Louisiana, Cuba trade partners?



Cuba might be known for its prized cigars and vintage cars, but Commissioner Mike Strain is working to gain a new market for Louisiana agricultural commodities.

Isis Maria Salcines father started what is now the largest organic co-op in Cuba back in 1997. They started with five workers but now have 150. "Producing food is even more important than being a doctor or a lawyer. The principle mission

of the farm is to produce food for the community," said Salcines. "We produce food out of necessity. When the Soviet Union fell in the 1990s, people were starving," she added.

This urban farm sits on a 25 acre

piece of land that produces mostly vegetables-lettuce, tomatoes, cucumber and cauliflower-some ornamental plants. The co-op is also the main producer of mint for Havana. Ninety percent of what is grown is sold to the community while 10 percent is sold to the hotel industry.

"The embargo helped us in that we became independent for organic agriculture. We had to be organic because we did not have chemicals," said Salcines.

What they are lacking is equipment/implements. Bulls till the land. "You need those implements and we have those implements. We'd love to sell equipment to you," said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., on his visit to the farm in July with a 94-person delegation promoting agricultural trade, economic development and tourism.

"The longer I am here and talk to agricultural officials, the more I am convinced this could be a big market for Louisiana rice," said rice and sugarcane farmer Jim Harper of

Cheneyville, La. "We are two days from shipping rice to Cuba and we have a better quality product than

need," added cattle rancher Marty Wooldridge of Oil City, La. Wooldridge agrees there is a great

possibility to trade with Cuba if the financing issues can be overcome. Cuba is cash poor and trades with other countries on credit.

"With 80 percent importation, they want to improve dairy, beef and vegetables. The younger generation wants a better life. They're very concerned about food security," added Wooldridge.

On a visit to Cuba's version of the Farmers Market, Commissioner Strain was approached by Raul Jose Perez, a former agro-economist at the University of

Havana. "We need good, quality food in Cuba. We would welcome trade with Louisiana," he added.

Besides financing issues, the Port of Havana is also restricted by a tunnel located at the entrance of the port. In 2013, the Mariel Special Development Zone was created to **See Trade, cont. on page 20**

our Asian competitors."

Cuba imports 80 percent of its food for its 11 million residents and estimated three million visitors. Cubans also consume the most rice, per capita, in the western hemisphere. Rice is primarily imported from Vietnam.

"We have everything they

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Agricultural Trade Mission to Cuba

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., recently returned from the island nation of Cuba, where he led a 94-person delegation promoting agricultural trade, economic development and tourism.

“We accomplished a great deal during our short visit to Cuba, including opening a dialog with Cuban officials and developing business relationships,” Strain said. “Also, we have a better understanding of what the country’s needs are – and how Louisiana can fulfill those needs – by visiting

places such as an organic farm, tobacco and corn farm, farmers market, grocery store and the port in Mariel.

“Trade barriers between the U.S. and Cuba could be relaxed in the near future. It is critical to establish these important business relationships now in order to gain access to new market opportunities for our Louisiana agricultural producers when it does.”

Cuba actually imports 80 percent of its produce. Specifically, Cuba imports rice from Vietnam.

Strain said Cuba is in great need of products which Louisiana can

provide. “Our ports are the largest in the U.S.; Louisiana exports \$439 million worth of rice each year. Cuba imports \$173 million of rice per year and on average consumes more than 177 pounds of rice annually, consuming the most rice per capita in the Western Hemisphere.”

Cuban economist Jorge Mario Sanchez added, “When the Soviet Union collapsed, all supplies ended. The state of our agricultural industry includes old technology. That makes it difficult for us to keep up,” said Sanchez.

As explained by officials in meetings, the embargo is the “elephant in the room” and the challenge is normalization.

“Cuba imports almost \$2 billion in agricultural products each year. The country needs commodities such as wheat, corn, pork, poultry, soybeans, petroleum and mechanical implements,” said Strain.

Currently, a major obstacle in doing business with Cuba requires third-party financing and issues with credit. Simply put, Cuba is cash-poor.

“Our products are the highest quality and safest that can be delivered at the most competitive price because of the short distance between Cuba and Louisiana,” said Strain.

“We have to get through some hurdles in Washington and get the Crawford Amendment passed so we can have the same trade rules as every other nation. We can improve their quality of life, but their economy has to grow. We’re here to be on a level playing field.”

Cuban officials are also reviewing products and technologies they can export to the United States if the trade embargo is lifted. Cuban economist C. Mario Pablo Estrada

Garcia said, “We’ve worked on soybeans that are fungi-resistant. We think this will be a significant contribution from Cuba.”

William Marshall with Louisiana Economic Development (LED) said, “We can benefit the people of both Louisiana and Cuba through trade with Cuba. While we cannot import from Cuba under the U.S. embargo, there are some current opportunities to export some staple Louisiana products such as rice and poultry. Over the last decade, Louisiana has led all other states in exports to Cuba, and we hope the next 10 years will be equally productive.”

According to researchers at Tulane University, in 1958 a third of all trade passing through the Port of New Orleans was destined for Cuba. In addition to Louisiana’s close proximity to the island nation and cultural similarities between the two places, Louisiana agribusiness produces many products that are in demand in Cuba.

“One in five jobs is associated with trade in Louisiana, and the state has unsurpassed trade infrastructure and diverse agricultural products. We have the busiest port system in the world, and we are one of two states where all six Class 1 railroads converge,” added Marshall. The U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation has ranked Louisiana the No. 1 exporting state, according to LED.

Strain said several members of the group gained invaluable knowledge. In order to trade with Cuba, Louisiana must:

1) Continue to develop its

relationship/interest in trade with Cuba

- 2) Identify which businesses can actually be developed in Cuba
- 3) Start requesting licenses to do business

While in Cuba, Strain presented Cuban government officials with Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) for consideration. Signing of the MOUs would initiate trade agreements.

Joe Accardo, the executive director of the Ports Association of Louisiana, said, “We are in a prime position to export agricultural products, petrochemicals and the cruise industry.”

With 32 ports, Louisiana moves more than 500 million tons of cargo, much of it agricultural products added Accardo.

Members of the agricultural delegation included cattle ranchers, rice, soybean and sugarcane farmers.

Strain and Governor John Bel Edwards plan to visit Cuba in October to continue to develop these trade agreements.



USDA designates natural disaster areas caused by Aug. storms

Baton Rouge, La. (September 21, 2016) – The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has designated 11 parishes in Louisiana as primary natural disaster areas because of the recent storms and flooding. This means, some Louisiana farmers could be eligible for assistance.

Farmers in Acadia, Ascension, Cameron, Evangeline, Iberia, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, St. James, St. Landry, St. Martin and Vermilion parishes are eligible for low interest emergency (EM) loans from USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible areas have eight months from the date of the declaration to apply for loans to help cover part of their actual losses. FSA will consider each loan application on its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability. FSA has a variety of programs, in

addition to the EM loan program, to help eligible farmers recover.

"As we continue to work to get assistance for our farmers following the historic flooding in August, this is one way agriculture producers can hopefully help sustain these businesses," said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

These parishes are also designated contiguous disaster areas as a result of damages and losses because of the flooding: Allen, Assumption, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, East Baton Rouge, Iberville, Lafourche, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, St. John the Baptist and St. Mary.

Jefferson and Orange counties in the adjacent state of Texas are also named as contiguous disaster counties.

Local FSA offices can provide affected farmers with additional information.

Fresh produce farmers, packers, distribution centers

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry is able to provide fresh produce farmers, packing facilities and distribution centers in Louisiana with basic Good Agriculture Practice/Good Handling Practices (GAP/GHP) audits, as well as, GAPs Harmonized audits (with or without the Global addendum).

GAP audits are a voluntary for hire service that certifies a producer's efforts to provide safe, quality product free from contamination to the consumer.

drive foreign investments in economic development to Cuba. The Port of Mariel, located west of Cuba's capitol city of Havana, has a modern road and rail connection to Havana.

During a visit of the Port of Mariel, Director Charles Baker said the location of Mariel and its proximity to the U.S. could make it a hub and direct gateway to ports in New Orleans, Mobile, Houston and Tampa. As of

now, the port accepts containers but no bulk imports and there is no access to refrigeration.

"What we've learned during this visit is that the Port of Mariel has grown 100 percent in two years. Also, we ship in bulk. However, there's no bulk facility. We would have to make adjustments and ship by container which we can do," said Strain. "This port is growing rapidly. Working on its infrastructure is putting this facility in a prime position to get foreign investment to come in. The scanning station alone is state of the art. That's major," added Strain.

The Cubans are buying the absolute essentials right now. Most imports are from Asia because Asia offers credit. Meanwhile, Cuba exports charcoal, rum, some sugar, coffee and medicines.

David Bertrand of Bertrand Rice in Elton, La. said, "Being able to network on this trip shows a

willingness to talk and a level of comfort that when trade negotiations are lifted, we will be ready for long term negotiations." Bertrand added, "We had

trouble finding rice in the stores but found it in the market. In talking to rice farmers, they plant and harvest by hand. It takes days for them to do what they need to do and they rely on the assistance of their neighbors for help. The rice dries on concrete and they must pick gravel out

by hand. It's heartbreaking. I actually saw heat damaged rice. It was not up to American standards."

For bank executive, Scot Vidrine, his visit to Cuba was to learn about financial and credit needs to facilitate trade with Cuba. While Cuba trades with the U.S. on a limited basis and with cash, expanding trade would require credit terms. "To initiate trade, it's important to accept terms outside ordinary practice. I'm optimistic but we're months away – up to 18 months- from actually being able to do business.

"What I'm told they'll have to do in Havana is the National Bank will issue the letter of credit which is unacceptable to us, but a third bank, most likely international, will stand behind it," said Vidrine.

Strain and Governor John Bel Edwards plan to visit Cuba in October to continue to develop trade agreements.
