“When I stand on the farm that my grandfather and my father built, I feel a sense of resiliency. It is our legacy,” said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain at the Century Farm ceremony at the 95th Annual Louisiana Farm Bureau Convention in New Orleans in June.

Four Louisiana farms were recognized as 2016 Century Farm award recipients: Bennett Farm, Faulk Farm, Rogers Farm and Roque Brothers Farm.

“I have had the chance to meet with many of you who have challenges keeping your farms operating, so it is quite an honor to achieve this,” said Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation President Ronnie Anderson.

Bennett Farm was founded by J.M. Risinger in Union Parish in 1877 where they farm beef cattle, hay and timber.

Faulk Farm was founded by Edward Lee Faulk in 1890 in Claiborne Parish. Currently, they farm beef cattle and hay.

Rogers Farm was founded by Israel c. Rogers in 1843 in DeSoto Parish where hay and timber are farmed and horses and goats are raised. It also serves as a wildlife wetland reserve.

Roque Brothers Farm was founded by Emitte Roque in 1916 in Natchitoches Parish. Corn, hay and pecans are farmed.

Lee Faulk is a county agent in Claiborne and Webster

Parishes. He’s also a fifth generation agriculture producer on his family farm in Claiborne Parish. “This is such a great honor and represents all of the hard work of previous generations,” said Faulk. “Hold on to your land. The land will provide. This 226 acre farm raised five generations. These people were poor, but the land still produces today.”

“Food production started with the family farm,” said LSU AgCenter’s Dr. Rogers Leonard. “Imagine all of the things such as weather and disease which can put a strain on the family farm. Farmers and ranchers who’ve owned their farms for more than 100 years have stood the test of time.”

Strain noted the importance of protecting our natural resources which are the heart and soul of agriculture. “Agriculture is the foundation of our economy, but the heartbeat is with the families,” he added.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, LSU AgCenter, Louisiana Land Bank and Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation partner to honor the Century Farm award recipients.

Horse Tests Positive for Eastern Equine Encephalitis

Baton Rouge, LA (July 25, 2017) – An unvaccinated horse in Iberville Parish tested positive for Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding horse owners to vaccinate their animals for both Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and the West Nile Virus (WNV).

“This is the time of year mosquitoes are more prevalent. Horses are infected the same way humans are infected – by being bitten by infected mosquitoes – so everyone needs to take extra precautionary measures at this time,” said Strain.

If a mosquito bites an infected bird, EEE or WNV can be spread to horses, dogs, cats and humans. These mosquito-transmitted

diseases can cause inflammation or swelling of the brain and spinal cord.

Clinical signs can include: fever, loss of appetite, weakness and loss of coordination.

The disease can often result in death.

Prevention includes removing standing water where mosquitos breed and using mosquito repellants that are safe for horses

and humans. Horses can also be vaccinated. So far, there is no vaccination approved for people.

Horse owners should contact their local veterinarian regarding proper vaccination protocols during this time of increased risk.

Veterinarians are required to call the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry if they suspect EEE or WNV in a horse as they are reportable diseases.



Attention producers, sellers, buyers, shippers of baled hay

The USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service regulates the movement of hay out of areas under quarantine for the imported fire ant quarantine zone which includes most of the southeastern United States including Louisiana.

In quarantine areas like Louisiana, USDA only regulates baled hay and baled straw that are stored in direct contact with the ground since it poses a risk for harboring imported fire ants. This hay can move anywhere within the quarantine area but can only move outside of the quarantine area when certain conditions are met.

Baled hay that meets any requirements below is not regulated and has no movement restrictions.

- For baled hay that is stacked, all bales except the bottom layer that is in direct contact with the ground.
- Hay that is cut, baled, loaded, and shipped without storage.
- Baled hay that is stored on an impervious surface such as hard pan (highly compressed soil), asphalt, concrete, etc.
- Baled hay that is stored elevated above the soil on pallets or tires or stored on landscaping cloth placed over the soil.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry officials recommend hay producers, sellers and shippers to contact agriculture officials in the state where hay will be shipped before transporting.

LDAF accepting organic cost-share rebate applications

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said Louisiana agricultural producers and handlers who have either obtained or renewed USDA organic certification may qualify for reimbursement for their certification costs through a cost share rebate program.

The program will reimburse up to 75 percent of certification costs, or up to \$750 per year per certification category.

The rebates are available to cover certification expenses incurred between October 1, 2016 and September 30, 2017.

"Earning the USDA Organic certification for an agricultural product has a number of benefits like adding value and consumer



confidence; however, the certification can be a costly and lengthy process," Strain said.

Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) Oct. 2, 2017.

The program is funded through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA).

The 2017 cost-share

application is available at www.LDAF.la.gov. Reimbursements will be on a first-come, first-served basis, based on receipt of the completed application packet, until available funding is exhausted.

Swine owners should take biosecurity precautions to avoid spread of disease

Owners of pigs need to take precautions against Seneca Valley Virus, a swine disease that has been detected in several states.

The virus causes blisters on pigs' noses, mouths and hooves, often accompanied by lameness, lethargy and fever. It is similar to foot-and-mouth disease and swine vesicular disease.

Only one recent case, which occurred in 2016, of Seneca Valley Virus has been reported in Louisiana. However, a recent uptick in the number of cases in other states should serve as a reminder to swine owners — including children and families who participate in 4-H

and FFA livestock projects — to review their plans for keeping their animals healthy.

"Biosecurity is important," said LSU AgCenter extension veterinarian Christine Navarre.

Biosecurity measures include purchasing animals from reputable sellers, keeping vaccinations up to date, controlling parasites, ensuring animals are properly nourished and regularly consulting with a veterinarian, Navarre said.

Newly purchased animals and those returning from livestock exhibits should be isolated from the rest of the herd for two

to four weeks, depending on the situation. Navarre said a 30-day isolation period is preferred.

"This virus is endemic in some Northern states," she said. "So owners of hogs arriving or returning from out of state should be on high alert."

She also said it's a good idea to disinfect footwear and hauling equipment after shows, fairs and other occasions when those items come in contact with animals from different farms.

Swine owners who notice symptoms of the Seneca Valley Virus or any illness should

contact a veterinarian immediately. Sick animals should be kept away from healthy ones, and they must not be sent to market or to shows.

"This virus is similar to foot-and-mouth disease, which is a foreign animal disease contagious to other livestock," Navarre said. "It is imperative to confirm a diagnosis as soon as possible to protect all livestock industries."
