touches on their dishes. The students were competing in the first ever Certified Louisiana Recipe Contest which was held on Dec. 6, 2019.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF) Certified Louisiana Program sponsored the contest in partnership with Louisiana Cookin' magazine to find the best original recipes in four categories created and prepared by students at the LCI. Entries were required to use at least one Certified Louisiana product.

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said they look for creative ways to engage people and grow the Certified Louisiana program and this recipe contest is a perfect example.

"We celebrate who we are through our food and we have such a story to tell. The Certified Louisiana Program is about a number of things. It's about food. It's about fun. It's about culture. It's

about the economy but it is also one way we grow our agricultural product base," Strain said. "As you become chefs and when you make the decision to use our wonderful Certified Louisiana products that is what grows the industry. When customers leave your restaurants and they say my goodness that was good, what did they use? Certified Louisiana products!"

Winning dishes were selected by an independent panel of food-industry professionals based on overall flavor, visual appeal and creativity.

Louisiana Cookin' Editor-in-Chief Daniel Schumacher said the folks at Louisiana Cookin' understand that Louisiana's cuisine is special. "We take great pleasure in working with great Louisiana products and chefs to respect Louisiana's traditions while moving the cuisine forward. I think all of you are really great examples of how we can move forward," Schumacher said. "This is our first Certified Louisiana recipe contest and I was really impressed with what we got today."

## Arrests made for livestock theft in Avoyelles Parish

On Jan. 7, 2020, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission arrested five men for their alleged involvement in the theft of two horses in two separate incidents in Avoyelles Parish.

Arnaud R. Walter, 18, 2650 Hwy 1187, Mansura, was arrested on two counts of theft of livestock and one count of simple criminal damage to property.

The four men who were arrested for illegal possession of stolen things

include: Dontel J. Hollis, 18, 2016 Rapides Ave., Lecompte; Joquaris R. Jones, 21, 104 East Hampton, Pinerville; Dewayne Lair Jr., 18, 3019 Beech St., Lecompte; Wilbert L. Williams Jr., 19, 109 Wilhelminia, Cheneyville.

The LDAF Livestock Brand Commission received separate complaints from two individuals regarding the theft of two horses in Avoyelles Parish. Livestock Brand Commission enforcement officers said an investigation into the complaints

revealed Walter allegedly removed both horses without the owners' authorization on or about Dec. 2, 2019 in Mansura and Dec. 17, 2019 in Cottonport. Walter also allegedly relocated the horses, and in one case damaged the owner's gate where the horse was kept. Hollis, Jones, Lair and Williams were allegedly involved in transporting and relocating one of the stolen horses.

Both stolen horses have been recovered and returned to the owners.

"Our Livestock Brand Commission enforcement officers were able to piece together evidence from this case with help from the public and video footage provided by various businesses in the area, Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

Strain encourages anyone who suspects a farm crime to report it to Livestock Brand Commission at 1-855-452-5323.

sisted in this investigation by the Avoyelles Parish Sheriff's Department and the Cottonport, Mansura, and Lecompte police departments.

## Southern Cinnamon Pecan Cake (Grand Prize)

### For the Cake:

¾ cup Cake flour  
 ½ cup granulated sugar  
 ¾ teaspoon Salt  
 1 ½ tsps. baking powder  
 ⅓ cup vegetable oil  
 3 egg yolks  
 7 tbsps. water  
 ¾ tsp. vanilla extract  
 ¼ tsp. almond extract

8 egg whites  
 ⅓ cup sugar  
 1 ½ tsp. cream of tartar

### Filling:

1 cup brown sugar  
 1 ½ tsp. ground cinnamon.  
**2 cups Louisiana Pecans** (crushed)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Butter and line a 9 inch round pan with parchment paper. Measure cake flour, salt, baking powder, and the first portion of sugar. Sift together. In a separate bowl, measure out vegetable oil, egg yolks, water and both the extracts. Combine dry and wet ingredients and mix until smooth.

In a third separate bowl measure out egg whites and start whipping and slowly add the second quantity of sugar and then the cream of tartar. Slowly fold the egg whites into the wet and dry mixture. In a separate bowl, mix together the

ingredients for the filling. Pour half of the batter into the pan. Sprinkle the filling mixture on top, then pour in the rest of the batter. Slightly swirl the cake with a butter knife. Bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes or until a toothpick is clean when inserted in the middle.

### Icing:

2 ½ cups powdered sugar  
 3 teaspoons whole milk  
 1 teaspoon cinnamon  
 ½ teaspoon almond extract

Sift the powdered sugar, add the cinnamon, milk, and almond extract.

Mix until smooth. After the cake is cool to touch, drizzle icing on top and sprinkle with more crushed pecans.

½ cup green onions, thinly sliced	1 tsp. hot sauce

Chop garlic finely in a food processor; add spinach watercress with stems removed and green onion to garlic. Pulse until mixture is finely chopped and transfer to a medium bowl.

Combine butter, bread crumbs, Pernod, fennel and hot sauce in a food processor blend well. Add the spinach mixture and pulse until the mixture is blended. Season with salt and pepper. Cook about 8 minutes.

#### Pork rinds

1 lbs to 2 lbs of pork skin	2 tbsps. paprika
<b>For seasoning</b>	1 tbsp. onion powder
2 tbsps. of garlic powder	½ tbsp. dried thyme
2 tbsps. Italian seasoning	

Cut the skin into large pieces about 6 inches long and 4 inches wide. Roast for 1 hour at 250 degrees and then lower temperature to 200 degrees and roast until the tops of the skin are golden brown 2 to 3 more hours. Remove pork skin from oven. Heat oil to 320 degrees. Season pork skin with Cajun seasoning, cook in oil and drain the excess oil.

## Shitake-Risotto Milanese with Pan-Seared Sea Scallops Amour Creole Seasoning



1 oz. sweet cream butter  
 2 tbsps. duck fat  
 1 oz. shallots, chopped fine  
 6 oz. shitake mushrooms, chopped coarsely  
 1/2 cups dry white wine  
 1 pound orzo pasta

1 tbsp. garlic powder  
 1 tbsp. onion powder  
 1/2 tsp. saffron  
 48 oz. **Dashi broth**, see recipe  
 1 oz. sweet cream butter  
 3 oz. Pecorino Romano cheese  
 Salt and white pepper to taste

In a saucepan, warm the broth over low heat. Steep saffron in a half cup of broth. Warm 2 tablespoons duck fat in a saucepan over medium-high heat. Cook mushrooms until soft. Remove mushrooms and jus. Heat 1 ounce of butter and 2 tablespoons of oil into a sauté pan and stir in the shallots. Cook 1 minute. Add orzo, stirring to coat with oil for about 2 minutes. Pour in wine, stirring constantly until the wine is fully absorbed. Add two 2 oz. ladles of broth to the orzo, and stir until the broth is absorbed. Add the garlic and onion powder. Continue adding broth, stirring continuously, until the liquid is absorbed and the orzo is al dente, adding a half cup of saffron steeped broth towards the end. Remove from heat, and stir in mushrooms and jus, butter and cheese. Season with salt and pepper to taste.

### Dashi

5 pints water	1/2 tsp. rosemary
1.5 tbsps. duck fat	1/2 tsp. peppercorn
8 oz. onion	1/2 tsp. parsley
4 oz. parsnips	1 bay leaf
4 oz. celery	2 oz. Kombu

Place thyme, rosemary, peppercorn, bay leaf and parsley in a sachet. Sauté onion, parsnips and celery in oil. Add water and boil, then reduce to a simmer for 30 minutes. Strain and cool down the broth. Add kombu to the cold broth in a pot, bringing it to a boil. Immediately remove from heat, remove kombu and add in the Katsuobushi (bonito flakes. Let them settle then strain through a cheesecloth)

1/2 tbsps. flour	1 sprig thyme
1 tbsp. <b>Creole seasoning</b>	1 sprig rosemary
2 tbsps. butter	1 pinch saffron
1 tbsp. duck fat	

### Pan-Seared Scallops

Dry scallops with a paper towel. Dust lightly with flour season with Amour Creole seasoning. In a large skillet set over medium-high heat, add the oil. When the pan is hot, add the scallops and cook until a deep crust develops on both sides. Flip the scallops, and add the butter and herbs to the pan. Continue to cook, spooning the butter over the scallops until they are cooked through, about 3 minutes more. Add the white wine, reduce at high heat. Plate over Shitake Risotto Milanese, garnish with dried capers and chopped parsley.

## Prior harvest affected 2019 sugarcane crop

CROWLEY, La. — Kenneth Gravois, LSU AgCenter sugarcane specialist, said the muddy 2018 harvest affected the recent sugarcane crop with reduced cane tonnage.

"It was a light crop," Gravois said. "Anytime you have a muddy harvest in the previous year, you have a hangover effect into the next year."

The average yield was 30 tons per acre statewide, compared to 39 tons the previous year.

"That was a record tonnage last year," he said.

The average sugar extraction of 222 pounds of sugar per ton of cane was a slight improvement over last year when the average was 219 pounds, he said.

This crop was below average. And for the most part harvest conditions were dry, and planting was accomplished in good conditions.

"We're going to be optimistic for next year," Gravois said.



2019 sugarcane acreage totaled 482,300, compared to 459,000 acres in 2018. Gravois expects acreage to increase for 2020, possibly as much as 490,000 acres, as more land is put into cane production to the west and north.

Blair Hebert, LSU AgCenter agent for sugarcane in the Bayou Teche area, said fields were badly damaged in 2018 during the muddy harvest.

Hurricane Barry damaged the cane worse than was initially thought with the tops of cane plants

broken. The early freeze put halted sugar production in the plants, he said.

"This is one of those tough years that Mother Nature didn't give us much to work with," Hebert said. "Overall, this is not going to go down as a good-yielding year."

Hebert credited the breeding programs of the American Sugar Cane League, U.S. Department of Agriculture and the LSU AgCenter for developing cold-tolerant varieties that withstood the freeze.

A hard cold snap would help suppress disease, insects and weeds, he said.

Even though tonnage was down, most farmers were satisfied with the outcome, said Matt Foster, AgCenter agent for sugarcane in Ascension, Assumption, Lafourche, St. Charles, St. James, St. John the Baptist and Terrebonne parishes.

"Some of them wish it could have been a little better," Foster said.

Last year, he said, acreage went unplanted because of wet conditions. This year the ground also was wet at the start of planting, but farmers managed to get seed cane in the ground.

"Some people were planting and harvesting at the same time," Foster said.

The muddy harvest of 2018 can be blamed for the tonnage decrease. "I think the cane was trying to recover from the muddy conditions," he said.


