

NASA Michoud Assembly Awarded "Certified Louisiana" Logo

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has deemed the NASA Michoud Assembly Facility eligible to be included in the "Certified Louisiana" logo program.

To be "Certified Louisiana," a product must be made, grown, manufactured, processed, produced or substantially transformed in the state of Louisiana. The "Certified Louisiana" program is facilitated

through the LDAF.

"The Michoud Assembly Facility is a major economic driver for the New Orleans area. We appreciate the facility's commitment to conducting business in Louisiana for many decades," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

State awards farm recovery grants to more than 900 farmers, ranchers

More than 900 farmers and ranchers in 51 parishes are set to receive disaster recovery grants to help compensate for their losses from the disastrous flooding that occurred across Louisiana in March and August of 2016.

The average grant award is \$9,905.65.

The applicant breakdown is as follows:

Total applicants: 1,065

Total eligible applicants: 961

Maximum grant awarded: \$12,185.40

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) mailed award letters to each recipient on April 26. The letters listed the closing dates, times and locations for finalizing the grants.

"This is not a loan," LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said. "The goal of this grant program is to help our farmers and ranchers sustain their businesses following a year of devastating flooding."

The Restore Louisiana Task Force allocated \$10 million for farm recovery to LDAF as part of \$1.7 billion in Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery money received by the Louisiana

Office of Community Development from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for recovery from The Great Floods of 2016.

To be eligible for the program, producers must have demonstrated a pre-storm, annual gross farm revenue of \$25,000 in 2014, 2015 or 2016. In addition, crop losses must have amounted to a minimum of \$10,000, as calculated by the crop-loss calculator.

The eligible crops included cotton, corn, crawfish, grain sorghum, rice, hay, soybeans, sweet potatoes, sugarcane, strawberries, wheat and cattle.

Lafayette Parish woman arrested for livestock theft

Baton Rouge, La. (April 26, 2018) – The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission arrested 27-year-old Sarah M. Broussard for stealing a horse valued at approximately \$1,000.

Investigators say Broussard, who used a false name to identify herself, advertised a horse for sale over the internet.

However, the horse's real owner was unaware and never gave Broussard permission to sell the horse. At the time, the horse was being housed in Lafayette Parish where the horse's owner did not reside. Therefore, when the horse was transferred to the person who bought it, the owner was unaware that the horse was missing until the owner came across the advertisement on the

internet.

"Buyers of livestock over the internet should be cautious, particularly when dealing with cash transactions. We also recommend being familiar with whom you are conducting business and demand paperwork regarding the origin of the animal," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Broussard, of Scott, La., was booked into the Lafayette Parish Jail on April 25, 2018 for Theft L.A.R.S. 14:67 B 4 Property valued over \$500.00 but less than \$1,000.00.

If convicted, the suspect faces a fine and/or jail time.

The Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office and the Scott Police Department assisted in this investigation.

You can never over prepare for emergencies

There is no such thing as ever being too prepared for an emergency situation. That is why state responders gathered recently to practice water rescues involving pets.

“Animals are a part of our lives. They mean a lot to us,” said Dick Green, Senior Director of disaster response for the ASPCA.

For Ben Zachary with the Louisiana Task Force Urban Search and Rescue Team, he helped rescue several families and

their pets during the August 2016 flood.

“This training helps us learn and practice how to calm down an animal during a stressful situation such as being in a confined area on a boat,” said Zachary.

The exercise called “Slack Water Training” focuses on taking animals out of slow rising flood water as opposed to swiftly moving water. “That is the thing we mostly deal with here in Louisiana,” said Renee Poirrier, DVM and

Director of the Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART).

“One of the big things about a flood is that you have to be concerned about what is in the water that could cause health issues for all involved. We want to focus on safety for humans and pets,” added Poirrier.

Officials say it is all about being proactive. “We know we’re going to have floods so we want to get local communities ready. We also prepare for when we are called to

assist other states,” said Poirrier.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) also participates in the training and works with its non-governmental partners. By law, the LDAF is required to assist with sheltering domestic pets that arrive at shelters with evacuees.

“Training is critical because it identifies any gaps we may need to fill before we have a real emergency,” added LDAF’s Robbie Averett. And for groups

that are already used to dealing with animals, it also gives them the opportunity to get experience with equipment such as boats.

Local fire departments, the U.S. Coast guard, local parish emergency officials, statewide animal control agencies, LSART Veterinary Medical Reserve Corps Volunteers and search and rescue task forces participated at the Cabella’s pond in Gonzales. Thirty-three individuals took part in the exercise that day.

Caladiums are a colorful choice for shady beds

(05/04/18) If you asked me what some of my favorite plants for summer color are, caladiums would absolutely be on the list. You won’t find a better plant for reliable color in areas that get some shade. And one investment can provide years of color.

Easy enough for the casual gardener to expect routine success, the caladium’s elegant beauty also makes it a staple in the most accomplished gardener’s landscape. Native to tropical South America, caladiums grow from tubers and thrive in the heat and humidity of our long summers. They are remarkably free of major insect or disease problems.

Caladiums (*Caladium x hortulanum*) are grown for their attractive foliage. The 6-to-12-inch heart-shaped leaves emerge from the ground on arching stems that are generally 1 to 2 feet tall but can grow taller. The foliage may be splashed with combinations of white, pink, rose, red, burgundy, chartreuse or green, often with several colors combining in wonderful patterns. These bright leaves with their bold texture embellish our shady gardens from May until October when the tubers go dormant.

Where to plant

Caladiums grow best in shade to part shade (two to four hours of direct sun, preferably morning) or bright dappled light. In these conditions, they produce the lushest growth with large, colorful leaves. The caladium plants you purchase at nurseries are usually grown in shady greenhouses, and the foliage will often scorch or burn if you plant them into beds that receive too much direct sun. This often results in brown areas and holes literally burned into the leaves. If the light conditions are appropriate, the new leaves that emerge will be adapted to the increased light and not burn.

Some cultivars are more tolerant of sunny conditions and are successful in beds receiving part to full sun (six hours or more of direct sun) as long as they receive adequate irrigation. When grown in full sun, caladiums tend to produce smaller and more brightly colored foliage, and the plants will be shorter.

The following caladium cultivars are recommended for full sun based on research done at the LSU AgCenter Hammond Research Station: Fire Chief (fancy-leaf red), Hearts Delight (lance-leaf red), Carolyn Whorton (fancy-leaf pink), Cherry Tart (lance-leaf red), Moonlight (fancy-leaf white), Florida Sweetheart (lance-leaf pink), White Cap (fancy-leaf white and green), White Ruffles (lance-leaf white), Celebration (fancy-leaf multi-color) and White Dynasty (lance-leaf white). Fancy-leaf caladiums have larger, heart-shaped leaves. Lance-leaf caladiums have smaller, narrower spearhead-shaped leaves. These cultivars also do well in the shade.

Planting caladiums

You can purchase caladiums two different ways. Buying caladium tubers is the most economical way to add caladiums to your landscape. You can buy caladium tubers and plant them directly into well-prepared beds now. Plant the tubers about 2 inches deep and 8 to 12 inches apart.

You should see growing points or even pinkish-white sprouts on the knobby side of the tuber. That side is planted up. The smoother side is the bottom of the tuber. Wait until unspouted tubers have emerged and grown several inches tall before mulching them.

Caladiums are also available growing in 4- to 6-inch pots, and they will provide immediate color in the landscape. Growing caladium bulbs should be planted with the top of the root ball level with the soil of the bed. Plant them 8 to 12 inches apart into well-prepared beds, and they will grow larger and more beautiful through the summer. Once growing caladiums are planted, mulch the bed with 2 inches of your favorite mulch and water them in. Keep beds of caladiums well-watered during the summer, especially those receiving lots of sun.

Winter care

In late September or early October, longer nights and cooler temperatures encourage caladiums to go dormant. But the tubers you plant this summer can be used to grow caladiums next year, either left in the ground or stored and replanted. If the beds where the caladiums are planted will stay relatively undisturbed and if drainage is good and they will not stay too wet during winter, you may simply leave the caladium tubers in the ground.

Or you may choose to dig and store them. This is the most reliable way of making sure they grow another year. Dig caladiums when a number of leaves turn yellow and most of the foliage begins to look “tired” and falls over. Use a shovel or a garden fork to lift the tubers, being careful not to damage them. Leaving the foliage attached, shake and brush off most of the soil from the tubers and lay them out in a single layer in a dry location sheltered from rain (in a garage, under a carport). After the foliage becomes tan and papery in appearance, pull it from the tubers and store the tubers in paper bags indoors where temperatures stay around 70 degrees through winter.

With poor growing conditions, particularly in areas of heavy shade or sunny, dry locations, the plants will likely produce small, weak tubers that may not return well either left in the ground or dug and stored. Under the right circumstances and with proper care, however, the tubers you plant this year can provide a beautiful display again next year and for years to come.
