LDAF seed certification provides disease free, true-to-variety seed for sugarcane growers

Matt Frey has been farming sugarcane for 19 years in Pointe Coupee Parish. "Any kind of disease such as smut or rust can put us out of business," said Frey. That is why he starts his

3400 acres of sugarcane with seed cane monitored for disease by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Seed Programs which administers the Louisiana Seed Certification

Program.

"Prior to the establishment of the Seed Certification Program in 1986, sugarcane was experiencing economic losses because of diseases. This program provides a clean, disease free, true-to-variety seed for commercial sugarcane growers," said Lester Cannon, Seed Programs Director with the LDAF.

The established Tissue-Culture Sugarcane Certification Standards are based on a broad spectrum of input from growers and agricultural professionals, and the requirements and tolerances within the standards are based on current scientific data.

Sugarcane certification is a rigorous process based "parent to progeny" approach. Program components include verification of planting stock, field inspections, sampling, laboratory analysis, auditing, approval of certified plant breeders and official labeling. Failure to meet any one of these requirements may result in field ineligibility.

For those "clean seed" companies that apply to have their fields inspected through the certification program, the fields are inspected three or more times a year, usually starting in April. Upon

initial inspection, the general appearance of the crop is taken into consideration and inspectors look specifically for mosaic disease in the susceptible varieties which would be evident at this time. In the early 1900's, mosaic disease nearly wiped out the industry.

"You always want new varieties and that's what is so important with this industry," said Frey. "With sugarcane we're limited and need more varieties just in case something comes up. You don't know when those diseases are going to come up. We need the industry to be stronger."

In June, LDAF inspectors conduct the second inspection. "This is where we take samples and run a test for Sugarcane Yellow Leaf Virus. If everything is okay, we will come back right before harvest in July and give our stamp of approval," said Cannon. "If we come out today and find some problems, the company has the option to clean it up, remove those plants from the field and then we will come back and re-inspect the field."

Cannon said he has concerns that the younger generation of sugarcane farmer is not as concerned about

the risk of disease because of the vigilance of the older generations. "Sugarcane is a major crop for Louisiana and we don't want to get into a situation as we did years ago where the crop is at risk. We need the new crop of sugarcane farmers to know this certification program is available to them," added Cannon. "There is so much science and research that goes into this plant before it is released. It takes years and sometimes decades for a variety to be released. Thousands and thousands are crosses are made until they get down to one or two to create a commercial variety," he said.

Sugarcane is a multi-year crop. When a farmer plants his crop, he or she wants a variety that will still be there three, four or five years from now.

"If we go through the cost of planting and can't keep these varieties until the end when we harvest, it can set us back for a long time. That is why this research is important. We want to know that when we plant, we have a chance to harvest this crop in four or five years," said Frey.

Frey also farms cattle, cotton, crawfish, rice and soybeans.

Cattle rustling ring busted

Three people are accused of stealing livestock valued at more than \$1 million dollars from four Louisiana livestock markets.

In Allen Parish, 68-year old Ricky Thompson and 69-year old Wanda Thompson of Pitkin, La., are charged with six counts of theft of property having a value of \$25,000 or more.

Ricky and Wanda Thompson turned themselves in to the Allen Parish Jail on June 1 following a

grand jury indictment.

Thirty-nine-year old Justin Thompson of Hinston, La., who is the son of Ricky and Wanda Thompson, was arrested on June 4.

Investigators with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Brand Commission said the thefts occurred between August – October 2017. This initial indictment involves a livestock market in Allen Parish.

Louisiana has eight public livestock markets where producers can sell their livestock. Investigators say four of the eight livestock markets were targeted by the Thompsons.

“The bottom line is — the cattle producers were protected and received their money from the sale barn. However, the Thompsons never compensated the sale barn so these businesses suffered significant financial losses,” said Commissioner Mike Strain,

If convicted, the Thompsons face extensive jail time. Bond was set at \$60,000 for both Rick and Wanda and bonded out of Allen Parish Jail the same day of their arrest. Investigators said they will be taken to Avoyelles Parish where they face the same charges.

Additional warrants have been issued in East Baton Rouge and St. Landry parishes where the other livestock markets are located.

Water appropriately during dry weather

Dry weather has been common around the state during May, and most of us have received less than the typical amount of rain the past few weeks. Who knows how much rain will fall this summer? We can be fairly certain, however, that there will be at least some periods of hot, dry weather when we will need to water our landscapes.

How often we need to water our landscapes varies, depending on such factors as temperature, rainfall, humidity, season, plant material and light intensity. Plants need to be irrigated more frequently when temperatures are high, the plants are growing in full sun and they have a lot of root competition for the soil water — when a tree is nearby, for instance, or in a thickly planted bed. Proper watering is a function of applying the right amount of water at the appropriate times.

Many gardeners tend to water lightly and frequently — even daily — during dry weather, but then the water does not penetrate deeply into the soil. Because roots only grow where they have adequate moisture, this results in a shallow root system. Shallow-rooted plants are unable to tap reserves of water

deeper in the soil and are prone to drought stress in even brief dry periods. Your plants then become dependent on you to water them constantly. Watering every day also increases the chances of foliar diseases and root or crown rots.

As relaxing as hand watering is to the gardener, it is typically not an effective way to irrigate plants growing in the ground. When we water by hand, we tend to apply water rapidly for a short period and move on. Applied this way, water does not adequately penetrate the soil. To irrigate properly, water needs to be applied slowly over a sufficient period of time to allow the water to soak deep into the soil.

Enough water should be applied about 6 inches into the soil for thorough irrigation. Applying about an inch of water to medium-textured soils will generally accomplish this. For established landscape plants, a thorough watering should not be necessary more than once week during dry conditions. The best way to determine how often you need to water again is to check the soil in landscape beds every few days, and water when the soil becomes dry.

Early morning is the preferred

time to irrigate. This provides plants adequate moisture going into the hottest time of the day when they need it most, and sunlight helps the foliage dry rapidly, reducing the possibility of foliar disease problems. (Wetting the foliage of plants while the sun is shining on them will not burn the leaves.) If sprinklers are used, watering in the early morning when it is cooler and humidity is high reduces irrigation water lost to evaporation.

You can use a variety of methods to irrigate your landscape. You may even use different methods in different areas.

Soaker hoses are made of a material that oozes water slowly. They apply water very efficiently, do not wet foliage — reducing potential disease problems — and can be left in place or moved easily. Soaker hoses must be laid fairly close to the plants to be effective, so snake them throughout a bed around the plants. It may be helpful to pin the soaker hose in place with U-shaped pieces of wire to make it stay where you want it. Finally, cover the soaker hoses with mulch so they are not noticeable. Soaker hoses are ideal for irrigating flower beds, vegetable gardens and shrub

plantings.

The most common and popular method of landscape irrigation is using sprinklers, which are also the only practical way to water lawns and large trees. Installed underground systems and hose-end sprinklers are the two basic types.

Underground systems are effective and very convenient, but they can be expensive to purchase and generally must be installed professionally. Professional landscape irrigation system installers must be licensed by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Ask to see a copy of the license to make sure the company or individual who installs your system is reputable and knowledgeable.

Most home gardeners use hose-end sprinklers. They are less expensive and do not require professional installation. But they are inconvenient to use because they must be moved to cover large areas and generally must be picked up after use.

To figure out how long to leave your sprinkler on to apply 1 inch of water, first, place several empty cans in the spray pattern of the sprinkler. Then, turn on

the sprinkler and check the time. When about an inch of water has accumulated in most of the cans, check the time again. That's how long it takes your sprinkler to apply 1 inch of water and about how long you should leave it on to thoroughly irrigate an area.

The best check of how thoroughly an area has been watered is to go back about 15 minutes after watering and dig into the soil with a trowel. Did the water penetrate 6 to 8 inches? Check several places. This procedure works to calibrate an installed irrigation system or hose-end sprinklers.

In some situations, such as on slopes and heavy clay soils, the water may need to be added even more slowly to reduce runoff. It takes water longer to penetrate heavy clay soils than light, sandy soils. Run the sprinkler alternately on for 10 to 15 minutes and off for 15 to 20 minutes, until an inch of water is applied.

Finally, don't forget to keep your landscape beds and vegetable gardens well mulched. A layer of mulch covering the soil surface cuts down on evaporation, conserves soil moisture and reduces the frequency of watering.
