## LSU AgCenter scientists press forward with roseau cane research

Roseau cane continues to die-off at the mouth of the Mississippi River with no known cause. But LSU AgCenter scientists are studying multiple possibilities.

AgCenter entomologist Rodrigo Diaz is leading a group of federal and state researchers who are looking at the possible cause of the die-offs.

“We’re looking at a number of possible causes, but we can’t be sure until we put the pieces together,” he said.

Diaz and the group of

scientists began their study in 2016, when the die-offs were first discovered.

When the group began their study, they were mainly interested in roseau cane scale, an insect known to damage the plant. But later, other scientists joined to look at pathogens that may be responsible — and the search began for a natural enemy to control the scale.

“We know the scale is responsible for some of the damage, but we are working to see if there may be something else that’s

aiding the problem,” Diaz said.

Each member of the group has an issue they are assigned to examine and to determine how much of the problem it can be causing.

Hannah Broadley, a researcher from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, is leading a team to explore any natural enemies of the roseau cane scale in Asia.

Broadley recently visited Japan, Taiwan and South Korea, areas where the cane is native, to search for the scale’s natural enemies.

Scott Schneider, a USDA scientist, is looking at the genetics of the scale to determine the origin of the scale located here.

AgCenter coastal ecologist Andy Nyman is looking at what follows roseau cane dieback. He has found that after the die-offs, there sometimes is no roseau cane to replace it — just open water.

Other times, the roseau cane returns. Nyman also has seen it replaced with other wetland plants.

Nyman is collaborating with the U.S. Geological Survey to use satellites to view images of the

area that date back to the 1980s.

Ehab Meselhe, a scientist from Tulane University, is studying if channel dredging will be impacted by the absence of the cane.

“He wants to know what will happen if large stands of roseau cane die,” Diaz said. “There are questions of whether there will be a need for more dredging once the cane is not there to prevent sedimentation in the navigation channel.”

AgCenter plant pathologist Rodrigo Valverde believes that more than one culprit is affecting the cane health. He is looking at the die-offs from a plant pathogen perspective.

Valverde is isolating potential pathogens from plants he’s collected and is growing cultures of some of them. His plan is to inoculate healthy roseau cane with the pathogens to see if they are causing disease or death.

“One thing that makes the entire situation more interesting is that there is not just one variety of roseau cane in Plaquemines Parish, but four: one from Africa, one from Central and South America, and

two with European origins,” Diaz said.

Jim Cronin, a professor in the LSU Department of Biological Sciences, suspects multiple stressors could be affecting roseau cane health. He is studying host plant resistance and how the different varieties of cane handle stress.

“He is simulating various scenarios for the plants, including major stressors such flooding, insects, soil pathogens and nutrients to study the different varieties’ defensive chemistry,” Diaz said.

The team led by Diaz also is looking at population dynamics of the roseau cane scale.

“We have found that the scale can rapidly colonize the plants early in the spring, and by later summer almost 100% of the plants are infested. In addition, the roseau cane scale will not harm any other plant species, and three parasitoid wasps are responsible for up to 58% of the scale mortality,” Diaz said.

Using insecticides is not recommended to control the scale because scientists believe it will negatively effect the natural enemies.

## Fueling best practices and ADA Accessibility

Have you ever had your credit or debit card information stolen and wondered how it happened? Credit card data theft can occur while making routine purchases such as buying fuel or conducting a transaction at a local retail outlet.

Criminals place credit card skimming devices in cabinets of gas pumps throughout the U.S. and the devices have evolved as technology has advanced from in-line type devices to Bluetooth and cell phone technologies that are much more difficult to locate inside the pump cabinet. The latter two do not have to be retrieved from a pump to be able to collect your card information.

We are seeing more stations that are accepting "chip cards" in advance of the October 2020 deadline to be

Europay, MasterCard and Visa (EMV) compliant. The chip cards are not full-proof and can be susceptible to shimmying, a process where fraudsters insert a "shim" into the card reader, allowing them to copy the chip card information. A new chip card cannot be created, but a magnetic stripe card can be made from it and used online or at convenience-store retailers that have not yet upgraded to be EMV compliant.

"Our Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Weights and Measures inspectors are checking fuel pumps daily during routine inspections, as well as during consumer complaints," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. "Our goal is to make sure that all transactions are fair and equitable. In addition, we work with U.S. Secret Service and local law enforcement agencies statewide to expand the scope of our ability to find and remove all types of skimming devices from the 3,500 gas stations statewide."

"Gas pump skimming is a crime of opportunity in which the criminals prey on unsuspecting consumers, and the U.S. Secret Service is committed to aggressively investigating these offenses," said Special Agent in Charge Leslie Pichon of the U.S. Secret Service New Orleans Field Office. "Together with our federal, state and local law enforcement task force members, we are excited to partner with the LDAF in order to protect the public against this growing cyber-enabled financial crime."

The LDAF recently implemented multi-parish skimmer sweeps and have more planned in the near future. The goal is to check all gas pumps

throughout the designated parishes during these sweeps, as well as train law enforcement on how to identify these devices so we can have more trained eyes monitoring statewide.

**Consumer Best Practices to Prevent Being Skimmed/Shimmed:**

- Pay with cash or a prepaid credit card.
- Use credit, not debit, whenever possible.
- Pay inside where it is less likely the credit card terminal has been tampered with.
- Use mobile payment options like Google Pay, Samsung Pay, PayPal Pay or Apple Pay, if they're an option. Some stations offer a mobile payment app.
- Use the chip reader rather than swiping. Shimmying is possible this way, but less likely.
- Investigate the card reader to make sure nothing looks or feels unusual.
- If possible, only stop at busy, well-lit and well-maintained gas stations.
- Look for LDAF seals, security seals or other signs that the pumps are regularly inspected.
- Use the fuel pumps in the middle of the station.

Consumers should avoid pumps that have tamper-evident security tape removed or not present and avoid pumps that are not locked or appear atypical. In addition, never use a debit card. Generally, credit cards are protected by a zero-liability policy from the issuing company. You can pay with a credit card inside but inspectors have observed overlay devices on top of the customer facing card terminals that can also steal your information. Paying cash eliminates the possibility of your card being skimmed.

**Handicap Access at Gas Stations**

Citizens with disabilities may find it difficult to use the controls, hose, or nozzle of a self-serve gas pump. The Americans with Disabilities

Act (ADA) requires self-serve gas stations to provide equal access to their customers with disabilities. If necessary to provide access, gas stations must:

- Provide refueling assistance upon the request of an individual with a disability. A service station or convenience store is not required to provide such service at any time that it is operating on a remote control basis with a single employee, but is encouraged to do so, if feasible.
- Let patrons know (e.g., through appropriate signs, see below) that customers with disabilities can obtain refueling assistance by either honking or otherwise signaling an employee.
- Provide refueling assistance without any charge beyond the self-serve price.

There is a mobile application, fuelService, available in the U.S., set up to assist disabled drivers relative to fueling their vehicles at participating stations; however, there are currently no stations participating in Louisiana. Many brands offer apps that allow consumers to pay for fuel utilizing an app but none are currently set up to assist disabled drivers as of this publication date.

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## Beauregard Parish Man Arrested for Theft of Farm Raised Deer

Baton Rouge, La. (October 31, 2019)- The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission arrested 21 year old Davin Chaney of 639 Bearling St., Merryville La., for allegedly shooting and stealing a farm raised deer in Beauregard Parish.

On October 29, 2019, LDAF brand inspectors determined Chaney, shot and removed the deer from the owner's property on October 21. Investigators say the deer was a two year old, non-typical, 23 point buck, weighing more than 200 pounds. The value of the deer is estimated at approximately \$15,000.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "Our alternative livestock industry consists of more than 300 licensed farms creating a multi-million dollar annual economic impact and recreational opportunities in the Sportsman's Paradise in which we live. Farm raised deer and exotics in Louisiana are considered 'alternative livestock' which are regulated by the LDAF."

Chaney was booked into the Beauregard Parish Jail on October 30 for theft of livestock, LA.R.S. 14:67.1. If convicted, Chaney faces a fine and/or jail time.

The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the Beauregard Parish Sheriff's Office assisted in the investigation.



## Strain Cautions Duck Hunters That Roseau Cane Scale Quarantine Still In Effect

Baton Rouge, La. (October 30, 2019) - Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said as duck hunting season approaches, a quarantine for Roseau cane scale remains in effect.

The scale, native to China and Japan, is an insect that destroys Roseau cane which is vegetation that helps protect Louisiana's coast and poses a threat to the health and welfare of Louisiana's wetlands. It also poses a threat to sorghum, sugarcane and rice industries.

"We urge waterfowl hunters not to move Roseau cane material more than one-quarter mile from its original location," said Strain. Duck hunting season starts in November and lasts through December.

A quarantine was put into place in March 2018. Quarantine areas in the state include all areas south of Louisiana Highway 10 beginning at the Mississippi state line moving west until intersecting at Highway 171 in Vernon Parish. Also, moving south on Highway 171 to Highway 190 in DeRidder

and turning west onto Highway 190 and continuing on Highway 190 until it reaches the Sabine River.

Quarantine areas in the state include portions of the following parishes south of Louisiana Highway 10: Allen, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, St. Helena, Tangipahoa, Vernon, Washington and West Feliciana.


These entire parishes are quarantined: Acadia, Ascension, Assumption, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, East Baton Rouge, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Lafourche, Livingston, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. James, St. John, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Terrebonne, Vermillion and West Baton Rouge.

Clean nursery stock may be moved within quarantined areas under a special permit issued by the LDAF. The quarantine will be in effect until further notice.
