## It's Officially Fall


*The time of year when folks are gearing up for cooler temperatures, fall leaves and pumpkin spice.*

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It's that time of year when folks are gearing up for cooler temperatures, fall leaves and pumpkin spice. Corn mazes and pumpkin patches also bring families out and build memories.

"I wanted somewhere people could come and learn about agriculture, our farm and to have a little fun," said Kacie Luckett of Luckett Farms located in St. Francisville, La.

Luckett was a physical therapy assistant until about 10 years ago when she and her husband decided to start farming.

"My husband, Derek, was working at a plant and went back to school to study horticulture. His family raised cattle, but I was not raised on a farm," added Luckett.

It was a bold move for people who were not rooted in rural Louisiana. But what Luckett and her husband were drawn to was the land. They live on two acres of land in Central, La. They also own 30 acres in Pride, La. where they grow fruits and vegetables and they lease 120 acres of land at Rosedown Plantation in St. Francisville where the corn maze and pumpkin patch are located. It's the first year they have done the corn maze and pumpkin patch.

"Kids get to see corn growing on the stalks. It's a lot different when they can see how it's grown, touch it and smell it. I also love the pumpkin aspect. Many kids don't know that pumpkins grow on a vine. They start out green and turn orange. There are also pretty flowers. Kids love it," she said.

Luckett said they plowed the land last February in preparation for the corn maze. They planted the corn

this past July and cut the corn maze in August. The design includes the words buy fresh, buy local and shapes of fruits, vegetables and a chicken. The design covers approximately 10 acres.

Technically, there are two corn mazes. The larger one takes approximately 45 minutes to walk through. The smaller one takes less time. The mazes include signs with agricultural facts. There is a hayride available and games in which the children can participate. Each child gets to bring home a pumpkin. They can even weigh their pumpkin and sit at a station to decorate it if they want.

Luckett Farms Corn Maze officially opened the last weekend of September and will operate through mid-November. Hours are from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. on the weekends.

Visits during the week are by appointment only and school field trips are welcome. The cost is \$12 per person. Luckett Farms is certified through the LSU AgCenter as an agri-tourism operation.

You can also meet the Luckett's at the Red Stick Farmers Market where they sell their fruits and vegetables. They are also affiliated with the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program where people sign up and get a box of fresh fruits and vegetables delivered to their homes or businesses each week.

There are several corn mazes and pumpkin patches throughout the state this time of year.

What started out as a hobby for Lisa and Charles Johnston soon grew into Louisiana Lagniappe Foods, a gourmet jelly, jams and preserves business based in the central Louisiana community of Lecompte.

Lisa said she and her husband started out making jellies and preserves for family and friends. “Our daughter (Sarah) is the one who encouraged us to up our game and spread our wings.”

In 2015, the Johnstons took the plunge and Louisiana Lagniappe Foods was born with just six jellies in their product line. Now, they offer over 35 gourmet jellies.

Though the company has grown, it remains family owned and operated. “Our daughter, Sarah, is involved and helps us out with the website.”

Even Lisa’s parents, Earlene and Robert Melder of Forest Hill, chip in to give the jars their signature look – hand-tied, colorful ribbon which secures a spoon to each jar.

Charles said sourcing locally-grown ingredients is important to them. “Our most popular jelly is our toasted pecan pepper jelly,” said Charles. “We get our peppers from Inglewood Farms in Alexandria, La. and the pecans come from both Riverside Pecan Company in Effie, La. and Natchitoches Pecans Plantation.”

1/4 cup rice wine vinegar  
1/4 cup Louisiana Lagniappe Foods Pepper Jelly  
1 tablespoon fresh lime juice  
1 tablespoon grated onion  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon pepper  
1/4 cup vegetable oil

Whisk together first 6 ingredients. Gradually add oil, whisking until blended.

## Vernon Parish 4-H’ers display woodsman skills

Leesville, La. - It’s a long-standing Vernon Parish tradition and pays homage to the biggest industry in the area — forestry. Approximately 150 4-H’ers competed in a woodman skills contest as part of the West Louisiana Forestry Festival.

According to the Louisiana Ag Summary, Louisiana has nearly 15 million acres in forest production. In 2017, the total value of forest production for the state was \$3.8 billion. Forest-related industries are a major economic driver in Vernon Parish.

“Forestry is a big industry, our largest in the parish,” said Chad Hagan, a Vernon Parish 4-H agent. “We just try to bring it back old style with the bowsaw, the cross cut and the cant hook for the log roll.”

Events in the contest included the log roll, bowsaw, match split, pulpwood toss and rope climb. There was also a leaf and insect identification component, but the highlight of the event was the

crosscut competition.

Coral Jean, a competitor with the Evans 4-H Club, is a fan of the crosscut event. “It’s the quickest. It’s fast-paced. It’s the heart and soul of woodman skills,” she said.

Leesville 4-H’er Greyson Grimes was competing in the crosscut competition, and he said you have to be physically ready to compete. “It is the most physically demanding,” Grimes said. “If you’re not fit in just about every way and have a good core, you cannot do it.”

Former competitors came back to judge the event and serve as volunteers to help coordinate the events. For some, this event ignited an interest in pursuing forestry as a career.

“4-H led me to the career path I’ve chosen, through the 4-H University forestry competition and obviously competing here and the state woodmen skills in Winnfield,” said Tristen Nicholas, a Louisiana Tech student majoring in forestry.

Jason Nolde works in the Kisatchie National Forest with the U.S. Forest Service and said 4-H also influenced his career choice.

“I actually work in the forestry industry,” Nolde said. “It [4-H] did that for me. It brought me closer and really set the stage for a career.”

While the focus of the event was on woodman skills and competition, there were also some life lessons mixed in.

“Life is not easy, and the bowsaw for the girls is a little hard,” Hagan said. “Some things in life aren’t easy, but you hope they learn from this. If you keep trying, you can reach your dreams.”

The top finishers from this event will advance to the state competition in Winnfield at the Louisiana Forestry Festival in April.
