Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

USDA designates parishes disaster areas due to drought

Baton Rouge, La. (Dec. 16, 2016) – Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) declared 13 parishes as natural disaster areas due to a recent drought.

The primary parishes included under the designation are: Concordia, East Carroll, Grant,

Jackson, LaSalle, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Sabine, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn.

In accordance with section 321(a) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, additional areas were named as contiguous disaster parishes. They are: Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard,

Bienville, Caldwell, Catahoula, De Soto, Evangeline, Lincoln, Madison, Pointe Coupee, Red River, Richland, Tensas, Union and West Feliciana.

Strain said farmers and ranchers located in both primary and contiguous parishes are eligible for low-interest emergency loans from the Farm Service Agency (FSA),

provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible areas have 8 months from the disaster declaration date to apply for the emergency loans.

Healthy Communities initiative works to improve rural health

As three rural parishes wrap up their first year participating in the LSU AgCenter-led Healthy Communities project, community members are now making plans for how they will work to make sustainable changes to improve residents' health in 2017.

The project is a grassroots effort to improve life in rural Louisiana by making healthful foods and recreation opportunities more accessible. It launched in West Carroll Parish in 2013.

When the AgCenter received a two-year, \$1.45 million grant from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention earlier this year, Healthy Communities expanded to St. Helena, Madison and Tensas parishes.

West Feliciana Parish was recently added to the project.

The Healthy Communities concept will soon be implemented statewide through AgCenter family and consumer sciences programs, although the focus will remain on the selected parishes.

AgCenter nutrition agents are leading educational programs and discussions with community members in each of the parishes. All face similar problems, such as obesity, diabetes and heart disease, — that are the result of low availability of nutritious foods and recreation, said Denise Holston-West, a registered dietician with the AgCenter.

Working with the AgCenter on the project is the Pennington Biomedical Research Center, which is assessing communities' needs and their progress toward better health, and the Southern University Ag Center, which is starting school and community gardens in an effort to increase access to healthy foods. The Louisiana Department of Health is also participating.

CDC officials recently visited each of the parishes, where the AgCenter has hosted health fairs, garden projects, nutrition camps for children and community meetings to discuss goals, said Elisabeth Altazan, Healthy Communities program manager.

Efforts in each parish are overseen by a coalition of volunteers, which include residents as well as strategic partners like school board members, police jurors and hospital employees.

"Our coalitions are making plans for projects they want to

accomplish in year two," Altazan said. "They're also talking about long-term plans. They are really focused on making this sustainable."

The initiative has helped bring national experts — like

public health consultant Mark Fenton, who conducted "walk audits" with residents of Greensburg, Tallulah, Newellton and Waterproof — to rural areas that are often overlooked, she said. It has also opened doors to establish more partnerships with

state agencies, including the Department of Transportation and Development and the Baton Rouge-based Center for Planning Excellence.

"The goal is to make the healthy choice the easy choice," Holston-West said.

Much of the first year of the project was spent developing relationships with the communities.

"It takes time to establish trust," she said. "Rural areas are disproportionately affected by nutrition-related chronic diseases, and addressing these issues requires community buy-in. It is a slow process because it takes time and effort to make sustainable change."

Small towns have different challenges than large cities. Many rural Louisiana parishes have high rates of poverty and poor infrastructure, Holston-West said.

Children who live in rural areas are much more likely to be obese, Altazan said.

The coalitions have been trying to solve these problems. In Madison Parish, for example, Tallulah residents decided to revitalize a park in The Fairgrounds neighborhood so children have a safe place to play and adults have a green space for social gatherings, Altazan said.

Residents in each of the parishes have expressed interest in restoring downtowns so they have better walkability, which would add much-needed venues for exercise. DOTD has helped identify ways to make it safer to walk between businesses and other key locations, Altazan said.

The AgCenter has also been working with schools on their wellness policies and with grocery stores to market healthy, convenient options. Access to food remains a struggle for many, however.

"There may be only one grocery store," Altazan said. "In Waterproof in Tensas Parish, you have to drive 15 miles to get to a store. And these places all have high poverty rates, so a lot of people don't have cars. They have to walk or ride a bike."

La. Equine Council annual meeting set for Jan. 14 in Crowley

The Louisiana Equine Council (LEC) will host its Annual Meeting on Saturday, Jan. 14, 2017, at the Rice Arena in Crowley. This year's meeting will have a Working Ranch theme.

Participants are urged to arrive early enough to pay their dues and visit. The meeting will open at 10 a.m. with a brief business meeting, followed by educational demonstrations of ranch riding, ranch roping, and ranch sorting (demonstrators to be determined ahead of time). Morning events will end with a working cowdog demonstration by Bryan Boudreaux and Dan Landry.

After lunch, which is free to LEC members, the Ranch Relay event will be held. Contestants will ride a ranch obstacle course, rope a dummy, crack cups off a post with a bull whip, jump a log, go through thick brush, pull a load, head, heel, brand a steer, load a group of cattle and their horses in a trailer, and do it all in a timed event. Teams will consist of three people, with an entry fee of \$100 per man (or woman). The teams can represent a named ranch, or not, and will compete for belt buckles and cash awards,

with \$500 added money for LEC members. Team members will decide who is on each team. As usual, a negative EIA (Coggins) test will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.

Teams will start out in a 50 foot round

pen, with three horses loose and un-haltered. When the buzzer sounds, riders must catch, saddle and bridle their horses. When the last horse is saddled and the rider mounted, the first rider will leave the pen and begin the obstacle course. After he/she completes the

course and touches the gate, the next rider goes through the gate and rides the course. When the last rider completes the pattern, three head of cattle will be released into the arena. One must be (mock) branded, then the team must load all three and their horses into a stock trailer. Riders may dismount to arrange panels to get the cattle into the trailer. Time stops when the last horse is loaded and the trailer gate is closed. Hot shots are not allowed to be used to load cattle or horses.

Team members must sign up by Jan. 10. A limit of six teams will be allowed. To sign up, send names of competitors, team or ranch name and a \$100 check to La. Equine Council to Howard J. Cormier, 1373 Caffey Road, Rayne, La. 70578. (A registration form will be made available.)

Prospective La. Equine Council members may pay dues at the meeting and sign up for a \$1 million insurance liability policy.
