## Louisiana Agriculture Hall of Distinction honors three agribusiness leaders

**BATON ROUGE, La.** – A veteran agriculture state executive, a top conservationist and an innovative entrepreneur are the latest inductees into the Louisiana Agriculture Hall of Distinction, which honors those who make extraordinary contributions to Louisiana agribusiness.

Held on March 17 at L'Auberge Hotel, the 2016 ceremonies recognized Willie Cooper of Pineville, Ruben Dauszat of Marksville and the late Raymond Hensgens of Crowley.

Cooper served as executive director of the Louisiana Farm Service Agency for an

unprecedented 42 years. Under his leadership, the agency secured billions in U.S. Department of Agriculture farm loans and established hurricane-relief programs for producers. Named Man of the Year by The Progressive Farmer magazine in 2000 and a recipient of the Louisiana Farm Bureau's Lifetime Achievement Award, Cooper is a member of the Louisiana Lions League for Crippled Children.

Named Outstanding Louisiana Master Farmer in 2014, Dauszat was honored for contributions to soil and water conservation, and on-farm environmental stewardship. After graduating from LSU, he served as a research associate at the university, studying the use of foam in protecting strawberry crops from frost damage. Dauszat was also a major promoter of the state's sweet potato and boll weevil eradication programs, and has implemented numerous conservation and best-practices policies on his farms. He is president of the Louisiana Association of Conservation Districts and a strong advocate for Louisiana 4-H.

Hensgens, who passed away in 2013, was honored for his entrepreneurship and the innovations

he made to Louisiana agriculture. Hensgens served nearly 30 years as rough-rice buyer with Dore Rice Mill and went on to form G&H Seed Co., Hensgens Grain Elevator Inc., Hensgens Fertilizer Co. and Quality Equipment Co. He introduced soybeans to Acadia Parish growers and was the first to offer fertilizer in a bulk auger truck. With the Louisiana Commissioner of Agriculture, he helped write and implement laws that directly affected farmers. He received the Louisiana Agricultural Industries Association Lifetime Achievement Award and was known for his work in preserving Acadiana's German heritage.

The Hall of Distinction honors outstanding contributions to Louisiana agriculture in farming, ranching, forestry, aquaculture, education and agribusiness. The annual induction ceremony is presented by the Louisiana Radio Network in cooperation with the LSU AgCenter and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Monsanto serves as title sponsor, and First South Farm Credit is the presenting sponsor.

"The Hall of Distinction is an important way of honoring and thanking individuals in Louisiana's

agricultural community, which is a cornerstone of the state's economy and cultural heritage," says Don Molino, Louisiana Radio Network farm director. "We recognize inductees for contributions that have a major impact on agribusiness in our state and, in many cases, around the world."

Founded in 1974, Louisiana Radio Network provides 63 radio stations throughout Louisiana and parts of Mississippi with news, sports and agri-news. ## Protect homes and businesses from termites after flooding

**Baton Rouge, La.** (March 23, 2016) - Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging builders and homeowners to take steps to prevent the spread of termites as they remodel and clean-up following the recent flood event.

“If your community flooded and soil around your home or business washed away, the applied termiticide barrier may no longer exist and the area may need to be retreated,” Strain said. “Termite bait stations need to be evaluated

for replacement as well. If you have a termite contract, you should contact your pest control company for an inspection.”

Homeowners or business owners who do not have termite contracts, should also consider contacting a pest control company since structures that have flooded are prone to infestation by termites. Structures are typically treated with a termite control product either before, during or after construction. Some owners also choose to build with termite-treated or termite-resistant products.

“Consumers should contact the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry at 225-925-4578 to make sure the pesticide company you hire is fully certified and licensed. This protects you, your family, your home or your business,” said Strain.

Treatments and annual inspections by a licensed, insured and bonded pest control company protect your homes and businesses from termite damage. Between professional inspections, owners should periodically inspect their

home or business for evidence of termites. Look for mud tubes on the slabs, piers or walls and pinholes in wallboards, softness in flooring or blisters in paint or wallpaper.

“Termite colonies are constantly looking for new food sources. Now is the time to take proactive measures to prevent termites from destroying your investments,” added Strain.



# LSU AgCenter lab offers soil testing service for spring planting

Many people will head to their gardens this spring with hopes of growing beautiful flowers and a plentiful harvest of vegetables. But those hopes may be dashed if they aren't familiar with the properties of their soil.

Testing soils can provide useful information on what nutrients are — or are not — present so any deficiencies can be addressed. The LSU AgCenter Soil Testing and Plant Analysis Lab can test soils, as well as plants and water, to help home gardeners and agriculture industry professionals alike achieve better results.

"Many people have soil samples tested only when plants are in trouble, but the time to test and amend your soil is before problems occur," said AgCenter extension associate Sue Chin. "Soil testing will provide you with the information you need to treat your soil so your plants will flourish."

Soil testing can be helpful to homeowners who are sodding lawns or adding new trees, flowers, shrubs and other plants. Landscapers, farmers, agriculture consultants and scientific researchers can also take advantage of the lab's services.

It's a good idea to take soil samples every two to three years because soil

fertility conditions change, Chin said. And samples should be submitted several months before planting to ensure there is time to fertilize properly based on the lab's recommendations.

Soil properties are often overlooked, Chin said, but can greatly affect plant performance. Azaleas, for example, do not grow well in basic soil, which means soil with a pH higher than 7.

"If your soil does not have sufficient nutrients, you will not be able to grow a robust garden," she said.

The lab can also run samples of plant tissue and irrigation and pond water to determine nutrient content.

Soil testing kits are available at any LSU AgCenter parish extension office and numerous nurseries and hardware stores around Louisiana. People should send samples of soils that haven't been amended with fertilizers or lime.

Testing fees will be assessed and vary depending on which tests are requested.

## Oakdale Man Arrested for Arson

**Baton Rouge, La., (March 23, 2016)** - Thirty-seven year old Joseph Stafford, of Oakdale, is charged with simple arson and criminal trespass following a joint investigation between the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF), Allen Parish Sheriff's Office and the Louisiana State Fire Marshal's Office. Stafford was arrested March 8, 2016.

On February 13, 2016, investigators say a 45 acre wildfire began in Allen Parish near Joe Strother Road on Forest Management Company Lands just outside

of Oakdale and spread into Rapides Parish.

Witnesses identified Stafford as setting the blaze and leaving the scene as LDAF fire crews arrived to put out the fire.

LDAF investigators charged Stafford with one count of simple arson and one count of criminal trespassing. Stafford was already incarcerated in the Allen Parish Jail on unrelated charges at the time of his arrest.

"As a result of the recent flooding of the area, damage estimates have been delayed.

It is believed that several thousand dollars of damage was done," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

According to state law, whoever commits the crime of simple arson, where the damage done amounts to \$500 or more, shall be fined not more than \$15,000 and imprisoned at hard labor for not less than two years nor more than 15 years.

For first offense criminal trespass, the fine shall be not less than \$100 and not more than \$500, or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both.
