

Protect homes and businesses from pests after flooding

Baton Rouge, La. - Once flooding recedes and repairs begin on homes and businesses, Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., urges builders and homeowners to take steps to prevent the spread of termites and rodents.

"If your community floods and soil around your home or business washes away, you will need to re-treat that area because the

termite barrier may no longer exist," Strain said. "Termite bait stations need to be evaluated for replacement as well. If you have a termite contract, you should contact your pest control company for an inspection."

Homeowners or business owners who do not have termite contracts should also consider contacting a pest control company since structures that have flooded are prone to infestation by termites.

Structures are typically treated with a termite control product before, during or after construction. Some owners also choose to build with termite-treated or termite-resistant products.

Strain also adds that everyone should be mindful of other pests and rodents that will be attempting to get away from flood waters and looking for food. "Rats carry disease. You may want to get a licensed pest control company to

put out traps. Consumers should contact the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry at 225-925-4578 to make sure the pest control companies you hire are fully certified and licensed. This protects you, your family, your home or your business," said Strain.

Hire licensed arborists/contractors to work on storm-damaged trees and property

Baton Rouge, LA (August 16, 2016) – Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding residents to hire only professional-licensed arborists to perform work on storm-damaged trees.

“Anyone doing tree work in Louisiana is required to obtain a license through the LDAF,” Strain said. “Hiring only licensed-professional arborists protects you, the homeowner, since licensed arborists are not only trained to properly execute tree work, but they must also maintain liability insurance. I also urge you to get a written estimate and, while you may be required to pay a reasonable deposit, you should never pay for the job in full up front.”

Strain also says if someone knocks on your door and offers to cut tree limbs, ask to see their license and a current copy of the arborist's liability insurance certificate. According to the Louisiana Horticulture Law: No person shall receive fees, advertise or solicit business in a regulated profession or occupation unless this person holds the appropriate license or permit, or has a regu-

lar employee who holds the appropriate license or permit, or is employed by a person who holds the appropriate license or permit. In addition, all licensees are required to place their license numbers on all business-related vehicles that have advertisements on them.

“This is also something to keep in mind if someone approaches you about doing repairs to your home. Please make sure that person is licensed and insured. Following disasters, people come out of the woodwork to make money. Protect yourself. Do not give anyone money in advance unless you know they are reputable. Have a written contract and just be cautious,” added Strain.

No license is required for persons doing tree debris removal, which includes cutting up and hauling away fallen trees. Strain added, “Any work on a tree or portion of a tree still standing will require an arborist license.”

Consumption of crops exposed to flood waters

Baton Rouge, LA (August 17, 2016)
– Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., says pay close attention to the Federal Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) warnings pertaining to crops exposed to flood waters.

According to the FDA, the edible portion of a crop exposed to flood waters is considered adulterated under section 402(a)(4) (21 U.S.C. 342(a)(4)) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and should not be consumed. The FDA recommends that these crops be disposed of in a manner that ensures they are kept separate from crops that have not been flood damaged to

avoid adulterating "clean" crops.

The food crops include but are not limited to:

- Surface crops such as leafy greens, tomatoes, string beans, berries, and corn
- Underground crops, such as peanuts, potatoes, carrots, and garlic
- Crops with a hard outer skin or shell, such as watermelon and winter squash
- Grains, nuts, corns, and similar products stored in bulk

For crops that were in or near flooded areas but where flood waters did not contact the edible portions of the crops, the growers

should evaluate the safety of the crops for human consumption on a case-by-case basis for possible adulteration.

"Food safety is a top priority for the LDAF. If any producer has questions or concerns, please contact our office for guidance," said Strain.

Flood waters may have been exposed to sewage, chemicals, heavy metals, pathogenic microorganisms or other contaminants. Therefore, knowledge of the sources of flood waters and any possible upstream contributors of human pathogens and/or chemical contaminants will help evaluate the likelihood of crop contamination by flood waters.


Thousands forced from homes into shelters

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry deployed its mobile pet shelter to the Baton Rouge River Center shelter. Snowball was the first of many residents. The mobile pet shelter can hold about 50 pets and equipped with metal cages, generator, battery power and a cleaning station.
