## Windy Hills Farm

Ricky and Lisa Peairs started planting Christmas trees in 1999.

It's that time of year when Christmas tree shopping is on the list! For those who want the pick of the crop, they show up on opening day at local choose-and-cut Christmas tree farms.

"We open the day after Thanksgiving. We see some of the same faces every year and that's

really nice," said Ricky Peairs of Windy Hills Farm in Ethel, La. in East Feliciana Parish. "The day after Thanksgiving is chaos, but we love it," added Lisa Peairs.

Ricky and Lisa Peairs started planting Christmas trees in 1999. They started selling them in 2002.

When Ricky and Lisa started

growing Christmas trees, they had no idea how much work it entailed. Seedlings get planted in January, then the trees are staked and tied, there's mowing and trimming, spraying of herbicides and fungicides, shaping of the trees and preparation to sell. It's a year round job. "I did not know this would end my winter and summer fishing," said Ricky.

Today, Ricky and Lisa have about 3,000 trees on about four acres of land.

When families visit their Christmas tree farm, Lisa says it reminds her of her own childhood. "All year long, my brothers and I would search for the perfect Christmas tree in the woods surrounding our childhood home."

That's where traditions start. "One year it snowed. We were reluctant to open, but then people showed up! It was neat. They walked in the snow to find a tree. How often can you get a tree in the snow in Louisiana? That's building memories," said Lisa.

It takes about three to four years, depending on rainfall, to grow a six or seven foot tree. The Peairs' say those are the most popular although people are starting to request even taller trees.

The Peairs' want their customers to find the perfect tree and to have a great experience when they come to Windy Hills Farm. The season

used to last five weekends starting the day after Thanksgiving and extending almost until Christmas Eve, but these days, they nearly sell out the first two weekends after they open. People want to ensure

they can pick from the better trees.

At Windy Hills Farm, customers can cut down their own tree. However, the Peairs' always have workers, or "elves" on hand to assist, if necessary. The farm provides saws so customers do not need to bring them. Trees are shaken by a machine to remove debris after leaving the field. They can also be netted if the customer wishes. Assistance is available to load the tree and secure it in the customer's vehicle. Several types of tree stands are available at the farm as well as fresh handmade Leyland Cypress wreaths and garlands. There's a small gift store, too, with homemade goods such as jams, jellies and soaps for sale.

The Peairs primarily grow varieties of the Leyland Cypress and Carolina Sapphire trees. Although few, they also buy some fir trees for people who prefer those types of trees. This year, Windy Hills Farms will also have a few colored trees, such as purple, in the event someone wants to be extra creative!

The trees range in price depending on size starting at \$40.

## FDA awards La. millions to implement food safety rule

Baton Rouge, La. (October 19, 2016) – Louisiana is one of 42 states awarded millions of dollars by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration to help implement the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) produce safety rule. The rule, which the FDA finalized in November 2015, establishes science-based minimum standards for the safe growing, harvesting, packing and holding of fruits and vegetables grown for human consumption.

“The overall goal of this project is to enhance Louisiana’s Produce Safety Programs to continue to encourage the safe production of

fresh fruits and vegetables and to promote compliance with the requirements of FDA’s Produce Safety Rule,” said Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “This project will help educate growers and will result in increased implementation of on-farm food safety practices by small, medium and large produce farms in Louisiana. This will develop a state-federal partnership for inspection, compliance and enforcement of the FSMA Produce Safety Rule as required by the law.”

The cooperative agreement

between the FDA and the states provides awardees with the resources to formulate a multi-year plan to implement a produce safety system, develop and provide education, outreach and technical assistance, and develop programs to address specific needs of the growers in their farming communities.

Issues that will be addressed include water quality, applications of raw manure and how to minimize risk of contamination, health and hygiene training for farm personnel who handle fresh produce and sanitation of equipment, tools and

buildings.

States and territories were eligible based on the estimated number of farms growing produce within their jurisdictions. The funding opportunity is for five years, subject to the availability of funding from Congress. Louisiana was awarded \$3.625 million which includes LSU and Southern AgCenters as sub awardees.

Larger farms will need to comply with certain aspects of the produce safety rule requirements beginning in January 2018, with smaller produce operations having additional time to comply.

# USDA issues safety-net payments in response to 2015 market downturn

(ALEXANDRIA, La), Oct. 14, 2016 – USDA Louisiana Farm Service Agency (FSA) State Executive Director, Craig A. McCain announced that approximately 57,500 Louisiana farms that enrolled in safety-net programs established by the 2014 Farm Bill will receive financial assistance for the 2015 crop year. The programs, known as Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC), are designed to protect against unexpected drops in crop prices or revenues due to market downturns.

These safety-net programs provide help when price and revenues fall below normal, unlike the previous direct payments program that provided funds even in good

years. These payments will help provide reassurance to Louisiana farm families, who are standing strong against low commodity prices compounded by unfavorable growing conditions.

“Payments by county can vary because average county yields will differ,” said SED McCain.

“In some cases, the average price for a crop for the market year was higher than the historical benchmark established by the program, so financial assistance did not occur.”


