LDAF, SUSTA host trade mission with Canada



The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) in partnership with the Southern United States Trade Association (SUSTA) sponsored a Canada in-bound trade mission to Louisiana on June 20-21 followed by a the Summer Fancy Food Show on June 22 in New York City.

The trade mission began in Baton Rouge, La. where Louisiana companies met with Canadian buyers in Baton Rouge, La. The Baton Rouge leg concluded with a tour of LSU AgCenter's Food Incubator, a business incubator that specializes in providing business and technical services, and resources to existing and emerging companies. For the New York City leg of the trade mission, participants attended the Summer Fancy Food Show which SUSTA provided companies the possibility to meet with Canadian buyers from various regions and have one-on-one meetings with them.

Louisiana companies representing products such as Steen's Syrup, Mama Roos Pecan Candy, Kinloch Pecan Oil, Pranam Antioxidant Bar, Cajun Blendz 180° Seasonings, Joe Gambino's Bakery, Cajun Thyme Iced Tea and Zydeco Salsa were in attendance.

Karen Mahoney with Joe Gambino's said they were glad they participated in the trade mission and were hopeful the meeting would result in new sales opportunities.

LDAF's Certified Louisiana Director Deana Erdey, who also serves as a SUSTA activity manager said, "I'm encouraged by the number of our Certified Louisiana companies and others who participated in the Canada trade event. I will continue to engage our partners at SUSTA to assist Louisiana companies interested in increasing their sales and exporting into markets abroad."

Participants must fill out surveys detailing the results of the trade mission immediately following the event and again six months later. No deals were made on the spot but participating companies made valuable business contacts which could result in future sales.

SUSTA is a non-profit organization, which works with state departments of agriculture within its region to help small and medium-sized companies to promote their value-added food and agricultural products in foreign markets. The organization assists companies in several ways: reduced fees to attend domestic trade shows, access to market research and other export resources and a 50-percent cost-share, for example, SUSTA reimburses a company for eligible marketing expenses to promote products in foreign markets.

Hurricane Barry damage assessment underway

It could be a few weeks before complete damage assessments from Hurricane Barry are available.

“Our partners, the LSU AgCenter and the USDA’s Farm Service Agency (FSA), are in the process of assessing damage from the storm,” said Department of

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “I’ve also been in communication with top officials from the USDA and Governor John Bel Edwards to discuss a possible secretarial disaster designation to ensure our agriculture industry is protected.”

This week, Strain and Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry employees have traveled the state to observe damage and meet with some farmers.

“While the damage was not widespread across the state, we have farmers who were greatly impacted.

When you are at the mercy of Mother Nature, it is tough to keep going year after year with so much uncertainty. I have great empathy for our hard working agriculture community,” added Strain.

Hurricane season ends November 30.

ZYDECO SWEET POTATO STUFFED BELL PEPPERS

INGREDIENTS:

3 large multi-colored bell peppers cut in half
2 lbs. ground pork & beef
1 medium onion chopped
1 (16 oz.) jar of Zydeco Sweet Potato Salsa

Air fryer enthusiasts are testing the limits of the machine cooking up everything but the kitchen sink. What is an air fryer, you ask?

A kitchen appliance that's like a convection oven on steroids. Cooking time is faster, crisps great and the cleanup is pretty easy. One such airfryer enthusiast is LDAF's own Food Distribution Program Administrator Mack Williams sister, Dr. Michelle Eckert of Pine Bluff, Ark. A surgeon by profession, Eckert enjoys cooking, using her air fryer and sharing recipes on Facebook to a group she started called Air Fryer Group at JRMC. Here are a few she has shared.

Air-fryer Recipes

by Michelle Eckert

Alligator eggs

Crack egg into avocado halves, sprinkle with cheese. Place in air fryer and set temperature to 400 degrees for 10-14 minutes (depending on how runny you want the yolk). Remove from air fryer. Burst the yolk, then add salt, pepper and crumbled bacon. You got to try it.

Barbecued Ribs

Dry rub your ribs with your choice of seasoning. Place in the air fryer at 300 degrees for 1 hour. Five minutes before the ribs are done, add the barbecue sauce of your choice.

Drago-Style Air-Fryer Oysters

Butter Sauce Recipe

10 oz butter melted
1 tablespoon black pepper
1 tablespoon white pepper
3 tablespoon minced garlic
1 tablespoon powdered garlic

Place shucked oysters in shells or cooking vessel. Spoon tablespoon of butter sauce, cooked crumbled bacon, candied jalapenos, Parmesan cheese. Set temperature to 390 degrees for 4 minutes.

Add another tablespoon of butter sauce and more cheese

Place in airfryer at 390 degrees for another 4 minutes.

The importance of connecting young people to agriculture and securing the future of farming in America emerged as central themes at the 2019 Morehouse Farm Field Day held July 19 in Bonita.

"Do it because you love it," said Southern University assistant county agent Odis Hill, a fourth-generation farmer who hosted the event for the second consecutive year on his family's farm.

Hill said more farmers are needed and urged young people to consider pursuing degrees in agriculture.

"Young people have the greatest opportunity they have ever had in agriculture," said Rogers Leonard, LSU AgCenter associate vice president.

As the need for food and fiber is expected to increase significantly by the year 2050, young people will need to play a critical role in meeting the challenges ahead, Leonard said.

"I can promise you we can't meet these challenges if we don't have farmers," he said, adding that in Southern University AgCenter and the LSU AgCenter, Louisiana has two of the best institutions in the Southern region to support agriculture research, education and outreach.

California author Natalie Baszile said she was encouraged during her visit to the field day by the young people she met who are continuing the farming tradition.

Baszile's novel "Queen Sugar," set in contemporary rural Louisiana, is the inspiration for the television drama series by the same name. The book tells the story of a young African American widow who moved from California to assume management of a sugarcane farm left to her by her late father.

"You are continuing a farming tradition that is really part of the American story — a story that I feel has not really been told, and a story that I'm committed to continue to tell," she said.

The field day drew more than 200 adults and youth and was sponsored by the Southern University AgCenter, LSU AgCenter, the Morehouse Black Farmers and Landowners Association with support from numerous businesses and industry groups. The field day was part of the National Black Growers Council 2019 Model Farm Series tour.

"We need all the tools in our toolbox that we can get," said P.J. Haynie, chairman of the National Black Growers Council.

Keeping farmers informed about programs, technology, chemistry and equipment in a timely manner is key to fulfilling the council's mission to improve the efficiency, productivity and sustainability of black row crop farmers, Haynie said.

"We've been hosting these field days in More-

house Parish for 18 years and want to show the young people that we are still able to grow and harvest a crop and survive," said Harper Armstrong, president of the Morehouse Black Farmers and Landowners Association.

The field day showcased new technologies and provided updates from experts on soybean, corn and hemp production.

"We hope for you to be able to grow hemp next year," said Mike Strain, commissioner of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

In Louisiana, one crop of hemp is estimated to take about 110 days from seed to harvest, offering growers a chance to potentially harvest two crops a year, he said.

"We are going to walk through this carefully," Strain said, adding that federal guidelines for hemp production should be released soon. Louisiana will be able to finalize its plan soon after.

Ensuring that growers have a viable crop, the information needed to bring that crop to harvest and the capacity to have it processed will continue to be a priority moving forward, he said.

Art Walker, president of the Louisiana Industrial Hemp Alliance, said more than 50,000 industrial products can be made from hemp, including paper, clothes, plastics, biofuels, soap, cosmetics, car wash and building materials.

"Farmers like these will do very well with hemp for the industrial side of the industry," he said. "It's a bit different with hemp for CBD production."

Regulations for production of hemp-derived cannabidiol, or CBD, oil are significantly more complex than those for industrial hemp, Walker said.

Strain reminded farmers to apply for sales tax exemption certificates by completing Form R-1085 with the state Department of Revenue.

"We have to maintain our sales tax exemption because without that, we are not competitive," Strain said.
