



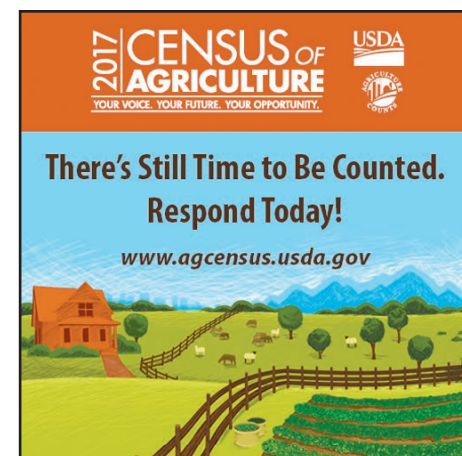

Emergency quarantine for Roseau Cane Scale

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., recently signed an emergency quarantine for Roseau cane scale.

The scale, native to China and Japan, is an insect that destroys Roseau cane which is vegetation that helps protect Louisiana's coastal wetlands.

According to the emergency declaration, Roseau cane scale poses a threat to the health and welfare of Louisiana's wetlands, and possibly sorghum, sugarcane and rice industries.

"Following an extensive survey conducted by the LSU AgCenter, it has been determined that efforts should be made to limit the spread of Roseau cane scale. Therefore, a quarantine is now in effect," said Strain.

Quarantine areas in the state include all areas south of Louisiana Highway 10 beginning at the Mississippi state line moving west until intersecting at Highway 171 in Vernon Parish. Also, moving south on Highway 171 to Highway 190 in DeRidder and turning west onto Highway 190 and continuing on Highway 190 until it reaches the Sabine River.

Quarantine areas in the state include portions of the following parishes south of Louisiana Highway 10: Allen, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, St. Helena, Tangipahoa, Vernon, Washington and West Feliciana.

These entire parishes are quarantined: Acadia, Ascension, Assumption, Beauregard, Calcasieu,

Cameron, East Baton Rouge, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Lafourche, Livingston, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. James, St. John, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Terrebonne, Vermillion and West Baton Rouge.

Clean nursery stock may be moved within quarantined areas under a special permit issued by the LDAF. Limited movement of Roseau cane by boat is allowed by waterfowl hunters as long as the Roseau cane material is moved no more than one-quarter mile from its original location and remains within the quarantine area.

The quarantine went into effect March 26, 2018. It will be in effect until further notice.

On another front to combat the pest, LSU AgCenter has secured additional funding to continue the fight against the Roseau cane scale. The omnibus spending bill, signed recently by President Trump, included funding for Roseau cane scale research.

An additional \$500,000 was allocated through the USDA's APHIS and will allow LSU AgCenter researchers to expedite and expand the scope of currently funded research initiatives to control pests in Roseau cane in wetlands. LSU AgCenter administrators are meeting with USDA officials to discuss the initiatives and the next steps in the collaboration.

Strain: Respond to 2017 Census of Agriculture

The deadline to respond to the 2017 Census of Agriculture by mail has been extended to the end of April. Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging Louisiana farmers and ranchers to share information with the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS). “It is very important that our farmers and ranchers fill out this questionnaire. The information collected is used when developing the Farm Bill and other farm policy, and when making decisions about disaster relief, community planning, technology development, and more,” said Strain. “Census

data will help accurately represent Louisiana’s diverse agriculture – from large and small crawfish farmers, fruit and vegetable growers, cattle producers, organic and urban farmers to row crop farmers. Without this information, Louisiana could possibly lose out on federal monies,” added Strain. The Census of Agriculture is the only USDA NASS questionnaire mailed to every producer across the country and is conducted just once every five years. The census provides a complete account of the industry, its changes, and emerging trends. Producers should respond online at www.agcounts.usda.gov or by mail. The online questionnaire offers new

timesaving features. The NASS mailed nearly 57,000 census forms in Louisiana to identify potential producers in the state and to collect the information about their operations that is necessary to help shape the future of American agriculture. “The data from the census can be used to let lawmakers know what is going on in our industry – from how much is planted and harvested, livestock produced, increases in truck crops and farmers markets and to see how the face of agriculture is changing. This information can be used to see just how big or small revenues actually are so they can help determine where to direct necessary programs and federal

money,” said Kathy Broussard, Louisiana statistician. Everyone who received the 2017 Census of Agriculture questionnaire is to return it, even if they are not currently farming. The first few qualifying questions on the form will determine whether completing the entire questionnaire is necessary. The census is the only source of uniform, comprehensive, and impartial agriculture data for every state and county in the nation. Producers are required by law to respond; NASS is required by the same federal law to keep all information confidential, use the data only for statistical purposes, and only publish in aggregate form to prevent disclosing the identity

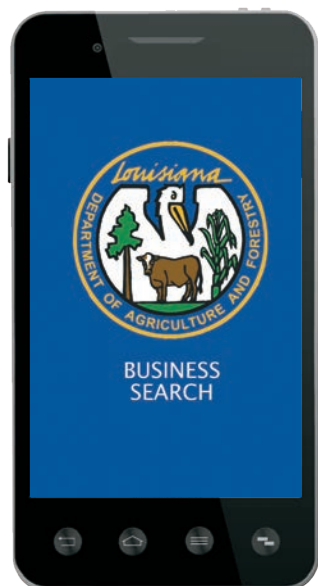

Louisiana rice planting on schedule thanks to recent dry weather

CROWLEY, La. — Recent stretches of dry weather have allowed Louisiana rice farmers to get in the field and plant their 2018 crop on schedule.

“In the last two weeks, we’ve made tremendous progress,” said Don Groth, resident coordinator of the LSU AgCenter H. Rouse Caffey Rice Research Station in Crowley. “All in all, it’s starting out to be a good year.”

Dustin Harrell, AgCenter rice specialist, said south Louisiana farmers are more than 80 percent finished with planting. He estimated this year’s rice planted acreage will total approximately 415,000, compared to about 400,000 last year.

Wet field conditions forced many farmers to plant by water seeding instead of drilling, according to AgCenter parish agents. Those who planted early had to dodge rains.

“There was a lot of rice planted in a short period of time,” said Todd Fontenot, AgCenter agent in Evangeline Parish. He added that about 85 percent of farmers in his parish have completed planting.

Frances Guidry, AgCenter agent in Jefferson Davis Parish, said a majority of the acreage there is planted. And Jeremy Hebert, AgCenter agent in Acadia Parish, said planting is close to 90 percent complete in his parish.



“It started out cooler and wetter than last year,” Hebert said.

He said some farmers have had to replant after blackbirds ate seed.

Most farmers have finished planting in Vermilion Parish, said Andrew Granger, the parish AgCenter agent. “I’m going to call it at 90 percent this week.”

Granger said fields yet to be planted are probably still being used for crawfish. The

same is true in St. Landry Parish, where only about half the rice acreage has been planted, according to parish AgCenter agent Vince Deshotel.

In north Louisiana, rice farmers are just getting started. Fields have been too wet for planting.

“We probably have less than 10 percent planted,” said Keith Collins, AgCenter agent in Richland Parish. “Once we get dry, there’s

going to be a lot of rice put in the ground.”

Rice already planted has been subjected to lower temperatures, causing some damage, he said.

Collins anticipates a slight increase in north Louisiana rice acreage, possibly 10 percent, with most of the increase being planted in row rice.

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
