It's a Grape Stomping Good Time!

She is too young to know who famed actress and comedian Lucille Ball was, but that didn't stop four-year-old Mylee Hill from donning a Lucille Ball costume, and climbing

into a bucket of grapes.

At the sound of "go", Mylee stomped her little heart out!

It's all part of the grape-stomp competition during two Landry Vineyards Stomp Fest events held every summer to celebrate Blanc


Du Bois and Lenoir harvest. Blanc Du Bois and Lenoir are two of the wine grapes that are suitable for the growing conditions in North Louisiana. The Lucille Ball reference pertains to a scene in "I Love Lucy" where the actress stomps grapes to win a role in an Italian movie.

On this evening in September, the rolling hills of West Monroe are alive with activity at Landry Vineyards. Approximately 600 people – both young and old—are enjoying live music, dancing, food, vineyard wagon ride tours, delicious Louisiana produced wine and of course, grape stomping.

"I was told there was going to be a grape stomping contest and I just happen to have a Lucille Ball costume," said Cynthia Arender Machen from Talullah, La.

For Machen, the vineyard adds a different kind of experience for people in north Louisiana. "This is so awesome for a local business in my area to do this. I said how does a vineyard make it in North Louisiana? But it has been here awhile and people come out. I don't drink much wine, but I know people who do," added Machen.

You do not need to be a wine drinker to enjoy the event. There is something for everyone. The goal, however, is to promote Louisiana agriculture by allowing people to tour the property and learn about how wine is made.

Owner Jeff Landry says he uses agritourism to educate the consumer. "We're not playing around. We are passionately growing wine grapes and producing quality wines. We want them to understand the art and the science. We need the Louisiana consumer to understand that with the development of new European-American hybrid wine grapes, suitable for our growing conditions, we can produce quality wines from wine grapes grown here in Louisiana. That's what we try to give them on our tours."

Landry Vineyards is 50 acres, 17 acres of grape vines with new acreage planted annually. Their current production is 60 tons of grapes. "People ask us, did you have a big crop this year? We don't want a fluctuation in crop size. We need balanced production to produce quality wines. We do not want to ask the vine to

produce more than it is capable of. Generally, we produce four to five tons per acre which is largely regulated by pruning and good vineyard management. We want wine balance and quality," added Landry.

Landry, a former industrial engineer by profession, has always loved agriculture. His grandparents were cotton farmers and he spent a lot of time in the country growing up. His family also liked to grow their own vegetables.

"As I got older, I developed a love for wine. I started looking at small agriculture in Louisiana. I found that if you could take a raw product, add value to it, and stability, sell straight to the consumer, that model works. That small farmer has a precious product. It's a model that can work for small producers," added Landry. Now that we have grown, a large portion of our wines are distributed by Republic National in over 500 stores throughout Louisiana.

"This is a rebirth of this industry in Louisiana," said Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain. *See Stomp, cont. on page 20*

## West Baton Rouge Parish man accused in horse thefts

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission arrested 30-year-old Jonramon Hatfield Vaughns, of 9690 Hwy. 190, Port Allen, La. on September 11, 2018. Vaughns is accused of stealing 15 horses.

Investigators said Vaughns was arrested on two outstanding warrants involving theft of horses in Evangeline and St. Landry Parishes. The warrants stem from two separate complaints filed with the Livestock Brand Commission in both parishes.

The St. Landry Parish complaint was reportedly filed in March 2018. According to the complaint, Vaughns fraudulently obtained seven horses. Vaughns allegedly sold two of the horses at a local livestock market and transported the remaining five horses out of state.

On March 19, 2018, a warrant was obtained for Vaughns in St. Landry Parish for seven counts of theft in violation of L.A.R.S. 14:67 valued at \$4000.

The Evangeline Parish complaint filed in April said that Vaughns fraudulently obtained eight horses,

transported the horses out of state and sold them. A warrant was obtained for Vaughns in Evangeline Parish on May 3 for eight counts of theft in violation of L.A.R.S. 14:67 valued at \$10,000.

On the evening of September 11, brand inspectors received a tip that Vaughns was in Rayne, Louisiana. With the assistance of the Rayne Police Department, Vaughns was arrested and booked without incident on the outstanding warrants. Vaughns is currently in the St. Landry Parish Jail with a hold placed on him for the Evangeline

Parish warrant.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. said, "It is highly recommended that horse breeders and trainers use caution particularly when conducting business with people they do not know or with whom they have never done business transactions involving livestock." Strain added, "Also, request proper identification and registration papers for the horses and obtain financial verification by line of credit or funds available from the broker."

If convicted, Vaughns could face fines and jail time.
