





Mother, son bond in the kitchen

Cooking means mother-son bonding time for Jamie Mayes and her four-year-old, Lee Antwine III.

“I LOVE to cook. I come from a big family and we all cook, a lot,” said Jamie. She added that it is a skill her mother taught her at a young age in which she also focused on the importance of eating healthy, fresh foods.

“It’s one of the first things my mother taught me to do, plus the importance of getting together with family. My grandparents, aunts, and uncles always celebrated holidays together with lots of food when I was growing up. I looked forward to it,” she added. She knew she wanted to share the same tradition when she had her own family.

Jamie said when Lee was about two-years-old, he would pull-up his chair because he wanted to help. “I would say, you can help mommy serve. You can pour things, thinking of easy things he could do.” But what he wanted was a more involved role in the kitchen. Lee started sharing ideas, and Jamie started listening.

“My favorite thing to do is cook with mom because I like her. My absolute favorite thing to make is our Mickey Mouse breakfast with jam and peanut

butter. The jam has blueberries,” exclaimed four-year-old Lee. Of course, the jam is homemade.

Jamie, who has a specialist degree in education, has taught for 12 years in the public school system. Last year, she launched her education consulting company where she specializes in literacy intervention and provides parental support to help meet the learning needs of all students.

“Because of my business, I have a strong social media presence. That’s where I would share videos of me making Lee’s fresh baby food from scratch. As Lee got older, he would be in the kitchen with me and people fell in love with him,” she said.

That is when a viewer and book publisher reached out and asked if Jamie had considered publishing a cookbook. “The Mommy & Me Cookbook was a two-part process. I asked Lee which recipes he wanted to include. Of course, he rattled off all of his favorite meals that we cook together. We also focus on how to include your children in the process,” added Jamie.

In the cookbook, you’ll find recipes such as “Yes Ma’am Yams” and “Lee’s

Louisiana Farm Recovery Program receives additional funding

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., announced the funding of an additional \$10 million in grant awards to eligible producers impacted by flood events that occurred in March and August of 2016.

“This additional funding is only available to those producers who participated in the 2016 Louisiana Farm Recovery

Grant Program,” Strain said. “These participants will be contacted by one of our grant program coordinators.”

This \$10 million is in addition to the \$10 million in disaster funding awarded in 2018. Both grants are funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (as

Block Disaster Recovery Program {CDBG} grant funds). The Office of Community Development, Disaster Recovery Unit, receives the CDBG disaster recovery grant funds from HUD. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture of Forestry will then administer the program. The funding is part of the \$1.6 billion congressional appropriation for Restore Louisiana.

“Conventional disaster programs like low-interest disaster loans and crop insurance are often inadequate when our farmers are impacted by major disasters like the flooding of 2016,” Strain said. “We worked hard to secure this additional funding to help ensure our farmers can continue to produce the safest food and fiber in the world.”

Lemon Tea". Jamie said they practice counting and measuring in the kitchen and how to do things safely. They also talk about the importance of eating fruits and vegetables.

Jamie said they often visit the local Farmers' Market and roadside vendors, but they also like to grow their own fruits and veggies - banana peppers, cantaloupe, cucumbers, tomatoes, and watermelon.

Fletcher will receive the award at the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis in November.


Drive Safely During Sugarcane Harvest

With safety the number one priority, Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding both drivers and agricultural producers to use caution and patience on the roadway this sugarcane harvest season.

Harvest usually runs from September through December.

"As sugarcane grinding season ramps up this September, farmers are harvesting and trucking their cane to mills in south Louisiana which means more slow moving agricultural equipment and 18-wheeler trucks are on the roadway," Strain said. "Farmers and the public alike must all do their part to drive safely during sugarcane harvest. "When you are driving, be aware of slow moving cane wagons and harvest locations, particularly on rural roads."

"Cane trucks are just like any other



18-wheeler; they make wide turns and start out slowly when entering the roadway," Strain said. "We just ask everyone to be patient."

Look for harvest site road signs
Keep an eye out for slow-moving vehicles

Rice donations highlight National Rice Month

CROWLEY, La. — Louisiana rice industry leaders celebrated National Rice Month with donations of rice totaling almost 32,000 pounds to area food banks.

A donation of 15,000 pounds of rice to the Second Harvest Food Bank was made by area rice mills, including Supreme Rice Mill, of Crowley; Planters Rice Mill, of Abbeville; Farmers Rice Mill, of Lake Charles; and Falcon Rice Mill on Sept. 17.

On Sept 19, the Kennedy Rice Mill in Mer Rouge donated 1,800 pounds of rice to the Northeast Louisiana Food Bank based in Monroe.

This year commemorates the 29th anniversary of National Rice Month, sponsored by USA Rice, and it is celebrated with events around the country.

The Second Harvest Food Bank provides food to more than 700 community partners and programs such as food pantries, group homes, shelters and meal sites across 23 parishes in south Louisiana. In 2018, the Second Harvest Food Bank provided approximately 32 million meals to

the needy.

Natasha Curley, of the Second Harvest Food Bank, said rice has become an important part of the organization's program. "I love rice because I've seen firsthand the amount of good that rice can do," she said.

The Northeast Louisiana Food Bank distributes more than 4.8 million pounds of food through 60 partner agencies and children and senior programs. Jean Toth, food bank director, said 69,000 people in northeast Louisiana are food insecure. "It means they worry about not having enough food to eat," she said.

John Owen, chairman of the Louisiana Rice Promotion Board, said in Monroe that rice works well for food banks because of its nutritional quality and long shelf life.

Rice farming has environmental benefits by providing waterfowl habitat, and it contributes to the diversified agricultural base. "I'm really proud to be involved in the Louisiana rice industry," Owen said.

Total rice donations to food banks in Louisiana last year exceeded

100,000 pounds, said Kane Webb, USA Rice field representative in Louisiana.

Curley said a 42,000-pound donation last year by Falcon Rice Mill, of Crowley, is the largest contribution of rice to Second Harvest. Falcon agreed to a match for every 5-pound bag of rice purchased by consumers in September 2018, and Robbie Trahan, of Falcon, said he will continue the donation this year. Curley said September also is Hunger Action Month.

At the Monroe gathering, state Rep. Charles "Bubba" Chaney read the governor's proclamation. "This state recognizes the importance of the rice industry," Chaney said.

Congressman Ralph Abraham, of Alto, said at the Crowley event that the U.S. relationship with Iraq has resulted in the sales of 300,000 metric tons of rice, and most of it was grown in Louisiana.

Coincidentally, a ship is being loaded at the Port of Lake Charles with milled Louisiana rice purchased by Iraq. About half of the rice grown in the U.S. is exported.
