Thirteen-year-olds William Green and James Plaisance spent a cool, crisp Saturday morning in November working really, really hard and not complaining about

it one bit. The teens were tasked to grind sugarcane and squeeze the juice out of it to make cane syrup. What they were also doing was participating in a 33-year-old

family tradition. That's how long one St. Tammany Parish family has been celebrating making syrup.

"That's kind of what it's all about. We have the next generation learning the process. We hope they continue the tradition," said Darryl Fitzgerald whose family made the syrup in the 1930s to sell and barter at a Covington grocery store under the label of Fitzgerald's syrup.

"The war years changed everybody's lives. The family stopped cooking the cane during World War II," said family member Marie King. "My husband and Dennis' father eventually found a new mill, remembered how to operate them and wanted to continue the process."

In 1982, the family started making the cane syrup again.

"Our family wanted to resurrect that part of our family history. We went to Mississippi, found a mill, found an evaporator pan, bought the equipment, grew a little field of cane and started making syrup one weekend in early November and the tradition grew," added family member Dennis Sharp.

Sharp and three of his cousins, David and Darryl Fitzgerald and Dale Jenkins, are third generation syrup makers saying it's a family activity that's been handed down.

These days, the family grows about an acre of sugarcane, harvests it, and on one Saturday each year, they make the syrup. He says there's no real recipe, just

the community was so much more connected than it is now. I hope people can connect to the past and experience what things were like a long time ago."

Depending on the weather, about 75 people typically show up. The family even gives away bottles of syrup.

"It's purely a family tradition we'd love to keep going. We were a pretty good sized group of boys. Unfortunately, when we stop doing it, it may be the end of it. My two daughters don't live here and a lot of our kids are scattered," added Sharp.

Right now, Sharp and his family are trying to maintain the tradition they have. "I think all family traditions are important whether they relate to

a process. Some may use a kettle or some may use a pan. The key ingredient is good old fashioned Louisiana sugarcane.

Everyone in the community is invited for biscuits and sausage and various breakfast items," said Sharp. "It goes back to a time when

agriculture or not, but I think the agriculture traditions across Louisiana should be something we should work hard to maintain. We owe it to agriculture in general, the rural lifestyle and the histories of agriculture families to maintain it as long as possible."

Reward offered for information on suspected arsons

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF), Louisiana State Fire Marshal's Office, the Bienville Parish Sheriff's Office and the Jackson Parish Sheriff's Office are seeking information on 86 suspected arsons that took place between August 30 – October 21, 2015.

According to investigators, the fires began in the Castor community in Bienville Parish and

progressed east through the Liberty Hill area and east to North Hodge in Jackson Parish.

"Our agents have expended a tremendous amount of time investigating fire scenes. They've questioned residents and former members of local hunting clubs to gain information on these fires. We clearly have one or more arsonists who have caused tremendous damage to timberlands

that destroyed at least one home," said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Investigators found that almost all the fires took place on properties owned by timber company Weyerhaeuser Industries.

One arrest was made recently for three fires that took place in the Jamestown and Castor communities that burned two timber tracts and a mobile home in a residential area.

In addition, another individual was arrested for six fires that took place in 2011.

The Louisiana Forestry Association and Weyerhaeuser have put up a \$4,000 reward for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the persons responsible for these arsons.



A Thanksgiving staple is having trouble making it to dinner in south Louisiana this season.

A mix of drought and rain has sweet potato farmers struggling through a late harvest.

Farmer Larry Fontenot with E&L Produce said here at the end of the growing season, the beginning and middle part of the crop year was rough.

"In the prime growing season, he lost 45 to 60 days of growth," Fontenot said. "At the beginning of September, we were estimating about a 350 bushel yield, which is not enough for us to bring in and sustain our farm."

Fontenot said he and many other sweet potato farmers in south Louisiana, took a gamble, holding off on harvesting most of their crop in hopes of better conditions.

"We went from 120 days of drought, to field saturation in 48 hours," he said. "We went from a slow-paced harvest, but were

advancing, to where in the last two weeks we haven't harvested anything at all."

Muddy conditions make harvesting difficult, but they have to get the potatoes out of the field because the drought, followed by a foot of rain, is what Fontenot calls a "recipe for a rotten potato."

"They're still holding on, they're not rotting and so far we think we're ok," he said. "You will have some loss, you will have some decay. Unfortunately, with the dry conditions so bad, now the wet conditions have made it worse."

With one-third of south Louisiana's sweet potatoes still in the ground, Fontenot is getting nervous they won't get the potatoes out in time.

"November is always a busy time at a packing shed because the Thanksgiving holiday is the biggest movement of sweet potatoes," Fontenot said. "Everybody needs to get what

they have left in the field, bring it back into the house and sell it. You can't afford to lose a third of your crop, not with the production costs as high as they are this year."

The weather and cost of production aren't the only challenges for sweet potato farmers this year, either. Stacks of sweet potatoes, from floor to ceiling, line Fontenot's shed after the last sweet potato processing plant closed this year.

"We're scared, as we're having to store sweet potatoes that normally we don't store this time of the year," he said. "That plant took about 45 percent of the potatoes that's grown on this farm and other farms that's like ours."

As a result, Fontenot cut his sweet potato production from more than 200 acres, to about 120.

"We have been able to get contracts with the French fry facility in Delhi," he said. "I don't know what we're going to do next year, though."
