Josh Williams of Galvez, La. arrived at Lamar Dixon Expo Center in Gonzales to pick up his dog, Shadow. The golden retriever greeted Williams with hugs and kisses - happy to head home.

Meanwhile at the Lamar Dixon cattle barn, Tommy Canine of St. Amant, was tending to his Shire draft horses. He was luck, Canine said his home is built up and was spared but he had five or six feet of water on his property and had to catch and move the horses to higher ground. "We couldn't get a trailer to them because of the water so we had to catch them and lead them about a mile," Canine said. "When we got here, they wouldn't even eat which is unusual for these guys. They just stood here with their heads down...they were just exhausted."

Williams and Canine are among the thousands of people who suffered flood damage from a slow moving storm system which began Aug. 11, 2016. The unnamed storm caused heavy rainfall and widespread flooding in south Louisiana.

Twenty parishes received federal disaster declarations: Acadia, Ascension, Avoyelles, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson Davis,

Lafayette, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Washington and West Feliciana.

As of Aug. 29, emergency personnel within the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) continue to coordinate pet resources for East Baton Rouge, Livingston, and Ascension parishes as well as providing emergency fuel support for first responders, generators and pumping stations.

The LDAF provided sheltering support at the Celtic Media Centre shelter, and LDAF Mobile Pet Shelter, staffers, supplies and the LDAF Mobile Command Center operated in conjunction with the Baton Rouge River Center shelter until Aug. 28. The LDAF worked with a number of partners including: Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART), National Animal Rescue & Sheltering Coalition (NARSC) and American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA).

Resources allocated: 6,113 gallons of gasoline and 7,798 gallons of diesel have been dispensed; 906 cages, 281 bowls, 15 tons livestock feed, 3220 pounds dry dog

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Two Arrested on Timber Theft Charges

Baton Rouge, La. (Aug. 24, 2016) – Following a six-month investigation, Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) enforcement agents arrested two men on multiple felony charges.

Tommy Morgan, 68, of Natchitoches, and Kevin Wayne Hill, 49, of Coushatta were charged in Rapides, Jackson and Ouachita parishes with defrauding three timber companies of \$953,990.21.

“Louisiana has some of the strongest timber-theft laws on the books which aid in the investigations and arrests by our highly skilled LDAF enforcement agents,” Strain said.

The investigation was launched

after complaints were filed by Roy O. Martin Timber Co. of Alexandria, West Rock of Hodge, and Graphic Packaging of West Monroe.

Agents said records show Morgan, who was doing business as Diversified Timber Services of Winnfield, already had premium-rate contracts in place with Roy O. Martin, West Rock and Graphic Packaging. Morgan had to deliver timber from high volume tracts of land that were further away from the mills in order to be paid the premium rate.

Morgan was also logging timber from tracts which did not qualify for the premium-contracted rate, agents said. However, Morgan required

the mills the load was coming from qualifying tracts and turn in loads under the wrong landowner’s name and locations. A similar pattern was reportedly also found with Graphic Packaging and West Rock who received pine and hardwood pulpwood.

Morgan was charged with theft by fraud, conspiracy and extortion. Hill, who worked as a timber buyer for Diversified Timber, was charged with theft by fraud and conspiracy.

As part of the alleged scheme, agents said Morgan and Hill ordered loggers both verbally and in writing to turn timber in under the wrong landowner’s names and wrong parishes or lose their equipment which was financed through Diversified Timber.

Agents executed a search warrant

on Morgan’s business and found from January 2012 – March 2016, loggers working for Diversified Timber delivered 18,952 loads of timber. Between records furnished by the mills and those obtained through the search warrant, agents found 5,731 loads which were fraudulently turned in under the wrong name and wrong parish which resulted in Diversified Timber being paid about \$1,049,000 more than the company was entitled to receive; however, the statute of limitations had already expired on \$95,009.79 of the total overpayment.

LDAF agents said both Morgan and Hill confessed to the crimes.

“LDAF enforcement agents take agriculture and forestry-related crimes seriously and they will seek justice when individuals break the

law,” Strain said. “I advise anyone who believes they may be victim of timber theft to immediately report a suspected crime.”

To report a timber theft, contact the Office of Forestry at 225-925-4500 to file a complaint.








Ascension Parish horse owner Tommy Canine follows his horses in a pirogue to bring them to safety. Photo provide by Tommy Canine.

food, 24 cans wet dog food, 180 lbs. cat food and 76 personnel.

The LDAF also continues to transport and store USDA commodities for food banks and shelters. The LDAF is also providing warehouse space to the Greater Baton Rouge food bank until they can get their warehouse back online.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, this storm brought unprecedented flooding requiring thousands of boat rescues shining a spotlight on the greatest lesson we learned from Hurricane Katrina which is that saving pets, saves people.

"Countless lives were lost during Katrina because many people refused to evacuate if they had to leave their pet behind," Strain said. "Legislation was passed in 2006 allowing pet owners to evacuate with their pet if there is room in the boat."

Strain routinely assessed pet shelter conditions. In many cases, people escaped floodwaters with just a few belongings and their beloved pets. Strain said, "A number of folks I spoke with said they wouldn't have left their pets and were happy they could evacuate with them."

"There are a lot of moving parts that comes with managing emergency animal evacuations and sheltering," Strain said. "Along with our LDAF emergency personnel, we rely on our partners with LSART, ASPCA, NARSC and other volunteer groups to assist in fulfilling our mission."

On Aug. 29, the LDAF relocated pets housed in the mobile pet shelter at the Baton Rouge River Center to Dixon Correctional Institute (DCI) in Jackson, La. As response moves into the recovery phase, the LDAF looks towards better long term solutions for the health of the pets as officials work toward housing solutions for those in the shelter.

The mobile pet shelter was activated Aug. 15. The facility is intended only as a temporary housing for displaced pets in an effort to co-locate pets and their owners. At DCI, the pets are paired with an inmate trustee who will care for that pet. The DCI animal shelter was built in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. This emergency pet shelter is often used in disasters. The LDAF worked with the Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) and the American Red Cross, to inform the shelter residents and to help them cope with the stress of being apart from their animals. DOTD will transport owners to visit their pets daily until their transition to housing takes place and they can be reunited full-time with their pets.

The LDAF has set up a Gofundme account to assist with animal relief efforts by the LDAF and parish governments. The funds collected will be used to provide supplies and equipment necessary to care for pets and livestock in shelters operated by the LDAF and parish governments.
