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## NRCS helping some veterans find a second career in

# Agriculture

Some veterans are finding a second career in agriculture, thanks to the Natural Resources Conservation Service.

One veteran from West Carroll Parish, Jimmie French of Oak Grove, is trying his hand at high tunnel farming. He said he loves working with his hands. "This is ideal for who has the first tomato. It used to be the first bale of cotton. Now it's the first tomato," said French.

French has no agricultural background. He was a plumber in Oak Grove and the surrounding area for nearly 45 years. Prior to that, he served in the U.S. Army and in Vietnam.

"I spent a little less than two years. Basic at Fort Polk. A year and seven days over there."

Jimmie heard about the Natural Resources Conservation Service program called Equip. Scott Breedlove and Jody Frederick with the NRCS office in West Carroll Parish turned Jimmie onto the program.

"It's really for all landowners where we can help with plant productivity, soil erosion, a lot of our natural resources. It's great just be able to assist our veterans and give back to them. It's a fulfillment for me personally. They've done a great service for us," said Jody Frederick, District Conservationist.

"It's nice to know that you've helped somebody make their life goal to do something like this," said Scott Breedlove, NRCS.

The High Tunnel initiative can give financial and physical assistance to those with a passion for growing and help them get the hoop house up and running. The controlled atmosphere of the hoop house allows producers to extend their growing season.

"In my mind I want to be the first one with tomatoes and the last one with tomatoes," said French.

Because high tunnels prevent direct rainfall from reaching plants, farmers can use precise tools like drip irrigation to efficiently deliver water and nutrients to the plants.

"There's one valve over there that you can cut on and it waters the whole system and then there's a bowl over there, if you cut it on it will fertilize it," said French.

Jimmie is experimenting with all types of fruits and vegetables. Okra, squash lettuce and even decorative sunflowers. But for him, tomatoes are the top choice.

"These tomatoes are what I call "football" tomatoes. I play the radio for them every Friday night so they can listen to the Oak Grove Tigers. It makes a difference to the tomatoes!" added French.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## USDA Designates Natural Disaster Areas

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has designated three Louisiana parishes as contiguous disaster areas as the result of excessive rain and flooding that happened between April 1 to June 30, 2018, said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Twenty counties in Mississippi received a primary disaster designation and 32 received a contiguous disaster designation. The contiguous Louisiana parishes that had crop damage and losses are: Concordia, East Carroll, and Tensas. Strain said some agriculture producers in these parishes

could be eligible for low interest emergency (EM) loans from USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible areas have eight months from the date of the declaration to apply for loans to help cover part of their actual losses. FSA will consider each loan application on

its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability. FSA has a variety of programs, in addition to the EM loan program, to help eligible farmers recover from adversity. Local FSA offices can provide affected farmers with further information.

# Harvest winter vegetables the proper way

(11/23/18) The vegetables we grow in Louisiana during the cool season are some of the most delicious and nutritious that our home gardens can produce. Many of the vegetables that we planted in late summer and early fall are ready to harvest or will be soon. It is important to harvest vegetables at the proper stage for best results, so here are a few guidelines for some common cool-season crops.

Root crops are harvested when the root is the proper size. Usually, the top of the root is readily visible at ground level, but it is easy enough to brush aside the soil at the base of the leaves to check on the size of the root. Harvest radishes and carrots when the root is about one inch across. Carrots can be left in the ground once they are mature and harvested as needed, and the tops can be used as a parsley substitute. Turnips should be harvested when they are 2 to 3 inches in diameter and rutabagas (a close relative) when they are 4 or 5 inches in diameter. Beets are best harvested at 2 to 3 inches and parsnips at 1 1/2 to 2 inches.

Incidentally, to get good production, these plants must be spaced properly in the garden. When the seeds you plant come up, it is very important to thin the seedlings at least as far apart as the width of the mature root in order to get good production. Leaving the seedlings too crowded is a common reason for root crops to produce small or misshapen roots.

Broccoli heads are not harvested based on the size of the head but when the largest individual flower buds are about the size of a kitchen match head. Do not allow the heads to remain on the plant so long that some of the buds to open to produce a yellow flower. Remember that smaller side heads will develop after the main head has been harvested, so leave the plant in place for additional harvest.

Harvesting cauliflower also depends more on the appearance of the head than its size. The curds of the head should be relatively smooth, very much like the cauliflower that you buy in the supermarket. If allowed to stay on the plant too long, the head will begin to separate and lose quality. If you did not blanch your cauliflower by covering the head with the plant's leaves, it may have a purple, green or yellow tint to it. This does not greatly affect the quality of the head.

Leafy crops such as mustard, spinach, Swiss chard, leaf lettuce, collards and turnips should be harvested frequently by breaking off the lowest, largest leaves (this is called cropping). Harvest the entire head of semi-heading varieties of lettuce such as bibb, buttercrunch and romaine when the head is fully developed.

Cabbage is ready to harvest when the head is solid and hard. Cabbage is one of the few crops that may be left in the garden

after they are ready to harvest, although the heads may split. If you are going to leave fully formed heads in the garden, rotate the entire plant one-half turn to prevent splitting (this slows water uptake by breaking some of the roots).

Snow peas and edible-pod peas are productive, delicious and well worth growing. Harvest snow peas when the pods are full size but still quite flat. Edible-pod peas, such as Sugar Snap peas, should be harvested when the pods are full and round but before the peas inside the pod have fully developed. Both types of peas should be checked daily and harvested frequently.

Bunching onions and green shallots can be harvested anytime during the winter when the tops are large enough. Dig up the entire clump and separate off one-half to two-thirds of the bunch, and then replant the rest to continue to grow and divide for future harvesting.

Cold protection for winter vegetables

Although winter vegetables are generally hardy, new plantings may need to be protected from hard freezes as will certain vegetables at or near harvest stage. If temperatures below 30 degrees are predicted, young seedlings should receive special attention by completely covering them with a 4-to-6-inch layer of loose mulch like leaves or pine straw. The mulch may remain over the plants for a few days, but remove it as soon as the freezing episode is over. Plastic covering that don't touch the plants, sheets or floating row coverings may also be used.

Although the plants themselves are quite hardy, the heads of broccoli and cauliflower are prone to cold injury if temperatures drop below 30 degrees. The leaves, flowers and pods of peas may also be damaged by hard freezes. Rather than trying to provide protection, the gardener should consider harvesting all mature and nearly mature produce before the freeze.

The following lists will give you a quick guide to the ability of some vegetables to endure freezes.

— Protect or harvest if temperatures are predicted to go below 30 degrees: fava beans, broccoli, cauliflower, lettuce, peas.

— Will tolerate temperatures down to the mid-20s with little or no damage: Swiss chard, Chinese cabbage, kohlrabi, mustard, spinach, radishes, turnips (although the leaves of radishes and turnips are moderately hardy, their roots are very hardy).

— Will survive temperatures in the low 20s and even the teens, especially if given some protection: beets, Brussels sprouts, carrots, celery, collards, garlic, onions, parsley, leeks and shallots.
