Juniors learn what it takes **TO BE** **BEST IN SHOW**



About a dozen youngsters who participated in the class that preceded the annual Lagniappe Classic Dog Show in early August.

Nine year old Dyna Vestal is very comfortable around dogs. Her family owns a dog boarding business in Tickfaw, La. where she helps care for the pets. Her family is also active in dog shows where she now shows her beloved beagle.

"I want to show golden retrievers one day at Westminster," said Dyna.

On this day, Dyna and her younger sister, Averie, are attending the first annual "Junior Summer Clinic" at the Lagniappe Classic Dog Show in Kenner, La. It is a class for preteens up to 18 years old who want to learn how to compete in dog shows.

Averie, who is also interested in being a dog groomer, said, "You have to take very good care of your pets. They are part of the family."

Dyna and Averie were two of about a dozen youngsters who participated in the class that preceded the annual

Lagniappe Classic Dog Show in early August. The participants learned canine first aid and dog show etiquette.

On hand was Deb Mauterer, D.V.M., who grew up in 4-H showing horses. Currently, she co-owns the number one English cocker spaniel in the country. "As a vet, my patients cannot tell me what is wrong with them so I have to be an investigator," said Mauterer. "When you're on the road with your pet, they can get stressed out and sick." Mauterer added she hopes to inspire future veterinarians.

For Lorraine Bisso, President of the Louisiana Kennel Club, she says it is important to "build bridges" and start introducing role models in the sport to mentor the kids. "Dog show etiquette is extremely important. First, you need to respect yourself, the other competitors, the judges and of course, your dog," said Bisso. "You want to win fairly and

lose gracefully."

Professional dog handler, David Harper out of Texas, was on hand to assist in showing the juniors how to show their dogs in the ring. "I went to my first dog show at nine years old. You learn a lot of responsibility whether it is taking care of the dogs, feeding them and overall keeping them healthy."

As for Dyna and her sister, Averie, they're learning at a young age that caring for any pet takes work and attention. It is something both of these young ladies are embracing as they, too, learn how to be "Best in Show."

Certified Louisiana Logo Program adds new online portal

Baton Rouge, LA (August 9, 2018) – The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has launched an online portal to help Louisiana businesses apply to the Certified Louisiana logo program online.

“This is one more way we are making it easier for people to apply for and renew their Certified Louisiana, Certified Cajun, Certified Creole, and Certified Farm to Table logos for their products,” said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain,

D.V.M.

While paper applications are still available, this online resource makes it easier and faster for the department to determine whether an agricultural product or agritourism activity is eligible to be labeled with a certified logo. The new, user-friendly online portal can be accessed from a desktop, tablet or smartphone.

“We want to make it as easy as possible for farmers, processors, producers, and suppliers to promote their products to consumers as

authentic Louisiana products,” added Strain. “People want to know where their food comes from and they want to support locally owned businesses.”

Certified Louisiana logos were established to promote Louisiana made, grown, manufactured or processed products and aimed at enhancing and promoting Louisiana’s agricultural industry. The Certified Louisiana program was revamped earlier this year and strengthened its eligibility requirements. The LDAF

determines eligibility.

To become certified, a company must be in compliance with applicable state and federal permits, licenses and laws. There is a \$25 non-refundable application fee. If approved, there is a \$30 registration fee per logo. All logos must be renewed every three years.

Brown gravy ground beef spaghetti sauce.

1-1.5 pounds ground beef
1 can of mushrooms (reserve juice)
1 can of Rotel tomatoes
1 quart of Stew in a Few

Add ground beef to a pot, turn heat to medium high, then, brown the ground beef. (Stir often.) Remove pot from heat and drain juice and fat. New sweet potato variety on the way for Louisiana growers

A sweet potato line with excellent eye appeal and good disease resistance is poised to be released to growers soon, LSU AgCenter sweet potato breeder Don La Bonte said at a field day on Aug. 16.

About 100 producers and industry representatives attended the event at the AgCenter Sweet Potato Research Station, where they heard from experts on variety development, management practices and industry updates.

La Bonte said the new line, currently called LA 13-81, has traits that appeal to both consumers and producers. It has a showy, bright red skin that maintains its sheen through harvest and yields well in different soil types.

If released, LA 13-81 would join a stable of other AgCenter varieties — such as Orleans, Bayou Belle and Evangeline — that offer alternatives to the Beauregard variety, the longtime industry staple in Louisiana.

La Bonte also is continuing work to develop varieties that mature earlier and are more resistant to diseases and

insects.

“In the retail trade, having several different types of sweet potatoes on the shelf is important to increase marketing potential,” La Bonte said.

Most Louisiana sweet potatoes are sold for processing rather than the fresh market, said AgCenter extension associate Myrl Sistrunk.

Some farmers are having to look for new outlets for their crop after a sweet potato canning facility in Arkansas — the closest to Louisiana — shut down last year, he said.

Louisiana had about 9,300 acres of sweet potatoes in 2017, and Sistrunk expects that number to drop by 500 to 800 when acreage is tallied this year. Some growers have cut back on acreage or left the business altogether, he said.

Field day attendees also heard from AgCenter plant pathologist Chris Clark about two potential threats to their crop: the guava root-knot nematode and black rot.

While the aggressive nematode — which was found for the first time in Louisiana earlier this year — has

been in the news lately, black rot is perhaps a bigger concern in the short run, Clark said. The disease had not been a concern in Louisiana since the 1970s until it resurfaced recently.

“This is something that can blow up, and blow up in a short time,” Clark said of the disease.

Black rot can be managed with crop rotation, buying “clean” virus-tested seed and treating them with effective fungicides, and cutting plants 1 inch above the soil when collecting slips.

While the nematode is not as easily controlled, it so far has been contained in Louisiana to a single field in Morehouse Parish where it was identified. Growers who suspect they have it should send samples to the AgCenter nematology lab, Clark said.

Two international groups attended the field day to learn more about Louisiana sweet potato production practices.

Kaye McAllister, a researcher at the University of Guyana, said the white flesh sweet potato varieties are most common in her country. McAllister

is working with the Guyana National Agriculture Research and Extension Institute through a collaborative program with the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff to improve technology in sweet potato production and address disease and pest challenges.

Australian seed producers Eric and Kristie Coleman are licensed sweet potato seed distributors with the AgCenter and planned their visit primarily to attend the field day, speak with scientists and look at research results.

“Even though we are in a different

production environment, you always learn a lot from looking at production practices in another environment,” Eric Coleman said.

Rogers Leonard, AgCenter associate vice president, said the AgCenter sweet potato program is unique in that it involves every aspect of the crop, from variety development and seed production to harvest and economics. The AgCenter takes a similar approach with sugarcane and rice, which also are important Louisiana crops.

“Sweet potato remains a signature crop in Louisiana,” Leonard said.
