It's no secret Louisianans love food. It's a special relationship that produces some of the best cooks - from five star restaurant chefs to people who dabble in the kitchen at home and revel in the accolades family and friends bestow upon them.

For New Iberia native Elizabeth "Liz" Grove, she knew her culinary skills would take her to the next level. "I went to culinary school in Santa Monica, California, but I realized early on that I did not want to work in the restaurant business," said Grove.

Grove became a private chef which was a better fit, but she wanted more. "I was out in Los Angeles and started catering on movie sets," said Grove. "That was okay but I felt like I wasn't doing what I was trained to do in culinary school."

Grove said she missed the "beauty" of food and the presentation of it. That is when she says she was introduced to food styling. Grove started working with Chris Oliver who has worked in the movie industry for three decades

Grove describes food styling as the manipulation of food. "What I mean by that is, say you're filming for several hours, it's what you have to do to ensure that the food maintains a consistent appearance throughout the shoot. That could mean adding, subtracting or replacing certain ingredients to keep the food looking fresh," added Grove.

But that's not all. Some actors eat the food if the script requires them to do so. "That can be tricky because what if the actor is a vegetarian but the script requires him or her to eat a chicken leg. Then I have to create that illusion and make something that looks like a chicken leg, but is something that the actor can eat," said Grove. She said it is all about following the script and the character, but some people have certain food allergies or dietary restrictions.

Grove recently wrapped up working on a television series being filmed in New Orleans. Her job often requires historical research. "Depending on the script, you have to understand the region, ethnicity and time period in which the production is taking place. In this particular television show, there is a lot of Russian influence so research was required

so I could get this right."

Grove calls her work "art" because it is so visual. She also works with print which means everything has to be perfect since the photographs are typically taken close-up.

While Grove is now based out of Atlanta, Georgia, she appreciates her local Louisiana roots and honors her Louisiana culture and food. "I love to use local produce and local art to showcase my work. It's all about the appearance." She added, "There are so many facets to a scene so it is finding the hole in the wall business or that one person who does something really unique that I can feature. It also helps support the local economy."

The presentation of the food is often vital to a scene and definitely on a photo shoot. Along the way, Grove has picked up unique platters, baking boards or bowls to showcase her work. Again, she focuses on local woodworkers and artists. She has even started collecting cypress and cedar locally and has started doing her own carving to add to her collection. "It's all about the presentation and illusion," she added.

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Strain meets with vice president, top federal ag officials

Baton Rouge, La. (February 7, 2018) – Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., and his counterparts across the country are calling on Congress to pass a Farm Bill by September with a unified voice.

At a recent meeting in Washington D.C., Strain had unprecedented access to federal cabinet members including USDA Secretary Sonny Perdue, EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt, Special Assistant to the President Ray Starling, Department of Interior Secretary Ryan Zinke and Commissioner of Food and Drug Administration Scott Gottlieb.

A discussion with Vice-President Mike Pence on "cooperative federalism" was also a focus in which national, state and local governments pledge to work together

"When discussions start soon on the Farm Bill, rural broadband expansion, investments in infrastructure and improvements to conservation programs for producers are top priorities," said Strain. "Making agriculture a priority is a way to bring prosperity to rural America," he added.

Strain said streamlining regulatory processes and

embracing science and technology are also priorities in the new Farm Bill

The current Farm Bill expires September 30, 2018.



Flatwoods man arrested for two counts of simple arson

Baton Rouge, La. (February 2018) Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) investigators arrested a Flatwoods, La. man in connection with a suspected arson in Natchitoches Parish.

Twenty-eight year old Leonard Allen Bennett III was arrested February 1, 2018 at his Rapides Parish home by

forestry enforcement agents.

Last December, the Forestry Enforcement Division received a complaint of arson at a timber management company in Natchitoches Parish. Following an investigation, enforcement agents say Bennett admitted to setting two fires, one of which resulted in a loss of \$827.40 of harvested timber.

"Arson is a crime that can quickly get out of control. Not only is property damaged or lost, but depending on where these fires are set, it can threaten people's lives, their homes and valuable timberland," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Bennett was booked into

the Rapides Parish Detention Center where he is currently held without bond awaiting in state extradition to Natchitoches Parish.

If convicted of simple arson where the damage amounts to \$500 or more, penalty includes a fine up to \$15,000 and jail time at hard labor for up to 15

A company must also be in compliance with applicable state and federal permits, licenses and laws. The LDAF determines eligibility.

The certified logos include: Certified

Louisiana, Certified Cajun, Certified Creole and Certified Farm to Table.

There is a \$25 non-refundable application fee. If approved, there is a \$30 registration fee per logo. All logos must be renewed every three years.
