Wildland Firefighter Training Field Day

Nearly 150 wildland firefighters with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) gathered in Woodworth, La. to attend the LDAF's Wildland Firefighter Field Day training last month.

This annual gathering is part of an ongoing wildland fire training initiative instituted by the LDAF

Office of Forestry to maintain its wildland firefighters' skill level and update everyone on the ever-changing management, technology and safety techniques associated with the detection and suppression of wildfires.

"It's important to routinely sharpen our skills which will not only enhance our effectiveness

but also the safety of everyone involved," said Assistant Fire Protection Branch Chief Bret Lane. "Many residents don't realize the number of wildfires experienced each year right here in Louisiana. A lot of folks think wildfires only happen out West."

Louisiana was recently ranked #11 in the U.S. for wildfire occurrence. In 2017, LDAF wildland firefighters responded to 729 fires that burned 7,071 acres. Additionally, more than 45 percent of U.S. wildfires occur in the Southern region.

"We have trained individuals who are ready to respond 24/7/365. We carve out this training time to review our processes, study lessons learned by other wildland firefighters, and to consistently promote a safe work environment."

This field day was all classroom instruction led by senior firefighters from across the state. There were four courses presented: Usage of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), Proper Radio Communications, Understanding Daily Fire Weather Reports and Field First Aid. The one commonality among the classes was an emphasis on safety.

The **Usage of PPE** class led by Forester Mark Davis of District 4 in Oberlin and Senior Firefighter Matt Cannon of District 3 in Jena began

with a video featuring a wildland fire crew that survived a wildfire burnover by trusting their training and PPE. The class concluded with a thorough inspection of the PPEs.

Proper Radio Communication remains the primary means of communication for fire crews and surveillance aircraft. Therefore, proper radio communications and usage is vital for the safety of personnel. Radio technicians Jacob Graves of District 6 of Clinton and Benji Rhame of District 4 in Woodworth led the course which focused on the technical operation of the radios currently in use by wildland fire crews. LDAF Fire Protection Branch Chief Don Smith explained, "Our radios are our first line of communication with one another on the ground. Where we go, cell phones simply don't work or meet the needs of the personnel."

Understanding Daily Fire Weather Reports and 10/18 Standard Fire Orders was instructed by Forester Jeff Anders of District 1 in Minden and Firefighter Wade Goings of District 3 in Jena. Understanding weather report forecasts allows for the identification of environmental conditions that are conducive for wildfire occurrence. This type of knowledge assists the agency with staffing levels and daily work

assignments. 10/18 Standard Fire Orders are utilized as reminder checklists for safe operations.

Field First Aid was instructed by Firefighter Anders Thompson, District 3 and Senior Firefighter Mike Smith. Due to the remote and hazardous environmental conditions encountered with fire, heavy equipment and other hazards, employees are instructed in basic, standard first aid and CPR. From the recognition of heat-related illnesses to the usage of bandages, employees are instructed how to identify, mitigate and stabilize a patient until advanced life support personnel assume command.

Consistent annual training is important to ward off complacency and ingrain proper work procedures and expectations, prior to an incident.

"When someone is faced with a difficult situation they will either rely on what they've learned in the past or try to make the best of the situation that is at hand," Lane said. "Wildland firefighting can be a dangerous and hectic occupation. With proper training and supervision, we can mitigate many of the hazards encountered and remain composed as we try to protect the citizens, structures and forested areas of the state from the destructive nature of wildfire."

Two Arrested for Horse Theft in St. Landry Parish

Baton Rouge, La. (Nov. 16, 2018)—Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said unrelated investigations by the LDAF Livestock Brand Commission resulted in the arrests of two individuals involving theft of horses.

Donna Greenwell, 61, of Pitkin, La., was arrested on Oct. 23 and Christopher Rocio, 39, of Palmetto, La. was arrested Nov. 8. Both Greenwell and Rocio were booked into the St. Landry Parish Jail. Both are charged with felony theft of livestock and if convicted could face fines and jail time. The arrests are the result of

separate, unrelated complaints for theft of livestock filed with local law enforcement authorities. Both subjects are accused of selling the stolen horses at a local livestock market. The Rapides Parish Sheriff's Department and the St. Landry Parish Sheriff's Department assisted in the investigations.

“Investigators were able to quickly determine that these animals were stolen because they were microchipped,” Strain said. “These cases should serve as a reminder to livestock owners to permanently identify their animals which can aid in the recovery of valuable livestock.”

Riceland Crawfish invests millions in expansion

Riceland Crawfish will make a \$3 million capital investment to expand its facility in Eunice. Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., joined company leadership recently including President and CEO Dexter Guillory, Operations Manager Doug Guillory and son, as well as local and regional leaders and economic developers, to break ground on the new expansion. With the new investment, the company will retain 50 jobs and create 10 new direct jobs in Acadiana.

Riceland Crawfish is a producer of Louisiana crawfish and alligator meat products. The company's investment consists of \$2 million for a new 33,000 square-foot facility and \$1 million for new equipment to process crawfish and alligator meat. About 96 percent of the company's sales are out-of-state, including markets as far away as the U.K. The company's wide distribution market ensures

that Louisiana agricultural products are reaching far beyond the state borders, and that the sales revenue from beyond Louisiana's borders makes its way to Louisiana businesses and their employees.

The expansion gives Riceland the ability to provide crawfish products to major food distributors and retailers year-round. Additionally, the Riceland Crawfish's expansion will help drive growth in local Louisiana communities by providing increased support to industries that provide bait, bags, boxes, sacks, seasoning, wire for traps and other products necessary for crawfish processing.

The crawfish industry in Louisiana represents a \$173 million gross farm value and includes 1,543 producers. Of that state total, the Acadiana Region is responsible for producing approximately 84 percent of that total or \$138 million. This represents the work of 1,232 producers, and numerous processors.



La. woman selected as national FFA officer

In October 2018, Layni LeBlanc was selected to serve as the 2018-19 National FFA Secretary. She is only the fifth national officer from Louisiana and the second from LSU since 1930.

LeBlanc is enrolled at Louisiana State University (LSU) pursuing a degree in Animal Sciences and a minor in Communication Studies. LeBlanc is also a member of the LSU Honor's College. Post graduation, LeBlanc intends to enter veterinary school.

LeBlanc is a longtime member of FFA, a national organization whose mission is to help members explore their interests in a broad range of agricultural pathways. Each fall, the FFA organization hosts a national conference where six student members are elected to represent FFA as a national officer. The process to become a national officer involves extensive interviews, with 40-50 state-nominated candidates advancing until the six national officers are selected.

The primary responsibility of a national officer is to serve the organization in local, state, national and international activities. National officers dedicate one year of service. The time is spent representing student membership during meetings with the National FFA Board of Directors, facilitating workshops that bring leadership and knowledge to FFA members, delivering motivational speeches and serving as advocates for FFA on a global scale.
