Trump addresses national farm organization in New Orleans

“Farmers have always led the way...”

Louisiana recently hosted the centennial celebration of the American Farm Bureau Federation in New Orleans. While statewide leaders such as Louisiana Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M., and Governor John Bel Edwards were in attendance to speak to the national agricultural audience, so was the 45th president of the United States, Donald J. Trump, who fulfilled a promise he made at the 2018 meeting in Nashville, Tennessee when he said he would be at the 2019 meeting.

“On this special anniversary, we gather to celebrate America’s proud farming heritage. Through your sweat, through all of your work, the strength of your hands, and the faith in your hearts, the American farmer feeds, and fuels, and sustains our nation. So true,” said Trump.

While much of the president’s speech to the approximately 6,000 in attendance was focused on building a wall, or barrier, to keep illegal immigrants from entering the United States at the southern border, Trump said he would make it easier and more streamlined for H2A and H2B workers to enter the country and work on the farms. “We’re going to make that actually easier for them -- to help the farmers. Because you need these people. No, you need these

people. We’re going to make it easier,” said Trump. Strain said this is good news. “Now is when you need to get visiting workers with proper credentials to do seasonal jobs that Americans will not do such as peeling crawfish, planting trees and picking fruits and vegetables.”

Trump also discussed the elimination of the inheritance, or death, tax. It is a tax he said prohibited many families from keeping the family farms they inherit because families cannot afford the inheritance taxes on these properties that are already family owned.

Trump also recognized that the newly signed Farm Bill which strengthens crop insurance for the farmer and allows a farmer to plan for the future. It increases the amount farmers can borrow so they can expand and improve their businesses. It also secures the \$600 million commitment to build a modern, effective, rural broadband across America’s heartland.

Trump discussed repealing the Waters of the U.S. (WOTUS) rule in which he said, “We’re going to get government off your backs so you can earn a living and support your families doing what you love. And I know what you love. Farmers love what they’re

Third Grade Cabbage Program Turns into Life Lesson

Alaina Watkins was very familiar with the Bonnie Plants Cabbage Program. So when it was her turn to participate at Southland Christian Academy in Denham Springs, La., she took it very seriously. It even entailed a little research.

"I took it home and we were going to plant it in our front yard, but I didn't want to do that. So I asked my mom if we could do something else. We looked at last year's winner and they used a kiddie pool," said Alaina. So Alaina decided to go that route.

"We were really shocked when we got the news. We are also very proud," said Alaina's mother, Jessica. "We tried it with my older daughter, so we were a little more prepared

this time around. We tried to grow it in the ground that time, but our home flooded (Great Flood of 2016) so the ground was not the same," Jessica added.

In speaking with Alaina, you quickly find out that she is a young lady on a mission. "My mom always wants me to do my best, and so this feels good." Alaina wound up growing the largest cabbage in the state – a whopping 10 pounder – for the Bonnie Plants Cabbage Program.

Bonnie Plants Louisiana representative, Foster Reeves, said, "The program is meant to get children involved in gardening and understand where their food comes from. We use a cabbage because that is the first

plant Bonnie Plants grew in 1918. Back then, it was delivered by horse and buggy."

Alaina added that she really felt responsible for the cabbage she was growing. "I would check on it, water it, and make sure I mixed the soil. I learned that you really have to make sure the roots are watered, not just the plant, and mix the soil."

"It's a great program because not only does it teach responsibility, but it easily becomes a family activity for these children," added Reeves. "Plus, they get to see what happens when they work hard and they are rewarded for their hard work."

Jessica added that she and her husband just want their children to be the best people they

can be at whatever they are doing, whether it is schoolwork or being a friend to someone.

"This was a way to learn how to nurture something, to take something from nothing and grow it as long as you take care of it," said Jessica. "The way I explained it to Alaina is that when she was a tiny baby, I had to do so much for her in the beginning. Just like everything I put into raising her up until this point, she did the same for her cabbage. She put a lot into it and allowed it to grow." And grow it did.

doing." Strain responded to the president's statement by adding, "We need to undo an over-burdensome regulation and move our economy forward."

The president also said that replacing unfair trade deals and providing "fair

market access" to all agriculture producers will be a result of replacing the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) with the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) trade agreement. Strain said this is

another positive for Louisiana. "The promise to open up and expand new markets will increase our ability to move new products abroad."

The president stressed that "farmers have always led the way. "You raise a

loving family, you teach your children right from wrong and you are loyal to your country." He added, "The future of American farmers is bigger, better, bolder and brighter than ever before."

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
