## FFA reaches milestone in St. Tammany Parish

"Every day, I take care of my lamb. Her name is Lady," said Northshore High School senior Joanna Gholson who is one of 530 students who is a member of the Future Farmers of America (FFA) program at her school. For the past two years, the FFA program at Northshore High, located just 30 minutes north of New Orleans, has been acknowledged as the largest program in the state.

"It's the amount of energy and love you put into it," said teacher Todd Tarifa who, along with a few other teachers, took the program from 175 students to more than 319 when he arrived at the school four years ago. More than 500 students have elected to take agriculture courses this year. "We want to give every student who walks in the door a good day and a reason to come to school. We have a very welcoming environment"

Gholson says the program did just that for her. "I was very quiet and to myself. I did not have an agriculture background, but I loved animals. Having to take care of the broilers in the beginning and now my lamb has increased my level of responsibility."

Gholson isn't the only one who says the FFA program was something completely different from what she was used to. Tenth grader Jacob Negueloua says he enjoys the responsibility of going to feed his lamb and keeping it healthy. "Over time, I've gotten more and

more interested in agriculture related work."

Senior Tyler Nienaber, who had zero agriculture background, now plans to study horticulture at Mississippi State University. "When we started working in the garden, it gave me a different perspective. I got a part-time job at a farm and I decided this is what I wanted to do. I want my own farm one day." Nienaber acknowledges that his family is a bit surprised by the direction in which he is going but they fully support him.

"We all learn from experience. None of these kids had ever put their hands on livestock until they joined this program," said Tarifa.

Farming isn't the only skill the students learn. They're also exposed to wood working. Senior Cole Danovsky grew up on a farm in north Mississippi so he's had some experience with livestock. Now, he's turned his interest toward the wood working aspect and even won the derby contest for most original and best looking derby car.

This is also where the students learn carpentry and take safety courses that are beneficial if they go into construction. "It teaches you how to work with your hands and determine how to make that car go faster.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Timber Theft Arrest in Bossier Parish

Baton Rouge, La. (December 30, 2015) - An investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) resulted in the arrest of a Minden man on two counts of felony timber theft.

Bennie Moore, 62, of 484 Deerfield Blvd., was arrested Wednesday morning and booked into the Bossier Parish Detention Center.

The arrest is the result of a complaint filed by several Plain Dealing landowners who are heirs

to 76 acres of timberland located off Sam Booker Road, south of Plain Dealing.

According to investigators, Moore's business, Piney Woods Timber Co., signed a contract with nine heirs in which he paid them just over \$61,000 in July 2015. Investigators say Moore then sold the timber to a logging contractor in Sarepta who cut the timber. Several additional heirs then discovered the timber was cut. Investigators say they contacted Moore who offered them a fraction of what he had paid

the original nine heirs.

Investigators say there are approximately 50 heirs involved on two separate tracts. Moore was reportedly arrested on five previous occasions since 2000 for similar activities.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "Under the state's 80 percent statute, loggers must obtain at least 80 percent consent from the heirs before timber can be purchased. Our investigators take these complaints very

seriously and we work closely with our landowners and loggers to ensure that the logging is done in a professional manner. Timber is a long term investment and we want to make sure that both parties operate legally."

The LDAF is continuing its investigation and asking the public if they have had any business dealings in the past three years with Moore. If so, please contact the department at (225) 925-4500.

Moore's bond was set at \$100,000.

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## Low prices for wheat, feed grains likely to persist

OPELOUSAS, La. – Low grain prices are not expected to increase soon because of excess supply and lower demand, according to an LSU AgCenter economist who spoke with farmers at a wheat and feed grain meeting on Jan. 21.

“Prices are still under significant pressure,” said Kurt Guidry.

Guidry said while yields for wheat, cotton, soybeans and grain sorghum were down in Louisiana last year from 2014, total U.S. production was still near record levels for many commodities.

“With large production levels and lackluster demand, carryover stocks remain high for most commodities. Even for those commodities that didn’t experience large production and supply levels in 2015, lower overall demand continues to keep stocks at troublesome levels,” he said.

China’s economic growth rate has slowed, he said, and the strong dollar makes American commodities more expensive overseas. Guidry said acreage and production for commodities this year will affect prices.

“The one positive we can take from the current market is that prices have been relatively resistant despite the poor supply and demand fundamentals,” he said. “Soybeans, for example, have been able to mostly remain in the mid to upper \$8-per-bushel range despite a near record U.S. crop in 2015 and record production in South America.”

He said China is buying South American soybeans.

Because of low prices and lower yields in Louisiana for 2015, Guidry said he anticipates that more commodities will be eligible for Price Loss Coverage payments. He also anticipates more commodities and more parishes will be eligible for Agricultural Risk Coverage payments administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Last year, Price Loss Coverage payments were primarily only available for rice, and Agricultural Risk Coverage payments were only available for a few commodities in selected parishes.

Boyd Padgett, LSU AgCenter plant pathologist, said wheat acreage in Louisiana at 50,000 or less is the lowest he’s seen in years.

Poor planting conditions resulted in late planting for many farmers, he said. “All in all, it’s very poor,” Padgett said.

Trey Price, LSU AgCenter plant pathologist, said choosing a soybean variety with resistance to frogeye leafspot is the best way to

avoid spending money on a fungicide.

Cercospora leaf blight has developed a resistance to fungicides, he said. No resistant varieties are currently available, Price said, but there is hope.

“That’s about to change because of research funded by your dollars,” he told the audience.

Ron Levy, LSU AgCenter soybean specialist, said mid-April is the optimum planting window. He advised that variety selection is the most important part of growing a soybean crop.

Levy said a study of harvest aids showed that Gramoxone resulted in a 1.6 bushels per acre loss from shattering compared to Sharpen at only 0.6 of a bushel.

Daniel Stephenson, LSU AgCenter weed scientist, said ryegrass is the biggest weed problem for corn. One ryegrass plant every 7 feet can reduce yield by 27 percent, he said.

For soybeans, he advised a pre-emerge herbicide followed by Roundup PLUS Dual Magnum early-postemergence to keep fields weed-free for five weeks after emergence.

He said herbicide-resistant rice flatsedge, barnyardgrass and Italian ryegrass have been found in St. Landry Parish, and he expects that resistant johnsongrass will be in the parish soon.

He said farmers in Arkansas, Tennessee and Mississippi are challenged by Palmer amaranth weeds that are resistant to glyphosate and have developed resistance to certain other herbicides such as Valor, Flexstar and Prefix.

“This is scarier than glyphosate resistance,” Stephenson said.

Julien Beuzelin, LSU AgCenter entomologist, said grain sorghum seed should be treated against the sugarcane aphid, which can cause 100 percent yield loss. He said some hybrids have resistance, and the insecticide Sivanto is effective against the pest.

Randy Price, LSU AgCenter engineer, said prices for drones and software have gotten cheaper, making the high-tech aircraft more affordable for checking fields.

New regulations by the Federal Aviation Administration require registration for any aircraft weighing more than 0.55 of a pound by Feb. 21, he said.

Dan Fromme, LSU AgCenter corn specialist, said corn yields continue to increase at the rate of about 2 bushels per year in the U.S. because of improved genetics and new technology.

You're pushed to be more constructive and competitive," said Danovsky.

In order to purchase items such as seeds, gardening tools, derby car kits and to participate in national and state FFA conferences, the students must raise money to keep their program going. While they receive some federal funding (\$50 per student which amounts to about \$21,000), last year, the program had \$98,000 in its account. That additional money came from what the students earned and put back into the program. Last year, they raised 500 chickens which they sold to a vendor in New Orleans. They also sell the vegetables they grow to farmer's markets and to teachers.

But while the students are learning about agriculture and developing skills, the FFA program has taken some students out of their comfort zones and has helped "shaped their personalities" as one student described it. It's also helped some develop friendships with students who normally would not associate with one another.

Senior Whitney McKinzie considers Joanna Gholson one of her closest friends. It's a relationship that started when they joined the FFA program. "I really did not know what to expect when I started with FFA. I just heard it was a lot of fun and you got hands on experience," said McKinzie.

Now she and Gholson show their lambs together at livestock shows and work as a team to care for their animals. "You never have a day off. I think this level of responsibility is training me for college and for future job opportunities. I find that I'm more organized and focused on what I need to do to get things done," added McKinzie.

Both McKinzie and Gholson agree their leadership skills are also developing. "We are more independent and self-sufficient since joining FFA," said McKinzie. Gholson added, "Even though we're having fun, there is a serious side of things when you're working, even when you're working in agriculture."

McKinzie is considering majoring in agricultural business. Gholson wants to continue to work with animals but has not decided on a college major.

The program also includes an internship. Year round, these students manage the poultry program and the gardens. "Some of the benefits of growing a garden teaches the students that not only is the food fresher, but they can save money by having a home garden," said Tarifa.

## Cinco de Mayo named 2016 Gulf District Rose of the Year

HAMMOND, La. – Because rose growers and enthusiasts surveyed in Louisiana and Mississippi have been impressed with the great landscape performance of Cinco de Mayo, the Gulf District of the American Rose Society has named the variety as the 2016 Gulf District Rose of the Year.

“Cinco de Mayo is an outstanding floribunda rose that has done well in southern United States trials since its 2009 introduction from Weeks Roses and is an All-America Rose Selections winner,” said LSU AgCenter horticulturist [Allen Owings](#).

Cinco de Mayo flowers have 25 petals, are 3-3 1/2 inches in diameter and are slightly fragrant with the scent of cut apples. “The uniqueness of Cinco de Mayo is the bloom color – described as smoky lavender to a blend of rusty-orangy red,” Owings said.

In the landscape, Cinco de Mayo is a slower grower. Mature

height is 36-42 inches with an equal spread. Plants have a nice deep glossy green foliage appearance. Cinco de Mayo would work well blended into perennial flower beds.

Individual plants should be placed 3 feet apart in the landscape for best performance.

This low-maintenance rose does not want to be pampered, Owings said. Water it occasionally during dry weather the first year or two after planting. Once it is established, this rose, as with most tough landscape roses, rarely requires supplemental irrigation.

Cinco de Mayo also is adaptable to planting in a container.

“More problems with these roses are likely created by overwatering than by anything else,” Owings said. If extraordinarily dry weather does occur and irrigation is necessary, water deeply and thoroughly no more often than once a week.

Mulching roses with 2 or 3 inches of pine straw reduces maintenance by suppressing weed problems and conserving soil moisture.

Cinco de Mayo stays generally disease free in the landscape, and fungicides are normally not needed.

“You can spray spinosad or summer horticultural oil for most insect problems,” Owings said. “If blackspot becomes a problem due to rainfall or over-irrigation, spray with mancozeb followed by a fungicide containing the systemic fungicide propiconazole. Be sure roses are planted in full sun to lessen disease problems.”

Cinco de Mayo joins Belinda’s Dream, last year’s inaugural recipient in the list of American Rose Society Gulf District Rose of the Year winners.

Most independent retail garden centers in the region carry Cinco de Mayo.

## Update on Gas Tank Skimming Devices

Baton Rouge, La. (January 28, 2016) – The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Weights and Measures division, the United States Secret Service and local sheriff’s offices continue their investigations into skimming devices at gasoline pumps.

Since June 2015, the task force has found 23 skimming devices throughout the state with alert clerks finding two for a total of 25. These devices contained a total of 801 credit/debit card numbers.

The three skimming devices found by LDAF Weights and Measures inspectors were located in Ascension Parish and two different locations in East Baton Rouge Parish.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, “As we hear more and more about this type of crime, our inspectors are removing anything suspect from the gasoline pumps. Convenience stores are also aware we are out there looking and are alerting the LDAF and their local authorities when they believe something is wrong.”

Skimming devices are typically easily recognized when the gas pump credit card machines are opened because they are an additional attachment to the machine. However, a new

type of device is replacing the entire credit card reader making detection much harder.

“We’re now seeing skimming devices that have Bluetooth capability. This tells us these crooks are getting more and more tech savvy making it easier to access the consumer’s personal information,” said Strain.

Some tips to protect your personal information:

Whenever possible, do not use your debit card function at the gas pump. Use it as a credit card.

Monitor your debit/credit card activity online and contact your bank to report unrecognized charges.

Whenever using a credit card, try to use a pump that is easily seen by gas station employees. Pumps that are less visible are commonly targeted because crooks can easily install a skimmer which normally takes very little time.

Parishes where skimming devices have been found include: Acadia, Ascension, East Baton Rouge, Iberia, Jackson, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, St Martin, St. Mary, Tangipahoa and Vermilion.

Once the skimming devices are analyzed, all financial institutions affected are contacted by the Secret Service.
