## Ag Outlook

Each year begins with a renewed hope of good weather, good prices, and a bountiful harvest. We search for each and every opportunity to increase productivity and sustainability and address the challenges of the day.

According to the 2015 Global

Agricultural Productivity (GAP) report, the rate of per capita income is going to increase almost three times as fast in developing countries as in already developed countries (4.4 percent vs 1.7 percent).

This will result in an increased demand for meat, crops, fiber, energy and all types of consumable

products. Specifically, developing nations will need approximately 12 percent more dairy, 15 percent more cotton, 28 percent more coarse grains, 24 percent more meat, 28 percent more poultry, and 32 percent more vegetable oils to meet their growing demands and populations.

Overall, by 2050, the global middle class is expected to double to 70 percent of the population. Moreover, the growing issue of climate change will be especially challenging to the majority of agricultural production throughout the world.

Whereas we utilize approximately 70 percent of all available fresh water today, this will increase to more than 89 percent by 2050. At the same time, the urban population will rise to 2/3 of the world's population with fewer people living and working in the rural areas.

With 95 percent of the world's consumers outside of the United States and the fact that more than 60 percent of the grains and a large portion of the proteins exported worldwide come from the United States, we have an unprecedented opportunity ahead. Once oil prices and the value of the American dollar stabilize, which is expected to begin early in the second quarter

of this year, the world economy will begin to recover and commodity prices will rise.

It is imperative now that we stay the course and become more efficient in production, transportation, processing and delivery of raw and value-added agricultural, forestry and aquaculture products. In doing so, we will be in the driver's seat and command a greater market share and profitability.

On Capitol Hill, the omnibus spending bill included the 2014 Section 179 tax extender language that was initially passed in late December 2014 making it permanent at \$500,000 and retroactive through 2015. Additionally, a 50 percent bonus depreciation was extended through 2019 and the Conservation Easement tax credit was made permanent, as well.

The bill also includes a five-year extension of property depreciation that is acquired and put in service during 2015 through 2019, with an added year of certain property with a longer production period. The bonus is 50 percent for property put in service in 2015, 2016 and 2017. It lowers to 40 percent in 2018 and 30 percent in 2019.

For cattlemen, the bill included

the repeal of Country of Origin Labeling (COOL), eliminating the possibility of billions of dollars in retaliatory tariffs that were approved by the World Trade Organization.

While COOL certainly captured the headlines, the omnibus contained many more priorities for producers including language to continue congressional oversight of the dietary guidelines process. With passage, Congress made it clear that the current and future dietary guidelines will be based on scientific agreement and limited to nutrition and dietary information. The bill also increases scrutiny on beef imports from regions with known animal diseases, funds wildfire reserves, continues prohibitions on environmental permitting and reporting and blocks the Department of Interior from designating de facto wilderness areas.

According to Brian Breaux of the Louisiana Farm Bureau, the omnibus spending bill for federal fiscal year 2016 also includes important H-2B relief and does the following:

- Exempts H-2B returning workers from the 66,000

## Webster Parish man arrested for timber theft

Baton Rouge, La. (December 22, 2015) An investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has resulted in the arrest of a Minden man on two counts of felony timber theft.

Bennie Moore, 62, of 484 Deerfield Blvd., was arrested Wednesday morning and booked into the Bossier Parish Detention Center.

The arrest is the result of a complaint filed by several Plain Dealing landowners who are heirs

to 76 acres of timberland located off Sam Booker Road, south of Plain Dealing.

According to investigators, Moore's business, Piney Woods Timber Co., signed a contract with nine heirs in which he paid them just over \$61,000 in July 2015. Investigators say Moore then sold the timber to a logging contractor in Sarepta who cut the timber. Several additional heirs then discovered the timber was cut. Investigators say they contacted Moore who offered them a fraction of what he had paid

the original nine heirs.

Investigators say there are approximately 50 heirs involved on two separate tracts. Moore was reportedly arrested on five previous occasions since 2000 for similar activities.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "Under the state's 80 percent statute, loggers must obtain at least 80 percent consent from the heirs before timber can be purchased. Our investigators take these complaints very

seriously and we work closely with our landowners and loggers to ensure that the logging is done in a professional manner. Timber is a long term investment and we want to make sure that both parties operate legally."

The LDAF is continuing its investigation and asking the public if they have had any business dealings in the past three years with Moore. If so, please contact the department at (225) 925-4500.

Moore's bond was set at \$100,000.

# Prepare livestock for possible river flooding

High river levels are causing concern for state officials. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is reminding livestock owners to be ready in the event of flooding that may occur mid to late January.

“Out of an abundance of caution, I’m alerting our livestock owners to be aware of the potential for flooding along the Mississippi River and Red River Valley. Pay attention to local forecasts and advisories,” said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “It’s also a good idea to double check the condition of livestock trailers and other equipment used to move large animals out of harm’s way.”

When evacuations are recommended, owners of large animals should leave as early as possible to avoid road closures.

- Tips on preparing livestock trailers:
- Check tire pressure and rubber for wear

- Test brake and running lights
- Inspect the overall condition of the trailer
- Important items to take:
  - Health records (especially proof of EIA testing for horses)
  - Food and water
  - Special medications
  - Bridles or leads
- Proper identification for livestock is crucial in the event of comingling.
- Livestock owners who need assistance should call their local Office of Emergency Preparedness (OEP).

## Protect tender plants from winter freezes

HAMMOND, La. – Winter is here, and this time of year brings questions about protecting landscape plants during the cold months of December, January and February. The best approach to protecting plants in winter is to pay attention to the weather forecasts and try to know a couple days ahead of time when a freeze is approaching. This year our first frost came a little late or right about on schedule, depending on your location in the state. Temperatures at first frost in some areas, however, also resulted in a first freeze. It was 29 degrees when frost first occurred in November at the LSU AgCenter Hammond Research Station.

Weather conditions prior to a freeze or frost play a role in how these temperatures affect plants. If the first cold event is a freeze, landscape plants will suffer more damage. If several cold fronts move through an area and produce several frosts prior to a freeze, we will see fewer negative effects on plants that normally show damage. One benefit of a gradual decrease in fall temperatures is

more attractive foliage color on trees and shrubs in Louisiana landscapes. Also, plants that bloom in fall, such as sasanquas and fall-blooming azaleas, flower better, longer and earlier when this occurs.

To prepare plants when a freeze is forecast, thoroughly water them if the soil is dry. This is especially important for container-grown plants. Shrubs in landscape beds also can be helped with irrigation prior to a freeze. This does not need to be done the day or night before. Rather, adequately hydrate plants gradually during the fall months and then three to five days before a major cold event. Wetting plant leaves before a freeze does not, however, provide any cold protection.

When a freeze is coming, move all tender plants in containers and hanging baskets into buildings where the temperature will stay above freezing. If this is not possible, group all container plants in a protected area like the inside corner of a covered patio and cover them with plastic.

For plants growing in the

ground, mulch them with a loose, dry material such as pine straw or leaves. Mulches will only protect what they cover and are best used to protect below-ground parts and crowns. Or they may be used to completely cover low-growing plants to a depth of 4 to 6 inches. But don’t leave a complete mulch cover on for more than three or four days. Many folks heavily mulch their tropical hibiscuses in landscape beds using this method. Smaller individual plants can be protected by covering them with various sizes of cardboard or plastic foam boxes.

Larger plants can be protected by creating a simple structure and covering it with fabric or plastic. The structure keeps the cover from touching the foliage, preventing broken branches and improving cold protection. For example, you can use several stakes slightly taller than the plant or use last season’s tomato cages. The cover should extend to the ground and be sealed with soil, stones or bricks to keep out the cold. Plastic covers should be vented or removed on sunny,

warm days.

For severe freezes when temperatures dip into the teens, providing a heat source under the covering may help. A safe, easy way to do this is to generously wrap or drape the plant with small outdoor Christmas lights. The lights provide heat but do not get hot enough to burn the plant or cover. But be careful and use only outdoor extension cords and sockets. If necessary, you may prune a large plant to make its size more practical to cover.

Keep in mind that cool-season bedding plants are adapted to the normal cold winter temperatures, so cold protection typically is not needed. Also, the vast majority of shrubs and trees in our landscapes are very cold hardy. We would not be planting them as permanent additions to a landscape if they were not. Educate yourself on plants that are in your landscape and learn which ones will have more trouble with winter temperatures and growing conditions.
