Louisiana traditions featured on LPB

For famed chef John Folse, food, family and tradition go hand in hand. “The boucherie was the center of the community and we have forgotten that,” said Folse. The internationally known chef hosted a boucherie on a clear, crisp winter day in February as part of a special being taped by Louisiana Public Broadcasting.

“The boucherie is all about family and bringing the community together,” added Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain who was part of the taping. “Family would get together and the older women would share life lessons with the younger women and the men would do the same with the younger men.”

Chefs from all over the country – Colorado, Georgia, Illinois and South Carolina- participated in the event. Feral pig was the highlight of the boucherie. Pork stew, hog head cheese and boudin were additional dishes to name a few.

“We’re showing what can be done with wild pigs,” said Strain. Strain added that the state is harvesting about 350,000 wild pigs each year. Five hundred thousand must be harvested to help manage the population. “This could be a way of turning a negative into a positive,” said Folse.

For Charlie Munford with Two Run Farm, his slaughterhouse in Springfield, Louisiana provides locally grown meat to New Orleans restaurants. His slaughterhouse is the first in the state to harvest wild hogs. “So far, we’ve processed about 200 wild hogs that have gone into local restaurants. Personally, I

love it. It has a nutty flavor, isn’t too gamey and is a pretty lean meat,” said Munford.

The wild boar goes into a state inspected slaughterhouse and put into commerce.

“My dream is to take these inspected hogs, make ham and sell it,” said Folse. “This is exciting to me. To take a feral hog from Louisiana and put a Louisiana label on it is great.”

This is just one tool to help manage the wild hog population. The LDAF is considering ways to help mitigate the damage these wild hogs cause to land and crops across the state by humanely harvesting them.

The goal of the LDAF is to help control the feral swine population, reduce agricultural damage, limit damage to coastal areas and levees and keep the domestic animal population disease free. With an estimated 500,000 feral pigs in Louisiana, the LSU AgCenter reports that the hogs caused \$75 million of agricultural damage in 2013. In an effort to control the population, the meat products processed from feral swine could eventually be purchased in restaurants, grocery stores, local markets and individual consumers.

Only feral hogs harvested and processed in USDA or state inspected facilities may be sold commercially for meat.

The John Folse “Fete des Bouchers” is scheduled to air sometime this spring on LPB. It will also be distributed nationwide to air on Public Broadcasting System (PBS).





LSU AgCenter scientist looks at sugar byproducts for making polymers

(02/22/16) BATON ROUGE, La. – An LSU AgCenter scientist is exploring using byproducts of sugar processing to make polymers.


Michael Vincent, a postdoctoral researcher at the Audubon Sugar Institute, has made polymers using aconitic acid derived from molasses and bagasse, the fibrous material left after sugar is extracted from sugarcane. Depending on which chemical reaction is employed, Vincent can make a polyester polymer or a high-strength resin.

The hardness and flexibility of the materials can be fine-tuned with different formulations, Vincent said. Some formulations make a more bendable product, while adding bagasse appears to make a harder and more durable polymer.

Sugar production in Louisiana — an industry valued at \$747 million in 2014 — leaves behind more than 650,000 tons of waste after milling every year. Bagasse can be used as boiler fuel to produce steam that powers sugar mills, but there are few other uses. Most of the molasses is sold for animal feed.

Vincent's work is part of the AgCenter's Sustainable Bioproducts Initiative, which is funded by a five-year, \$17.2 million grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The goal is to find ways to make biofuels and other products using infrastructure already in Louisiana because of the sugar industry.

"There's literally tons and tons of bagasse that are produced each year, and we need to find something to do with it," Vincent said. "The sugar industry has been in Louisiana for over 220 years, and as a native Louisianan, it's something I'd like to see continue and strengthen. Sugar is very important, and if we

can find ways to increase the value of the byproducts, that can only help the industry and the state."

Vincent hopes to find industry partners to help identify uses for the polymers — and he has already thought of a few possible applications. The polyester could be used to make small goods like cell phone cases. The resin could be used for coatings on consumer products and to make lightweight composite parts for the automotive industry.

The polyester and resin both have advantages over products already on the market, Vincent said. The polyester can stand high temperatures without degrading. And the

resin, while similar in consistency to epoxies often used in home improvement projects, is made from a renewable resource.

Vincent continues to search for other polymers that can be made using sugarcane byproducts.

"We want to have different materials and have a portfolio of options that private partners could take and find out if it suits their needs," Vincent said.

He is working on the polymers with Giovanna Aita, an associate professor at Audubon; John Pojman, an LSU chemistry professor; and Pojman's graduate student, Arturo Carranza.
