New Heights

The Folsom, La. facility is the only fully accessible riding center in Louisiana that provides equine-assisted activities and therapies to adults and children with cognitive, physical, and emotional challenges.

Twenty-five year old Walker Haase has a job to do. He's collecting a horse from the pasture where he was grazing and bringing him to his stall. His mother, Mary Ann, says working with horses

gives Walker, who is developmentally disabled, an opportunity to feel like he is accomplishing something.

"Every Wednesday night he writes the name of every horse he will take care of the next day," said Mary Ann. "These moments in his life make him whole. Every parent wants their kids to be happy and to have good experiences."

New Heights Therapeutic Riding Center in Folsom, La. is Walker's happy place. Walker has sensory and attention issues caused by Fragile X Syndrome. Walker does both recreational and therapeutic riding at New Heights. "It's helped with his anxiety. His attention issues are huge, but here he is focused and motivated. That carries over into other areas of his life where he has developed a real work ethic," added Mary Ann.

New Heights is a non-profit organization recognized as a Premier Center by the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International (PATH). It is the only

fully accessible riding center in Louisiana which provides equine-assisted activities and therapies. New Heights serves adults and children with cognitive, physical, and emotional challenges.

An "incredible gift to the community" is what Walker's mom calls New Heights, and she's not the only one who feels that way.

Katherine Racine's five year old daughter Ruthie has Cerebral Palsy. For the past year, she has received Hippotherapy which helps her with balance and muscle toning. "Before, she could not stand on her feet very long, but now she can stand longer and sit up straighter," said Katherine. "Of all the therapy she's had in the past five years, this is the place where she's shown the most improvement. I can't put a price on that."

New Heights started in 1998 when a physical therapist who owned horses used them to treat her patients. "Being a non-profit, we used to move from location to location until two very generous benefactors donated the eight acres in Folsom where we are located today," said Kim Clinard who serves as operations manager.

New Heights operates primarily on donations and currently serves about 60 riders. It has a few full-time employees which include an occupational therapist, a PATH certified instructor and barn/herd coordina-

tor plus other part-time staff. The facility also relies heavily on volunteers who provide support to the riders.

"Right now we have nine amazing horses on loan to us from generous owners. These horses come from all kinds of backgrounds. They're older horses. One is a former show horse, an ex-barrel racer, a thoroughbred race horse and a very large hunter jumper who is just a love bug," said Kim. "He loves to give hugs and receive them!"

"We see the beauty of what this facility does for those involved and what the benefits are," said Ashley Richerand.

One sweet horse on loan is from local business owners Frank Richerand and his daughter, Ashley. Frank is also a New Heights board member.

For Ashley, New Heights has a special place in her heart. "I have a 15-year-old daughter who is disabled so helping those with special needs is a priority. She even volunteers there," said Ashley.

The Richerand's also have a love of horses as clearly expressed in their coffee shop, Giddy Up, which is equestrian themed. "I thought the name was fitting. You get a giddy up when you drink coffee and you're also in horse country here in Folsom," she

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

LDAF accepting organic cost-share applications

Baton Rouge, La. (Aug. 13, 2018) - Louisiana agricultural producers and handlers who obtained USDA Organic certification or recertification may qualify for reimbursement of their costs through a cost-share rebate program, Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

USDA Organic certification and recertification expenses incurred between Oct. 1, 2017 and Sept. 30, 2018. The program will provide reimbursements of up to 75 percent of certification and recertification costs, or up to \$750 per year per certification category.

“Earning the USDA Organic certification can be a costly and lengthy process,” Strain said.

“This cost-share program is one way producers can offset these expenses.”

Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) Oct. 1, 2018.

The program is funded through USDA’s Farm Service Agency (FSA).

The 2018 cost-share applications are available at www.LDAF.la.gov. Reimbursements

will be on a first-come, first-served basis, based on receipt of the completed application packet, until available funding is exhausted.

Louisiana Lagniappe Cookery

Editor's note: We dug into the Louisiana Market Bulletin archives and came across these little gems. These recipes were printed in various editions during 1973. Back then, the bulletin was printed on a weekly basis and free to subscribe.

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

LA. CHICKEN SAUCE PIQUANT Courtesy of J. M. Coco

2 chickens, approx. 3 lbs. each
3 cupfuls La. cooking oil or shortening
3 lbs. onions
4 cloves garlic finely chopped
1 cup green shallots
3 sm. cans tomato sauce
1 cup finely chopped celery
1 cup finely chopped Bell Pepper
Salt, red pepper and black pepper (to taste)

Measure cooking oil or shortening and pour into a large cast-iron pot. Cut chickens into serving-size pieces and season with salt, red pepper and black pepper and brown in cooking oil or shortening. Remove chicken from pot and place in a pan.

Brown onions and garlic in oil or shortening, then add chickens. Pour tomato sauce over the chickens and add finely chopped celery and green shallots. Add enough water to cover all of these ingredients and lower the flame. Stir about every 10 minutes. You may add approximately 1 cup of flour to thicken the gravy as desired. Add bell pepper about 1 hour before the chicken becomes tender.

Cook until chicken becomes tender. If you find that there is too much oil or shortening, skim up before serving. This will serve approximately 12 people. Serve with Louisiana rice.

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

RICE & OYSTER DRESSING Courtesy of Mrs. Elbert Buckner Athens, La.

Chicken broth
2½ c. rice
½ c. cooking oil or 2 sticks butter
1½ lb. ground meat
1½ c. chopped celery
1 c. chopped onion
2 bell peppers, chopped
½ bottle Worcestershire sauce
Salt and pepper
2 pt. oysters and juice

Cook rice in chicken broth until tender but moist. Melt butter in separate container; add ground meat. Cook until almost done; add celery, onions, peppers, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper. Cook until done. Add oysters and juice; cook until edges curl. Add oyster mixture to cooked rice; simmer 10 minutes. Serve immediately or allow to set 30-40 minutes.

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

LOUISIANA STYLE BARBECUED PORK CHOPS

2½ c water
1 T sugar
2½ t black pepper
2 T butter
¼ c vinegar
2½ t salt
¼ c onion (chopped)
2 T Worcestershire sauce
1 t powdered mustard
2 t chili powder
½ t Tabasco sauce
½ t red pepper
1 bud garlic

Combine all ingredients in a one quart sauce pan and bring to a rolling boil. Allow sauce to stand overnight to blend flavors. For best results, warm the sauce slightly before use. Any leftover sauce may be stored in the refrigerator and reused.

Select large meaty chops sliced at least 1 inch thick. One large loin (17 - 18 lbs.) will yield 20 to 25 chops with 12 center-cut chops.

Place chops on grill over medium to low heat and cook for 30 to 45 minutes, turning every 5 minutes at first and more often as they cook. Apply barbecue sauce with a dish mop or small paint brush everytime you turn the chops. Since the sauce does not have a tomato base, it will not burn. Your only concern is not to burn the chops.

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

OLD TIME SWEET POTATO PIE Courtesy of Mrs. Elaine C. Wilson

2 c. mashed sweet potatoes
½-¾ c. sugar
3 beaten eggs
⅛ tsp. nutmeg
¼ tsp. cinnamon
½ tsp. salt
1 c. milk
3 tbsp. melted butter

Boil potatoes and mash. Add sugar, beaten eggs, spices & salt. Stir until well blended, add milk & butter. Pour into unbaked pie crust and bake in medium oven 40 minutes. This will make one 9 inch pie.
