, dividing evenly. Place pan with soufflé dishes on rack in middle of 375 degree oven. Pour very hot water into pan (hot-water bath) to within 1/2 inch of top of dishes. Bake until soufflés are puffy and delicately browned, 15 to 20 minutes. Serve immediately.

Lemon Delight Chess Pie

Prepared pastry for a 9-inch pie plate	2 tablespoons cornmeal
6 tablespoons butter, melted	2 tablespoons grated lemon peel
1 2/3 cups sugar	1/4 cup lemon juice
4 eggs	1 teaspoon vanilla

Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Unfold pie pastry and gently ease into pie plate. Flute pastry around edge of pie plate. In a large bowl beat together butter, sugar and eggs until smooth. Add cornmeal, lemon peel, lemon juice and vanilla. Beat until thoroughly blended. Pour into pie shell, and bake in a preheated 450 degrees oven for 10 minutes. Reduce heat to 350 degrees, and continue baking until knife inserted in center comes out clean, or about 30-40 minutes. Cool on wire rack at room temperature for no more than two hours. Serve at room temperature or chilled. Refrigerate leftovers in covered container.

Turkey-Vegetable Hash Brown Quiche

2 cups frozen vegetable blend (12 oz.), defrosted	Hash Brown Crust:
1/2 cup diced cooked turkey	1 EGG
5 EGGS	1/4 tsp. salt
1 cup milk	2 cups frozen shredded hash brown potatoes (12 oz.), defrosted
1/2 tsp. salt	
2 tbsps. sliced almonds	

FOR CRUST: Heat oven to 375 degrees. Beat egg and salt in medium bowl until blended. Add potatoes; mix well. Press evenly against bottom and sides of greased deep 9-inch pie plate. Bake in 375 degree oven 5 minutes.

Place vegetables in crust; top with turkey. Beat 5 eggs, milk and 1/2 tsp. salt in medium bowl until blended. Pour slowly over turkey. Sprinkle with almonds. Bake in center of 375 degree oven until center is puffed and knife inserted near center comes out clean, about 45 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes.

Chocolate Peppermint Crinkles

2-1/4 cups all-purpose flour	3 EGGS, room temperature
1/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder	1/2 cup vegetable oil
1-1/2 tsp. baking powder	1 tsp. peppermint extract
1/2 tsp. salt	1/3 cup powdered sugar, sifted
2 cups granulated sugar	1/4 cup crushed peppermint candies
1 (12 oz.) pkg. semisweet chocolate chips, melted, cooled	1/3 cup granulated sugar, for rolling

Mix flour, cocoa powder, baking powder and salt in large bowl. Combine 2 cups sugar, cooled chocolate, eggs, oil and peppermint extract in mixer bowl. Beat on medium speed until blended. Gradually add flour mixture, beating on low speed until blended. Refrigerate, covered, until firm enough to shape, about 1 hour or overnight. Heat oven to 350 degrees. Mix powdered sugar and crushed candy in small bowl. Work with 1/3 of the dough at a time, keeping remaining dough refrigerated. Shape dough into 1-inch balls; roll in granulated sugar first and then in crushed candy mixture. Place 2 inches apart on parchment paper-lined or ungreased baking sheets. Bake in 350 degree oven until lightly browned, 8 to 10 minutes. Cool on baking sheets 1 to 2 minutes. Remove to wire racks; cool completely.

2015 soybean crop exceeds expectations

ALEXANDRIA, La. – The 2015 Louisiana soybean crop was not as good as in recent years, but the results were better than expected after weather extremes of flood and drought.

“Overall, the crop was not as good as we’ve had in the last three or four years but still overall yields were good for Louisiana,” said LSU AgCenter soybean specialist Ron Levy.

Levy projected this year’s average statewide yield at slightly more than 40 bushels an acre, far below last year’s state record crop of 57 bushels an acre that led the nation.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture’s November estimates place average soybean yields for Louisiana in 2015 at 41 bushels per acre, more than 7 bushels below the national average and below Louisiana’s five-year average of 45.7 bushels.

This year Louisiana farmers harvested 1.41 million acres, with 1.5 million acres planted. Last year’s harvested acreage was 1.39 million acres.

Heavy rains at planting time created difficulties getting a stand established, Levy said. Wet ground also inhibited deep root growth, which made it difficult for plants to get adequate moisture during a late-season drought.

Wet conditions at planting left only a small window of time to put seed in the ground, Levy said, and that also resulted in a narrow window for harvesting because the crop matured at the same time. “It put a lot more additional stress on farmers.”

Some fields that were planted were not harvested. Drought stress prevented soybeans from maturing in some fields, he said, and many soybean fields in northwest Louisiana were lost to flooding.

The dry summer meant less disease, Levy said, but insect pressure from loopers and

stinkbugs was severe in some areas.

More farmers were using irrigation because of a shift from corn on land that has been irrigated. Levy said he also noticed a slight increase in the use of LibertyLink soybeans to fight weeds that have become resistant to glyphosate herbicide.

Because of the weather extremes, no varieties stood out as top performers in commercial fields or LSU AgCenter demonstration plots, Levy said. “None of them could perform at their highest potential.”

Soybeans remain the top money-making

option for farmers with prices above \$8.50 a bushel, he said.

U.S. soybean acreage isn’t likely to change next year, and the current price could hold steady, said AgCenter economist Kurt Guidry.

“Looking ahead to the 2016 crop, prospects for prices remain mixed,” Guidry said. “Early projections for 2016 soybeans call for acres to fall only slightly from 2015 levels as a lack of attractive planting alternatives limits acreage shifts.

“With acres remaining mostly unchanged in 2016 and assuming that there are no surprises in the South American harvest in the spring of 2016, prices will likely remain in the mid \$8 to low \$9 level,” he said.

The rest of the U.S. had a good soybean crop, with a national average of 48.3 bushels per acre, an increase of one bushel from 2014, he said.

“The better-than-expected yields, coupled with essentially unchanged acres from 2014, put total soybean production at 3.98 billion bushels, the largest level ever on record,” Guidry said.

The record production estimate has depressed prices, he said.

Last year, soybeans were selling for \$2 a bushel more, Guidry said, and the anticipated record South American soybean crop will increase supplies.

But world soybean demand remains high. “Demand continues to expand globally and offer additional opportunities for the U.S. to expand its exports,” he said. “Currently, U.S. soybean exports for the 2015-2016 marketing year are roughly 7 percent higher than the same time last year. This strong demand base will likely limit just how far soybean prices may fall.”



USDA Issues Safety-Net Payments to Louisiana Farmers Facing Market Downturn

(ALEXANDRIA, LA), Nov. 18, 2015 – USDA Louisiana Farm Service Agency (FSA) Executive Director, Craig A. McCain announced that approximately 15,662 Louisiana farms who enrolled in the new safety-net programs established by the 2014 Farm Bill will soon begin receiving financial assistance for

the 2014 crop year. The programs, known as Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC), are designed to protect against unexpected drops in crop prices or revenues due to market downturns.

“These new safety-net programs provide help when price and revenues fall below

normal, unlike the previous direct payments program that provided funds even in good years,” said McCain. “For example, 30 counties in Louisiana harvest long grain rice and producers have experienced a 16.0 percent drop in price below the statutory reference price established by the PLC program.”

Similarly, the county-based option of ARC protects against lower revenue from a combination of price and yield. “For example, 36 counties in Louisiana harvest corn and producers have experienced a 30.1 percent drop in price below the historical benchmark price established by the ARC-CO program,” said

McCain. “Payments by county can vary because average county yields will differ.”
