## *Farm bill mostly beneficial for Louisiana ag producers*

Both the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives passed the 2018 farm bill with strong bipartisan support. The bill passed the Senate

on an 87-13 vote and passed the House by a vote of 386-47. This is the first time since 1990 that a farm bill has been enacted the same year

it was introduced.

Michael Deliberto, an agricultural economist for the LSU AgCenter, said the 2018 farm bill is “more an evolution of farm policy and not a revolution.” His interpretation of the bill is it is in line with a continuation of the previous farm bill and does not make any radical changes.

Deliberto said factors that shaped the 2018 version were lower commodity prices for the past few years, political realities and constraints being placed on the federal budget by Congress.

“There were some changes to Title I programs that should be beneficial to Louisiana farmers during tough times,” Deliberto said.

According to U.S. Department of Agriculture data, these are tough times. Net farm income is projected to drop 12 percent in 2018, the lowest levels since 2002. Poor market conditions, especially for Louisiana soybean producers, and adverse weather have played havoc on farmers.

Deliberto said some of the most notable changes were done to appeal to the interests of the nonfarm voting bloc.

“This farm bill does maintain and enhance the crop insurance programs, which are helpful to growers. It also expands most conservation programs and creates new assistance to indoor and urban agriculture. The bill also increases aid to organic agriculture and farms that serve local markets,” Deliberto said.

One of the most significant changes to both the Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC) programs is, starting in 2021, producers will be allowed to make annual elections rather than five-year decisions under the 2014 farm bill.

This annual decision component will give producers more flexibility to respond to changing market conditions.

The individual payment limit remains at \$125,000, but the definition of family was extended in the 2018 version to include

nieces, nephews and first cousins.

“For the ARC program, payments will now be calculated based on the physical location of the farm, not the administrative parish location,” Deliberto said. “Another change to ARC is USDA Risk Management Agency yields will be used as the first source of parish-level yield information. These acres are documented and certified and will be used to set revenue guarantees and calculate payments.”

Deliberto said the new farm bill increased acreage in the Conservation Reserve Program, which is good for Louisiana. The CRP cap will be increased from the current 24 million acres to 27 million acres by 2023.

“While acres allocated for CRP will go up, there is a slight decrease in rental rates for this program,” he said. “The new bill also encourages the use of cover crops for conservation purposes. Producers may want to examine the provisions related to cover crops.”

President Donald Trump signed the farm bill on Dec. 20.

## Poultry owners urged to maintain biosecurity after disease detected in California

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding poultry owners to maintain biosecurity following the recent detection of virulent Newcastle disease (vND) in a California commercial poultry flock. The case was confirmed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS).

This is the first case of virulent Newcastle disease, formally known as Exotic Newcastle disease, in commercial poultry since 2003. This case is part of the outbreak in

southern California that began in May 2018 in backyard birds.

“This California case should serve as a harsh reminder to all poultry owners in the state of the important role that biosecurity plays in protecting the health of our poultry flocks,” Strain said. “Everyone within the poultry community from backyard-poultry hobbyists to commercial producers should have biosecurity procedures in place and adhere to them every time, every day.

“Just last year Louisiana poultry production brought in \$1.8 billion, it is vital that we do everything in

our power to protect this important industry.”

With a mortality rate of nearly 100 percent in birds, virulent Newcastle disease is considered one of the most serious poultry diseases worldwide. The disease spreads when healthy birds come in direct contact with bodily fluids from sick birds. The disease affects almost all birds and poultry, even vaccinated poultry. The virus can travel on litter, egg flats, crates, other farming materials or equipment, and people who have picked up the virus on their clothing, shoes, or hands.

The disease poses no threat to food safety and no human cases of the disease have ever occurred from eating poultry products. Properly cooked poultry products are safe to eat. In very rare instances people working directly with sick birds can become infected resulting in a mild infection, predominantly conjunctivitis. Infection is easily prevented by using standard personal protective equipment.

# USDA launches second round of trade mitigation payments

(Washington, D.C.) Dec. 17, 2018 – The U.S. Department of Agriculture recently announced the second and final round of trade mitigation payments to assist farmers suffering from damage due to unjustified trade retaliation by foreign nations. Producers of certain commodities will now be eligible to receive Market Facilitation Program (MFP) payments for the second half of their 2018 production.

Since September 2018, USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) has been administering the MFP to provide the first payments to producers for the first 50 percent of their 2018 production.

The MFP provides payments to almond, cotton, corn, dairy, hog, sorghum, soybean, fresh sweet cherry, and wheat producers

who have been significantly impacted by actions of foreign governments resulting in the loss of traditional exports. Eligible producers should apply after harvest is complete, as payments will only be issued once production is reported.

Producers need only sign-up once for the MFP to be eligible for the first and second payments. The MFP sign-up period opened in September and runs through January 15, 2019, with information and instructions provided at [www.farmers.gov/mfp](http://www.farmers.gov/mfp).

Producers must complete an application by January 15, 2019 but have until May 1, 2019 to certify their 2018 production.

For farmers who have already applied, completed harvest, and certified their 2018 production, a second payment will be

issued on the remaining 50 percent of the producer's total production, multiplied by the MFP rate for the specific commodity.

"The President reaffirmed his support for American farmers and ranchers and made good on his promise, authorizing the second round of payments to be made in short order," U.S. Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue said. "While there have been positive movements on the trade front, American farmers are continuing to experience losses due to unjustified trade retaliation by foreign nations. This assistance will help with short-term cash flow issues as we move into the new year."

## AQUACULTURE

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) will soon conduct the 2018 Census of Aquaculture as a follow-on survey to the 2017 Census of Agriculture. This census is the only comprehensive source of information on the aquaculture industry in the nation.

Last conducted five years ago, this census serves as the baseline for many decisions involving the sustainability and growth of U.S. aquaculture. The results will also help aquaculture organizations assess the current state of this critical sector of the U.S. economy.

USDA's NASS will survey farm operators to collect detailed information related to production and production methods, surface water acres and sources, sales, point of first sale, and distributed aquaculture.

For the purpose of this survey, an aquaculture farm is any place from which \$1,000 or more of aquaculture products were produced and sold, or distributed for conservation, recreation, enhancement, or restoration purposes, during the census year.

The Census of Aquaculture will be mailed to all farms that reported aquaculture activity during the 2017 Census of Agriculture. Questionnaires will be mailed December 17. Please respond online, by mail, telephone, or personal enumeration by January 14, 2019. Survey results will be available October 10, 2019.
