Acadiana High Serves Up School-Raised Chicken

School raised chickens is what's on the menu at Acadiana High School in Lafayette. A grant from the National Farm to School

Network allowed students at the high school to provide lunch to their fellow students. The initiative is called Seed Change.

"This lunch makes agriculture and farming real to these students," said agri-science teacher Brandon Broussard.

Approximately 350 students participate in the agriscience program. Many of them are also 4-H and National FFA Organization members.

Acadiana High School received the \$27 thousand grant at the beginning of the school year. Louisiana, Kentucky and Pennsylvania were the three states who benefitted from the grant.

"It's the real world experience they get from planting seeds to picking tomatoes and management in between," said Broussard.

The students raised 100 broilers for the school lunch that fed up to 800 students that day and also featured lettuce and tomatoes from the garden, a vegetable and fruit.

Eight students manage the broilers and members of 4-H have raised \$1,800, so far, this year selling broilers at the parish sale.

The goal is also to learn the science behind agriculture. For 11th grader Bailey Hanks who

grew up on a farm, learning more about seeds and soil is beneficial. "When you grow it yourself, you

know what you're eating," said Hanks.

Acadiana High was one of six demonstration sites selected. Teachers and administrators from other Louisiana Schools that were awarded \$5,000 mini-grants from the National Farm to School Network came to Acadiana High to receive training. At Acadiana

High, there's poultry, a greenhouse, garden and an orchard that grows fruit trees that are native to the area such as citrus and peaches.

"I'd like to add that this endeavor would not have been possible without Celeste Hay, who is the dietitian with the Lafayette Parish School System, and the cafeteria workers on staff. The collaborative efforts of everyone involved made this initiative come to life," said Broussard.

Seed Change is an initiative of the National Farm to School Network aimed at expanding grassroots farm to school activities state by state to support better health outcomes for children and economic opportunities for local farmers. The 18-month project funded by Walmart Foundation in Kentucky, Louisiana and Pennsylvania will increase the number of students engaged in farm to school activities and strengthen statewide farm to school networks for long term sustainability.

LDAF now accepting SCBGP applications

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is now accepting applications for the 2016 Specialty Crop Block Grant Program (SCBGP), Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., announced today.

Applications must be received no later than close of business (4:30 p.m.) May 9, 2016.

The LDAF will administer the grant program funded through the United States Department of Agriculture – Agricultural Marketing Service (USDA-AMS). The USDA allocated \$314,385.77 to fund Louisiana projects.

The grants are to be used for projects that solely enhance the competitiveness of Louisiana-grown specialty crops like fruits,

vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits, horticulture, Christmas trees, turf grass/sod, nursery and greenhouse crops.

Individual farms are not eligible to apply; however, producer associations, state and/or local organizations, state or local governments, qualified educational institutions, non-profits and other specialty crop stakeholders are eligible recipients. Applicants must reside in or their business or educational affiliation must be in Louisiana. All applicants are required to obtain a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number and include that number on their application.

Grant funds will not be awarded for projects that directly benefit

a particular commercial product or provide a profit to a single organization, institution or individual. Projects should focus on issues to help improve specialty crop industries as a whole such as: distribution, production, research, market development, food safety, promotion and education.

LDAF will accept grant applications with a yearly budget value of up to \$100,000. Grants can be awarded for projects lasting up to two years and 11 months.

Once the deadline has passed, all applications submitted to the LDAF will be carefully evaluated to determine if the projects are qualified based on the criteria listed in the guidelines. All submitted project applications deemed qualified will

be reviewed and scored by a panel consisting of industry stakeholders, and the panel will make funding recommendations to LDAF. All LDAF approved projects will be incorporated into one state grant request, which will be submitted to the USDA.

LDAF has prepared a Request for Applications (RFA) document detailing application instructions, scoring criteria, federal forms, project format examples and other helpful information from the USDA. The document may be found at www.LDAF.la.gov. Click on the 2016 Specialty Crop alert.

Cover crops offer farmers benefits

(04/08/16) ALEXANDRIA, La. – LSU AgCenter researchers at the Dean Lee Research and Extension Center are studying the use of cover crops, which are grown in the off-season for erosion control, improved fertility and an increase in organic matter in the soil.

“Overall, the research showed us there was a good increase in yield,” LSU AgCenter economist Naveen Adusumilli said at a cover crop field day at the Dean Lee Research Station on April 6.

Yields increased by as much as 20-30 percent in the first year of testing cover crops grown in the winter before cotton, he said.

AgCenter corn specialist Dan Fromme said he will be testing cover crops with corn at a farm in Beauregard Parish using crimson clover, tillage radish and rye to see what advantages can be realized. He also has a series of cover crop research plots at the Dean Lee

Research Station.

Chris Coreil, with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service, said money is available to help farmers use cover crops up to five years. He said it may take longer than three years to see any benefit to using cover crops, and yields may even decline for the first two years.

“You are trying to adjust the soil ecosystem with a cover crop,” Coreil said.

The roots of tillage radishes won’t grow through a hard pan soil layer, he said.

The NRCS will pay \$50 to \$70 per acre to help farmers try cover crops, but he advised farmers to start with a small acreage.

Cover crops are planted in the fall after harvest and have to be killed before the subsequent main crop is planted. In northern states, cover crops are killed by freezing weather, but Louisiana farmers

have to use herbicides because of the warmer weather.

AgCenter weed scientist Daniel Stephenson said testing of several herbicides on tillage radish showed that a combination of glyphosate and 2,4-D herbicides showed the best results.

Herbicides should be applied four to six weeks before a crop is planted to eliminate the food source for insects that could become pests on the main crop, he said.

Tillage radish that goes to seed becomes more difficult to kill, he said.

AgCenter soil microbiologist Lisa Fultz said the cover crop project includes a study of how cover crops may benefit soybean production by adding nutrients to the soil.

AgCenter area agent Donna Morgan said the studies will provide information for using cover crops in Louisiana’s unique growing conditions. “There are a lot of things we don’t know,” she said.

LSU College of Agriculture scholarship honor late Pointe Coupee county agent

(04/08/16) BATON ROUGE, La – Louis Curet, a retired Baton Rouge attorney, is honoring his late father, A.B. Curet, by establishing an endowed scholarship in the LSU College of Agriculture in his name.

The elder Curet was the LSU AgCenter county agent in Pointe Coupee Parish for 40 years. The A.B. Curet Scholarship for Agriculture will benefit students studying agricultural education – a degree suited for someone hoping to work as an agricultural or 4-H agent.

Curet said his father started his career in 1916 after graduating from Mississippi State University.

“The county agent was a big deal in those days,” Curet said. He said there was no veterinarian in the rural parish, so his father was responsible for vaccinating many of the animals in the area.

There also was no electricity in Pointe Coupee Parish either when his father moved there from Kiln, Mississippi.

“My father was instrumental in getting electricity to the area,” Curet said, adding that his father was actively involved in Pointe Coupee’s Rural Electric Association.

Curet’s father also raised cattle and grew crops on his land in Mix, Louisiana.

“He knew his cattle inventory. If one was missing, he knew which one it was,” Curet said.

Curet’s daughter, Jeanne James, an alumna of the LSU College of Agriculture, said the people of Pointe Coupee thought so highly of her grandfather, they made him the first adult king of New Roads Mardi Gras.

“I’ve had several prominent farmers tell me they owe their career to my grandfather,” James said.

Louis Curet is a 1947 graduate of LSU. He received his law degree from the LSU Law Center three years later. He also has had a distinguished career that kept his ties with agriculture. He worked as an attorney for 55 years, serving as legal counsel for Louisiana Farm Bureau for 40 years.

Curet served as the president of Baton Rouge Bar

Association from 1972-1973. He was inducted in the LSU Alumni Hall of Distinction in 2002.

Curet and his late wife, Jean Harvey Curet, extended their philanthropy to many causes. He has been an ardent supporter of the LSU Department of French Studies, funding an international internship in France. He was a founder and the first president of the Friends of the French Studies. Starting in 2002, Curet, who is now 88, would travel to France for six weeks every year. His last trip was in 2013.

Curet hopes his latest gift will help students pursue a career in agricultural education.

“I want people to promote agriculture as much as they can. It’s a great profession,” Curet said.



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
