**T**radition, memories, family are all words used to describe Old Farmer's Day held on an October weekend each year in Loranger, La. What started out as a fundraiser for the now defunct Louisiana Draft Horse Association has grown into something widely anticipated by supporters.

Little by little, Gerald and Barbara Brunett, who are the founders of the event, purchased antique farm equipment at auction and even spent some time with the Amish community in Arcola, Illinois learning how to use and maintain these turn of the century implements, as well as introducing the draft horse to southern Louisiana. "Our family was one of the first to bring Belgian draft horses to this part of the country since they were more prominent up north," said Ethan Dunn, a cousin of the Brunett family.

Traditionally during the month of October, the harvest would be mostly complete and farmers would take a break from their labors to celebrate

the end of the crop season. Old Farmer's Day is celebrated as a throwback to the sustainable farming and farming practices of the old days.

"We try to cater to all ages. What's great is you can watch the older generation reminisce about the days where they personally lived such a hard life for sustainability, while the younger generation is interested in the craft booths and educational aspect of what was common rural life 100 years ago," said Dunn. "One of the things I love is the reactions we get to some of the demonstrations we show. Just the other day I saw a little kid completely mesmerized by a pay phone hanging on the wall inside a grocery store, we get similar reactions at Old Farmer's Day from people of all ages."

Dunn said it is amazing what people take for granted until they come to Old Farmer's Day and realize what it took just to put food on the table. "Today, agriculture and farming is mechanized, **See Loranger, continued on page 20**

## Brand new tractors stolen from north Louisiana business

Baton Rouge, La. (October 21, 2019) – Two men are accused of stealing two brand new tractors from a Many, La. business. Authorities were alerted September 30, 2019 that the tractors were missing. The estimated value of both tractors is \$80,000.

Thirty-eight year old Stephan Morton of Shreveport, La. and 41-year old Michael Bayonne of Alexandria, La. are charged with felony theft of two new “LS” brand tractors

from Byles Tractor and Welding located at 245 Hwy 71 Bypass, Many, La.

Evidence and statements confirmed probable cause to charge both for their involvement.

Both men were already in custody in the Natchitoches Parish Detention Center on charges unrelated to the tractor thefts in Sabine Parish.

“Farming equipment can be very expensive and loss of such equipment can be a financial burden. This crime

is a felony and is taken very seriously,” said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Morton has since been moved to the Sabine Parish Detention Center with no bond set at this time. Morton also has charges pending in other jurisdictions.

Bayonne currently remains in custody at the Natchitoches Detention Center and has charges pending in other jurisdictions. Bond has

been set at \$10,000.

As of press time, the stolen tractors have not been recovered.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Livestock Brand Commission and the Natchitoches Parish Sheriff’s Office assisted the Many Police Department in these arrests.

## State Industrial Hemp Program Update

Baton Rouge, La. (Oct. 10, 2019) - The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) filed rules and regulations with the State Register's office for the Louisiana Industrial Hemp Program, LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

"Our staff worked diligently to complete and file the industrial hemp administrative rules and regulations,"

Strain. "Our goal is to have everything in place and licenses issued in time for the 2020 planting season. While there are additional steps that must be completed before the production of industrial hemp in Louisiana is authorized, I remain confident that we are on track to meet our goal."

### Background

The 2018 Farm Bill addressed a number of federal policies and programs regarding industrial hemp, laying the groundwork for full-scale commercial production. Specifically, it removed industrial hemp from regulation under the Controlled Substances Act and provided for the commercial production of industrial hemp.

Act 164 was passed by the Louisiana Legislature and signed by the governor authorizing the LDAF to submit a state industrial hemp plan to USDA and adopt regulations to administer the industrial hemp program in Louisiana.

The LDAFLouisiana Industrial Hemp Program is the state's designated regulatory authority for the production, processing and transportation of industrial hemp.

A lot of people don't understand exactly how hard of a life our ancestors lived to build the world we know today." Dunn explained how his grandmother grew up in Husser, La. where her father owned a sawmill as their family's primary source of income. "But despite what little they had, my grandma said there always seemed to be

enough, referring to food on the table.
