There is something to be said about 100 plus years of family farming. The words you hear include perseverance, hard work, dedication, and family unit to name a few. Six Louisiana families are the recipients of the Louisiana Century Farm Award. This award, administered by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) and the LSU AgCenter, is given to families who have owned and consistently farmed on Louisiana land for at least 100 years.

“What does the family farm mean? It’s about our families, traditions, our pasts and our future,” said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

“This is one of the most unique awards because it truly proves the resiliency of family farms,” said Ronnie Anderson, president of the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation (LFBF). The award ceremony was held at the 96th annual LFBF convention held in New Orleans on June 22, 2018.

“It’s kind of amazing,” said Ronald Gonsoulin, who represented A&F Farms. “So many people have left the farms and this is a tribute to those who have persevered through commodity prices, drought, floods and storms.”

“The farm is where our family unit began,” said John Washington of Cornist Family Farms. “When everyone comes home, they come back to the farm. It’s our core.”

Crops and livestock grown include: Beef cattle, corn, cotton, peanuts, soybeans, sugarcane, sweet potatoes and wheat.

“Everything started with the family farm,” said Dr. Rogers Leonard with the LSU AgCenter. “It’s an amazing accomplishment to have a family farm for 100 plus years.”

Stephen Austin with Louisiana Land Bank added that this is a true celebration of land ownership, “As we move forward and continue to tell stories and show the passion of farm ownership, hopefully your children will celebrate another 100 years of owning farm land.”

New Crop Pest Identified in Louisiana

Baton Rouge, La. (July 13, 2018) – A new pest that attacks certain crops grown in Louisiana has been identified.

The root-knot nematode, *Meloidogyne enterolobii* (*M. enterolobii*), is a serious pest which has a high rate of reproduction and a wide host range that includes soybean, sugarcane and sweet potato. It has also been known to attack

varieties of tomato, soybean and sweet potato that are considered resistant to the Southern root-knot nematode species which is common in Louisiana.

M. enterolobii, also called the guava root-knot nematode, was first identified in the U.S. in Florida on ornamental nursery stock in 2001. In 2011, it was identified in North Carolina. It was recently confirmed in

Morehouse Parish.

The LSU AgCenter will begin a statewide nematode survey to determine if *M. enterolobii* is in other areas of the state. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is currently working with the producer to reduce the spread of the nematode and monitor the situation.

“The nematode species is often

transported by equipment,” said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “Cleaning soil off of equipment, including tires and footwear before going to another field is one of the best ways to reduce the spread of this nematode.”
