LSU AgCenter graduates first Master Goat Producer Program class

BATON ROUGE, La. — More than 20 people were named Master Goat Producers on April 27 after completing a new LSU

AgCenter training program.

Participants in the Master Goat Producer Program attended three daylong classes that featured

lessons and demonstrations by fellow goat producers and AgCenter and LSU School of Veterinary Medicine personnel. They covered topics such as facilities, fencing and equipment; breeds, reproduction and genetics; grooming; health and nutrition; marketing goat products; and 4-H programs.

“Those who graduated this class and who are interested can participate in a goat educational trip to Oklahoma in August to several producer farms, Reproductive Enterprises, Inc. and Langston University Small Ruminant Research Center,” said Rodney Johnson, livestock specialist for the AgCenter Central Region. The trip will be Aug. 9 to 11.

Johnson is now planning a second round of Master Goat Producer classes. Meetings will be at Reese Hall at the Louisiana Tech University farm, 1501 Reese Drive in Ruston, on Aug. 17, Aug. 24 and Sept. 28.

Registration costs \$125, and participants must attend

all three meetings to become a certified Master Goat Producer. Contact Johnson at rjohnson@agcenter.lsu.edu or 318-767-3968 to sign up.

The Master Goat Producer Program is one of several AgCenter programs — including the Master Farmer Program, the Master Cattleman Program and the Master Gardener Program — that help people in agriculture improve their skills and network with one another. Strain: termite swarming season is here

Have you noticed more insects swarming at dusk? More than likely those insects are termites in search of a new home.

It's subterranean termite swarming season – the pests swarm as weather warms up or following a rain event.

The typical swarming season usually runs from May through June and peaks around Mother's Day.

Here are some tips to protect your property from termites:

1. Repair any leaks in the roof, pipes and outside faucets on your home.
2. Turn off outside lights at night or use yellow bulbs to avoid attracting swarming termites.
3. Repair rotting wood on fascia, soffit, and exterior wood surfaces.

4. Pick up any wood lying on the ground under and around your home.
5. Look around your home at the slab line and base of piers for signs of termites.
6. Store firewood away from your home.
7. Clean the gutters on your home and fix any holes.
8. Trim tree limbs and vines that may be growing on or

near your home.

9. Do not allow water to pool next to the slab or under your home. Drain the water away.
10. Most importantly, use only licensed and certified pest control professionals for termite treatments.

sure we do the Clovers Care project as well," said Richland Parish senior Samantha Summers.

The group has actively contributed to the state service-learning project that targets childhood cancer awareness by participating in local fundraising events and visiting and donating items to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital in Memphis and the Shriner's Hospital for Children in Houston, Powell said.

Every two years the state service-learning focus changes based on how 4-H

4-H Clovers Care program helps Monroe-area foster children

A colorful gift bag filled with personal care items, toys and games is a small gesture of kindness that can make a world of difference to a child entering foster care for the first time.

Members of the Northeast Regional 4-H Leadership Board have spearheaded a project for the past five years they call Clovers Care, putting about 200 age-appropriate gift bags into the hands of foster adoptive children from the Monroe region.

"Each item is a joy to the children," said Wanda Washington, child welfare supervisor with the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services.

The Clovers Care bags include items that are helpful for children just entering care and give them something of their own, Washington said.

"Their faces just light up to get the bag," she said.

Close to 500 children are in foster care in the Monroe Department of Children and Family Services region at any given time, and the bags have been a blessing, Washington said.

"It has been amazing to watch the youth be very intentional in buying for others," said LSU AgCenter regional 4-H coordinator Ashley Powell.

"Most people don't really consider doing something like this," said Morehouse

Parish senior Christianna Releford, adding that board members collect money and useful items for the bags all year.

More than 25 4-H board members and adult volunteers met April 27 in Vidalia to conclude the board activities for the year with a full day of community service.

The teens collected \$480 in cash donations and other items valued at \$350 to fill 30 Clovers Care bags this year.

The group began the day volunteering for Aiden's Light Mind Over Matter 5K obstacle course to support families with children diagnosed with Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma and raise funds for other brain cancer research.

Following the event, board members gathered to purchase supplies and assemble the Clovers Care bags for children from birth to 18 years of age.

Each teen selected a boy or girl in a specific age range and traveled to a local store to shop for some practical and fun items to make each child feel special.

"I have little cousins, and they like dinosaurs and super heroes, clothes and playing with boy games," said Releford, who shopped for a boy in the 4-to-6-year-old age group.

Kevin Thompson Jr., a ninth-grader from East Carroll Parish, relied on his personal experience to shop for a boy 6 to 8 years old, purchasing hygiene products, socks

and athletic wear.

"Boys that age have a lot of energy and focus on sports," Thompson said.

Freshman Jaylan Bell, of East Carroll Parish, had the same idea shopping for a 10-to-12-year-old boy.

"I know when I was that age, I was outside playing basketball, throwing football and throwing things like Frisbees," he said.

The service-learning project has been a successful teaching tool for youth to learn about budgeting and making age-appropriate purchases while building on their leadership experiences, said AgCenter extension 4-H agent Brandon Reeder.

"It doesn't matter what other service projects we do each year, we always make
