Fort Martin playground opens at Indian Creek

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) and RoyOMartin announced the grand opening of Fort Martin, a new playground located at Indian Creek Recreation Area in Woodworth, Louisiana. This effort was a joint partnership between the LDAF and RoyOMartin.

Indian Creek, which is located 15 miles south of RoyOMartin's corporate headquarters in Alexandria, is a popular destination for fishing, hiking, biking, and camping. While some basic playground equipment was already on site, Fort Martin is intended to provide a safer, larger and modern space

for young children to play. Its name honors the Martin family, whose patriarch, Roy O. Martin, Sr., entered the wood-products business in 1923.

RoyOMartin's involvement in this project consisted of employee volunteers helping design the playground equipment, supplying the wood needed for construction, and overseeing its installation—as well as landscaping—at the site. YellaWood® donated the majority of the lumber used in construction.

"We want to thank RoyOMartin for stepping up to the plate and providing funding for a much-needed playground at Indian Creek Recreation Area that will be enjoyed by thousands of children," stated Mike Strain, D.V.M., Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner. "We are so

“When you’re everyone’s favorite bear, you deserve to party all year long! Funny thing is, Smokey doesn’t look like he’s aged one bit,” said Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

According to the U.S. Forest Service, Smokey Bear was born when the Forest Service and Ad Council decided a fictional bear would be used as the symbol to promote forest fire prevention. In 1947, Smokey’s slogan became “Only YOU Can Prevent Forest Fires!”

In 1950, a bear cub was caught in a burning forest in New Mexico. The bear found refuge in a tree but was badly burned. Firefighters who rescued the bear named him Smokey. The bear was given a new home at the National Zoo in Washington, D.C. until his death in 1976. He also played an important role in messaging that promoted wildfire prevention and forest conservation.

Spicer recognized at state capitol for public service

The Louisiana Legislature recently recognized Bradley Spicer for fifty-five years of exemplary public service and congratulated him upon his retirement from the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

Spicer is a native of Oak Hall Station, Pennsylvania. He served in the U.S. Air Force as an in-flight refueling specialist for the Strategic Air Command during the Cold War. Spicer continued to serve in the Air Force Reserves after he was honorably discharged from active duty in 1960.

In 1965, Spicer received his bachelor of science in agronomy from the University of Southwestern Louisiana; and later received his masters in agronomy with a minor in geomorphology in 1969 from Louisiana State University.

Spicer is a licensed-professional geoscientist and during his career he has authored and coauthored numerous technical and scientific articles and reports. Spicer began his career in conservation in 1965 working as a soil scientist for the United States Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service (SCS) in Baton Rouge; and he spent 20 years with the SCS, during which time he was placed on special assignments assisting state agencies, including the office of the governor, the Department of Natural Resources, coastal management division, and the Department of Agriculture and Forestry, in natural resource conservation.

Spicer changed the way Louisiana

treats soil and water conservation by developing comprehensive and coordinated conservation systems. He was the driving force in moving soil and water conservation from the Department of Transportation and Development to the Department of Agriculture and Forestry and creating the Office of Soil and Water Conservation.

Spicer has served as the assistant commissioner for the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, Office of Soil and Water Conservation, and executive director of the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission since January 1986.

Spicer’s passion and commitment to conservation have made him an invaluable leader in natural resource conservation efforts, both in Louisiana and nationwide, and he has received recognition for his contributions at the state and national levels.

Spicer served as the president of the National Association of State Conservation Agencies and was awarded the National Association of Conservation Districts’ Professional Service Award in 2000.

Spicer has been instrumental in many of Louisiana’s major natural resource conservation milestones over the past five decades, including the passage of the State and Local Coastal Resources Management in 1978 and the creation of the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Authority in 1989, which was the forerunner to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority, and the Ground Water Resources Commission in 2001.

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
