

## DREAMS Foundation making dreams happen

Donielle Watkins is on a mission. The mother of a son with special needs, Watkins knew her son, Logan, wanted more out of life.

Watkins said, “How do you tell your child he can’t when he knows he can?”

Logan, now 20, was born with

Spina Bifida, a birth defect that affects the spinal cord. Watkins said all her son wanted in life was to do the same things other kids did like play baseball, basketball and even go bowling.

Watkins and her husband, Brian, eventually helped start a baseball league for kids with disabilities. When people started asking if they could donate to the league, Watkins, who is a CPA by profession, decided it was time to start a non-profit and called it the DREAMS Foundation of Acadiana. DREAMS is an acronym for Disability Resources Education Activities Management Services which was incorporated in 2008. In the meantime, Watkins’ husband, Brian, went back to school to get a degree in education so he could become a special education teacher.

“As our members started getting older, we began to look at how we could get some job training for our members since they wanted to work. We wondered how we could make people with disabilities be

more self-sufficient. I often think about this in the event that Logan outlives me,” said Watkins.

Watkins said Chris Burch, a friend who was a former food distributor and on the DREAMS Foundation of Acadiana board, approached her one day with an opportunity. “Mr. Burch said a friend of his in the area had a meat pie business and was looking to get out of the business of making meat pies. We decided to check to see if our individuals with special needs could make the pies...to my surprise, making meat pies was a simple process.” Watkins said she knew she wanted to open something related to the food industry because “everyone needs to eat” so this was a perfect fit. Finding a place to house this business and learning the ropes for USDA inspections and other federal and state health requirements were a whole different story.

With help from the USDA and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry’s Meat Inspection Division, the

DREAMS Foundation of Acadiana manufacturing facility became a reality.

“They were so wonderful in helping us set up the facility, inspecting it and helping us work within the guidelines of processing plants. We simply could not have done this without their help,” said Watkins.

Currently, the facility employs 21 workers with special needs. Their goal is to eventually hire 200. “When we opened in October (2018), we interviewed every person who applied and hired them all.” The current employees range in age from 20-30 years old and their disabilities range from severe cerebral palsy to high-functioning autism.

“We treat them as equals. We don’t treat them as people with special needs,” added Watkins. “They clock in, do a job, and clock out. We learn what they are good at and help them excel at it. This job gives them purpose, responsibility and job experience.”

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Nation's ag leaders urge ratification of USMCA

Baton Rouge, La. - Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., praised the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) which modernizes the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA).

"I'm pleased that Canada and Mexico have taken this important step in the right direction toward

fair trade and increased market access for American farmers and ranchers," Strain said. "The deal includes key provisions increasing markets for U.S. rice, wheat, dairy, poultry, eggs and many other agricultural products."

Currently, 27 percent of all U.S. exports go to Canada and Mexico.

"I'm hopeful the USMCA deal will fuel a renewed effort to improve trade tensions with China, a major agricultural market for Louisiana behind Canada and Mexico.

"I urge the U.S. Congress to ratify the USMCA, eliminating tariffs on more than 200 American products and providing a new and improved avenue for trade and

economic growth," Strain added.

Strain was recently in Washington D.C. at a National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) meeting in which the nation's agriculture leaders develop and advocate public policy and programs that promote the agricultural industry.

Watkins' brother, Brandon Gaubert, who is a professional chef, prepares the meat voluntarily while the employees make the dough, scoop the cooked meat, and operate the machine to make the pie. Then they package and put the pies in the freezer for delivery. At the end of each day, they clean the machines, floors, tables and bathroom. The employees work two to twelve hours per week and are paid \$7.25 an hour. Those employees who qualify to be managers earn a little more money.

The meat pies are currently sold in 13 retail locations in the Acadiana area. They are also supplied to prisons and nursing

homes. Other funding comes through donations and sports league events. "Our kids can work and should work. They just want to be a part of the community."

Watkins said she puts all her faith in God. "I've always looked to give back in some fashion. The more you give, the more you receive. Seeing those kids smiling is everything. These individuals can and will do everything a typical person would like to do they just need the opportunity. We are giving them the opportunities from recreational activities, to holding jobs."

# Ag Hall of Distinction honors four inductees

BATON ROUGE, La. – The Louisiana Agriculture Hall of Distinction added four new members for 2019. During ceremonies held March 7 in Baton Rouge, Grady Coburn, Jack Hamilton, George LaCour and Linda Zaunbrecher were inducted for their significant contributions to the state's agricultural community.

Zaunbrecher, a native of Gueydan, was recognized as a pioneer for women serving as leaders in Louisiana agriculture, along with her work in establishing the Louisiana Farm Bureau Foundation. She is only the second woman to be inducted into the Hall of Distinction.

Coburn, of Cheneyville, serves as an independent agricultural consultant and researcher. Over the past 40 years, his insights have helped farmers throughout the state and around the country improve pest management and optimize profits.

A native of Lake Providence, Hamilton passed away in 2001. He was honored posthumously for his crucial innovations to cotton production and ginning, as well as his role in the formation of the Agricultural Corporation Self-Insurance Fund.

LaCour was honored for his expertise with sustainability and conservation in the cotton industry. He was a driving force in creating the Tri-Parish Gin in Pointe Coupee Parish, and he has traveled as far as China with his outreach work through the Cotton Research and Promotion Program.

The Hall of Distinction honors outstanding contributions to Louisiana agriculture in farming, ranching, forestry, aquaculture, education and agribusiness. The annual ceremony is presented by the Louisiana Radio Network in cooperation with the LSU AgCenter, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, and the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation. Bayer serves as title sponsor and First South Farm Credit is the presenting sponsor.
