Seed Vigor Testing Why is it important?

After some Louisiana farmers experienced problems with seed vigor this year, Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging farmers, seedsman and others to take the extra step of running a seed-vigor test to avoid costly problems in the upcoming planting season.

"It is particularly important to run a seed-vigor test before you plant," Strain said. "You may not be able to control Mother Nature, but using quality seed is one factor you can control."

Seed vigor is not required on seed labels thus is not part of LDAF's routine seed labeling compliance program. However, seed vigor testing can provide valuable information to farmers on how well their seed might perform under harsh conditions.

LDAF Seed Programs Director Lester Cannon said some folks question why they should vigor test their seed since the germination percentage is already stated on the label. The answer, "Seed with a high germination percentage may or may not have good vigor."

Germination tests are conducted under ideal laboratory conditions and help predict the germination potential of the seed when planted in favorable field conditions.

"Seed is almost never planted under ideal field conditions," Cannon said. "The vigor test, however, is conducted in the laboratory using less than ideal test conditions and helps predict the ability of the seed to perform under harsh field conditions."

Factors to consider:

- Low seed vigor often results in poor field emergence, less than ideal plant stands and subsequent economic loss for farmers.
- Vigor testing is used to determine the percentage of seeds that will most likely produce productive plants when these seeds are planted under or experience non-favorable field conditions.
- Seeds are lab tested using less than optimal growing conditions in a controlled environment under very stressful test conditions. These stressful test conditions typically involve the seeds being exposed to

LDAF assists Texas authorities to apprehend La. man connected to cattle-rustling ring

Baton Rouge, La. (September 4, 2019) – The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Brand Commission arrested a Rapides Parish man who was wanted for livestock theft in the state of Texas.

Justin G. Thompson of 127 Pilgrim Road, Hineston, La., was arrested on Tuesday, September 3, 2019 by LDAF brand inspectors on three warrants from the state of

Texas for theft of livestock in excess of \$91,000. The warrants were a result of an investigation conducted by the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association, special rangers in Woods County, Texas.

“This is not the first time Justin Thompson has been in trouble with the law. He was previously arrested by our brand inspectors on similar charges,” said Commissioner of

Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M.

The LDAF received a request to assist the special rangers in locating Thompson on outstanding warrants. LDAF brand inspectors were assisted by the Louisiana State Police and the St. Landry Parish Sheriff’s Department in locating him and making the arrest. Thompson was arrested by authorities off U.S. 190 west of Opelousas.

LDAF brand inspectors previously arrested Thompson and his parents, Ricky and Wanda Thompson, for felony theft of livestock in June 2018 in connection with stealing more than \$1 million in livestock from four Louisiana livestock sale barns. At the time of that arrest, they faced criminal charges in Allen, Avoyelles, East Baton Rouge and St. Landry parishes.

Thompson was out on

bond in the Allen Parish case at the time of this most recent arrest. Bond will be set in Texas.





Season inside of peppers with 1 teaspoon salt and black pepper; set aside. Combine rice, beans, corn, onion, walnuts, chilies, liquid smoke, cumin and remaining 1/4 teaspoon salt. Spoon 1 cup rice mixture into each pepper; stand upright in 13x9-inch baking pan. Cover pan with foil; bake for 20 minutes. Remove cover, sprinkle peppers with cheese. Cook additional 5 minutes or until cheese is melted.



CHEESY BACON RICE TOTS

1 cup Bacon, cooked, chopped
 3 cups Mild cheddar cheese, shredded
 1/2 cup Green chili hot sauce
 8 cups long grain rice, cooked, cooled (use 10% extra water to cook rice)
 As needed Rice flour
 1/3 cup Black pepper aioli
 1/2 cup Scallion, 1/4" slice on a bias
BLACK PEPPER AIOLI:
 2 cups Mayonnaise
 2 teaspoons Black pepper, freshly ground
 1 1/2 teaspoons Kosher salt
 1 tablespoon Lemon juice

For black pepper aioli, whisk together mayonnaise, black pepper, salt and lemon juice. Place in a refrigerator until time to serve. For tots, fold bacon, cheese, hot sauce and rice together. Lay 1 inch of rice mixture onto a sheet tray lined with plastic wrap. Cover rice with plastic wrap and place another same size sheet tray with around 2-3 lb of added weight on top of it. Let press for 2-3 hours in refrigerator or until rice completely cools. Remove rice from refrigerator and uncover. Cut rice into 1" x 1" cubes and toss in rice flour to coat. Fry in 350 degrees oil until light golden brown. Serve tots with black pepper aioli for dipping.

Collaborative relationships help sustain La. sweet potato industry

Collaborations among growers and industry partners have long sustained the growth and profitability of the sweet potato industry in Louisiana.

This cooperation was never more evident as growers, processors, regulatory agencies, researchers and marketing groups came together for the annual LSU AgCenter Sweet Potato Field Day held Aug. 22 at Black Gold Farms near Delhi.

“In any agricultural community, producers are driven to see what other producers are doing,” said LSU AgCenter Sweet Potato Research Station coordinator Tara Smith.

Small-plot research first conducted at the Sweet Potato Research Station at Chase applied on a commercial scale in cooperation with growers like Black Gold Farms helps researchers, producers and industry see how varieties and production programs perform.

“We like to be on the cutting edge,” said Todd O’Neal, farm manager at Black Gold Farms, currently the largest grower-shipper in Louisiana with more than 2,600 acres of sweet potatoes.

About half of the potatoes produced at Black Gold are destined for the fresh market through retailers across the southeastern United States, O’Neal said, while the other half is shipped just 13 miles north of the farming operation to the Lamb Weston facility where they will be processed for sweet potato fries.

“All of this research helps improve the size, shape and yield of the sweet potato, which obviously benefits the processing industry but also the fresh market industry. And of course, we like to see this research reduce those input costs so the cost of production will go down,” said Michelle McHargue, Lamb Weston senior food scientist.

The field day drew more than 125 people, including international visitors from South Africa along with representatives from North and South Carolina, Mississippi, Arkansas and Alabama.

“The impact of sweet potatoes is far greater than just the geopolitical boundaries of Louisiana,” said LSU AgCenter

Associate Vice President Rogers Leonard.

Compared to other agricultural commodities produced in Louisiana that represent a larger number of growers and far more acreage, resources that support the sweet potato industry cover a broader spectrum from seed production and variety development to field production and marketing at the local level, Leonard said.

The sweet potato industry contributes about \$100 million annually to the state’s economy. Louisiana currently ranks fourth in sweet potato production nationwide with just under 8,000 acres.

“The research done at the LSU AgCenter at Chase makes it one of the preeminent research stations in the world and keeps us ahead of the curve,” said Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain.

“It’s our job to make sure we don’t get new plant pests and diseases, and if we do get them here, we deal with them quickly. It is a team approach with the

AgCenter,” Strain said.

The recent threat posed from the guava root-knot nematode discovered on a farm in Morehouse Parish one such example.

“We know where it came from, what day it arrived, exactly where it was planted, and the grower was helpful and immediately alerted everyone that it was there,” said AgCenter plant pathologist Chris Clark. “The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry immediately became involved and worked with the AgCenter to develop a plan for dealing with it. And the grower has been very cooperative in executing that plan.”

The AgCenter is conducting a statewide survey, collecting and processing soil samples from agricultural production fields across the state, said AgCenter nematologist Josielle Rezende. To date, no samples have tested positive for the guava root-knot nematode.

“Our goal is to sample every sweet potato field as growers are harvesting the crop,” said AgCenter extension associate Myrl Sistrunk.

Recognized as a go-to research resource for all things sweet potato, from variety information and production practices to the latest pest and weed management strategies, the AgCenter Sweet Potato Research Station is also part of the National Clean Plant Network and is one of seven locations in the U.S. providing foundation seed and certified plant materials for producers across the nation and world.

The AgCenter sweet potato breeding program is one of only three active sweet potato breeding programs in the country.

Most of the sweet potato varieties developed by the AgCenter for commercial release find a fit in production programs across the Gulf South largely due to similar soil types and climate.

“That’s what these field trials are all about: to get that short list of those varieties that have the right characteristics to move into the industry if they show consistency,” said AgCenter sweet potato breeder Don La Bonte.

La Bonte is currently conducting several experimental variety trials across the U.S. and abroad.

extreme temperatures with very high relative humidity.

- Vigor testing can also be used to assist with the prediction of the storability of seeds being carried over for the next year’s planting season.
- In general, most seeds will start demonstrating a loss in vigor much sooner than they will demonstrate a loss in germination.
- Vigor testing is typically performed on soybeans and cotton but can also be performed on corn and rice as well.

The LDAF State Seed Testing Laboratory provides vigor testing to anyone upon request for a nominal fee.
